

# CHARACTERISTICS OF PATRONAGE JACKSONIAN

## UNDERSTANDING THE CORE CHARACTERISTICS OF PATRONAGE IN THE JACKSONIAN ERA

**CHARACTERISTICS OF PATRONAGE JACKSONIAN** PROFOUNDLY SHAPED AMERICAN POLITICS AND GOVERNANCE DURING THE PRESIDENCY OF ANDREW JACKSON AND THE SUBSEQUENT ERA. THIS SYSTEM, OFTEN REFERRED TO AS THE "SPOILS SYSTEM," FUNDAMENTALLY ALTERED THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN PUBLIC SERVICE AND POLITICAL LOYALTY, LEADING TO BOTH SIGNIFICANT SHIFTS IN POWER AND ENDURING DEBATES ABOUT THE NATURE OF DEMOCRACY. THE JACKSONIAN APPROACH TO PATRONAGE PRIORITIZED REWARDING POLITICAL SUPPORTERS AND REMOVING PERCEIVED OPPONENTS FROM GOVERNMENT POSITIONS, BELIEVING IT FOSTERED EFFICIENCY AND ENSURED RESPONSIVENESS TO THE WILL OF THE PEOPLE. THIS ARTICLE WILL DELVE INTO THE MULTIFACETED NATURE OF JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE, EXPLORING ITS ORIGINS, ITS IMPLEMENTATION, ITS PROponents' JUSTIFICATIONS, ITS CRITICS' CONDEMNATIONS, AND ITS LASTING IMPACT ON THE AMERICAN ADMINISTRATIVE STATE. UNDERSTANDING THESE CORE CHARACTERISTICS IS CRUCIAL FOR COMPREHENDING A PIVOTAL PERIOD IN AMERICAN HISTORY AND ITS INFLUENCE ON MODERN POLITICAL PRACTICES.

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## THE RISE OF THE SPOILS SYSTEM

THE CONCEPT OF REWARDING POLITICAL LOYALTY WITH GOVERNMENT APPOINTMENTS WAS NOT ENTIRELY NEW TO THE JACKSONIAN ERA. HOWEVER, ANDREW JACKSON AND HIS SUPPORTERS ELEVATED IT TO A SYSTEMATIC AND WIDESPREAD PRACTICE. PRIOR TO JACKSON, GOVERNMENT POSITIONS WERE OFTEN HELD BY A RELATIVELY STABLE BUREAUCRACY, WITH APPOINTMENTS BASED MORE ON PERCEIVED MERIT OR LONG-STANDING CONNECTIONS. JACKSON'S PRESIDENCY MARKED A DECISIVE BREAK FROM THIS TRADITION, USHERING IN A PERIOD WHERE POLITICAL AFFILIATION BECAME A PARAMOUNT QUALIFICATION FOR HOLDING OFFICE.

THIS SHIFT WAS PARTLY FUELED BY A GROWING DEMOCRATIC SPIRIT AND A DESIRE TO CHALLENGE THE ENTRENCHED ELITE THAT HAD DOMINATED FEDERAL APPOINTMENTS. JACKSON'S SUPPORTERS ARGUED THAT THE PREVIOUS SYSTEM HAD LED TO A STAGNANT AND SELF-SERVING BUREAUCRACY, DISCONNECTED FROM THE NEEDS AND DESIRES OF THE COMMON CITIZEN. THE ELECTION OF 1828, OFTEN TERMED A REVOLUTION, PAVED THE WAY FOR A SIGNIFICANT OVERHAUL OF THE FEDERAL WORKFORCE. THIS PERIOD SAW AN UNPRECEDENTED TURNOVER IN GOVERNMENT JOBS, AS JACKSON SOUGHT TO REPLACE THOSE HE VIEWED AS LOYAL TO HIS PREDECESSORS OR THE OLD GUARD WITH INDIVIDUALS WHO HAD ACTIVELY SUPPORTED HIS CAMPAIGN AND CHAMPIONED HIS DEMOCRATIC IDEALS.

## KEY CHARACTERISTICS OF JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE

THE DEFINING FEATURES OF JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE ARE ESSENTIAL TO UNDERSTANDING ITS PERVASIVE INFLUENCE. AT ITS CORE, IT WAS A SYSTEM BUILT ON THE PRINCIPLE OF ROTATION IN OFFICE AND THE REWARD OF POLITICAL SERVICE. THIS APPROACH HAD SEVERAL DISTINCT CHARACTERISTICS THAT SET IT APART FROM PREVIOUS ADMINISTRATIVE PRACTICES.

## ROTATION IN OFFICE AS A DEMOCRATIC PRINCIPLE

ONE OF THE MOST PROMINENT CHARACTERISTICS OF JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE WAS THE EMPHASIS ON ROTATION IN OFFICE. PROPONENTS ARGUED THAT GOVERNMENT POSITIONS SHOULD NOT BE HELD FOR LIFE, AS THIS COULD LEAD TO COMPLACENCY, CORRUPTION, AND THE FORMATION OF AN ARISTOCRACY WITHIN THE CIVIL SERVICE. INSTEAD, THEY BELIEVED THAT FREQUENT TURNOVER WOULD PREVENT THE ENTRENCHMENT OF POWER AND ENSURE THAT PUBLIC OFFICES WERE ACCESSIBLE TO A WIDER RANGE OF CITIZENS. THIS CONCEPT WAS SEEN AS A DIRECT APPLICATION OF DEMOCRATIC PRINCIPLES, ALLOWING MORE INDIVIDUALS TO GAIN EXPERIENCE IN PUBLIC SERVICE AND FOSTERING A MORE ENGAGED CITIZENRY.

## REWARDING POLITICAL SUPPORTERS

THE MOST DIRECT AND PERHAPS MOST CONTROVERSIAL CHARACTERISTIC WAS THE PRACTICE OF REWARDING LOYAL POLITICAL SUPPORTERS WITH GOVERNMENT APPOINTMENTS. INDIVIDUALS WHO HAD CAMPAIGNED FOR JACKSON, CONTRIBUTED TO HIS CAUSE, OR OTHERWISE DEMONSTRATED THEIR ALLEGIANCE WERE OFTEN GIVEN PREFERENCE FOR POSITIONS WITHIN FEDERAL AGENCIES, CUSTOMS HOUSES, POST OFFICES, AND OTHER GOVERNMENT ENTITIES. THIS CREATED A POWERFUL INCENTIVE FOR POLITICAL ENGAGEMENT AND MOBILIZATION, AS THE PROSPECT OF SECURING A GOVERNMENT JOB BECAME A TANGIBLE BENEFIT OF ELECTORAL VICTORY.

## REMOVAL OF OPPONENTS AND PERCEIVED INCOMPETENTS

COMPLEMENTARY TO REWARDING SUPPORTERS WAS THE SYSTEMATIC REMOVAL OF THOSE PERCEIVED AS OPPONENTS OR AS UNQUALIFIED FOR THEIR ROLES. JACKSON'S ADMINISTRATION ACTIVELY SOUGHT TO WEED OUT INDIVIDUALS WHO HAD SERVED IN PREVIOUS ADMINISTRATIONS AND WERE NOT SEEN AS ALIGNED WITH HIS VISION. THIS WAS OFTEN JUSTIFIED ON THE GROUNDS THAT THESE INDIVIDUALS WERE INEFFICIENT, CORRUPT, OR IDEOLOGICALLY OPPOSED TO THE DEMOCRATIC MANDATE OF THE JACKSONIAN MOVEMENT. THE REMOVAL PROCESS WAS OFTEN SWIFT AND COMPREHENSIVE, LEADING TO A SIGNIFICANT RESHAPING OF THE FEDERAL BUREAUCRACY.

## DECENTRALIZATION OF POWER AND LOCAL CONTROL

WHILE THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT WAS THE PRIMARY ARENA FOR JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE, THE PRINCIPLES ALSO INFLUENCED STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS. THE SYSTEM OFTEN EMPOWERED LOCAL PARTY LEADERS TO NOMINATE CANDIDATES FOR FEDERAL POSITIONS IN THEIR DISTRICTS, THEREBY STRENGTHENING THE PARTY ORGANIZATION AT THE GRASSROOTS LEVEL. THIS DECENTRALIZATION OF INFLUENCE WAS SEEN AS A WAY TO MAKE THE GOVERNMENT MORE RESPONSIVE TO LOCAL INTERESTS AND TO BREAK THE HOLD OF DISTANT, CENTRALIZED POWER STRUCTURES.

## THE ROLE OF PARTY LOYALTY

PARTY LOYALTY BECAME A PARAMOUNT QUALIFICATION FOR OFFICE. THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY, UNDER JACKSON'S LEADERSHIP, BECAME A FORMIDABLE POLITICAL MACHINE THAT RELIED HEAVILY ON PATRONAGE TO MAINTAIN ITS COHESION AND ELECTORAL SUCCESS. MEMBERSHIP AND ACTIVE PARTICIPATION IN THE PARTY WERE OFTEN PREREQUISITES FOR CONSIDERATION FOR APPOINTMENTS, SOLIDIFYING THE LINK BETWEEN PARTY PLATFORMS, ELECTORAL VICTORIES, AND THE DISTRIBUTION OF GOVERNMENT JOBS.

## PHILOSOPHICAL UNDERPINNINGS AND JUSTIFICATIONS

THE ARCHITECTS AND DEFENDERS OF JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE OFFERED SEVERAL PHILOSOPHICAL ARGUMENTS TO JUSTIFY ITS IMPLEMENTATION. THESE JUSTIFICATIONS WERE DEEPLY INTERTWINED WITH THE BURGEONING DEMOCRATIC IDEALS OF THE ERA AND A CRITIQUE OF WHAT THEY PERCEIVED AS AN ARISTOCRATIC AND UNRESPONSIVE GOVERNMENT.

## DEMOCRATIC EGALITARIANISM

A CENTRAL TENET OF THE JUSTIFICATION WAS A BELIEF IN DEMOCRATIC EGALITARIANISM. JACKSONIANS ARGUED THAT THE TALENTS AND CAPABILITIES FOR PUBLIC SERVICE WERE NOT EXCLUSIVE TO ANY PARTICULAR SOCIAL CLASS OR EDUCATED ELITE. THEY BELIEVED THAT ORDINARY CITIZENS, WHEN GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY, COULD COMPETENTLY MANAGE THE AFFAIRS OF GOVERNMENT. THE SPOILS SYSTEM, IN THIS VIEW, DEMOCRATIZED ACCESS TO PUBLIC OFFICE, BREAKING DOWN BARRIERS THAT HAD PREVIOUSLY LIMITED OPPORTUNITIES TO THE WELL-CONNECTED AND THE WEALTHY.

## THE "WILL OF THE PEOPLE"

JACKSON AND HIS SUPPORTERS FERVENTLY BELIEVED THAT GOVERNMENT APPOINTMENTS SHOULD REFLECT THE "WILL OF THE PEOPLE" AS EXPRESSED THROUGH ELECTIONS. IF THE ELECTORATE CHOSE A PARTICULAR PARTY OR LEADER, THEN THE ADMINISTRATION SHOULD BE STAFFED BY INDIVIDUALS WHO WERE COMMITTED TO IMPLEMENTING THAT MANDATE. PATRONAGE WAS SEEN AS A MECHANISM TO ENSURE THAT THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH WAS DIRECTLY ACCOUNTABLE TO THE ELECTED OFFICIALS AND, BY EXTENSION, TO THE VOTERS. THIS CONTRASTED SHARPLY WITH THE IDEA OF A PERMANENT, INDEPENDENT CIVIL SERVICE THAT MIGHT OPERATE BEYOND THE IMMEDIATE INFLUENCE OF THE ELECTORATE.

## PREVENTING CORRUPTION AND ENTRENCHMENT

AS MENTIONED EARLIER, A SIGNIFICANT JUSTIFICATION FOR THE SPOILS SYSTEM WAS THE PREVENTION OF CORRUPTION AND THE ENTRENCHMENT OF POWER. JACKSON'S RHETORIC OFTEN DEPICTED THE EXISTING BUREAUCRACY AS A DEN OF CORRUPTION AND SELF-INTEREST, RESISTANT TO REFORM. THE ROTATION OF OFFICIALS WAS PRESENTED AS A WAY TO PERIODICALLY "CLEANSE" THE GOVERNMENT, BRINGING IN FRESH PERSPECTIVES AND REDUCING THE OPPORTUNITIES FOR INDIVIDUALS TO EXPLOIT THEIR POSITIONS FOR PERSONAL GAIN. IT WAS ARGUED THAT A LIMITED TENURE IN OFFICE WOULD FOSTER A SENSE OF PUBLIC DUTY RATHER THAN A DESIRE FOR LIFELONG PRIVILEGE.

## STRENGTHENING THE PARTY SYSTEM

FROM A PRAGMATIC POLITICAL PERSPECTIVE, PATRONAGE WAS ESSENTIAL FOR BUILDING AND MAINTAINING A STRONG POLITICAL PARTY. BY DISTRIBUTING JOBS, PARTY LEADERS COULD ENSURE THE LOYALTY AND EFFECTIVENESS OF PARTY OPERATIVES. THIS CREATED A DISCIPLINED ORGANIZATION CAPABLE OF MOBILIZING VOTERS, DISSEMINATING CAMPAIGN MESSAGES, AND SECURING ELECTORAL VICTORIES. THE SPOILS SYSTEM THUS SERVED AS A VITAL TOOL FOR THE FUNCTIONING AND PERPETUATION OF THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY.

## CRITICISMS AND CONTROVERSIES

DESPITE THE FERVENT JUSTIFICATIONS, JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE WAS A DEEPLY DIVISIVE ISSUE AND FACED SIGNIFICANT CRITICISM FROM ITS INCEPTION. THE PRACTICE SPARKED VIGOROUS DEBATES ABOUT THE ETHICS OF GOVERNMENT APPOINTMENTS, THE EFFICIENCY OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION, AND THE VERY NATURE OF A REPUBLIC.

## MERIT VS. LOYALTY DEBATE

THE MOST PROMINENT CRITICISM CENTERED ON THE PERCEIVED DISREGARD FOR MERIT AND QUALIFICATIONS. CRITICS ARGUED THAT AWARDED JOBS BASED ON POLITICAL LOYALTY RATHER THAN COMPETENCE LED TO THE APPOINTMENT OF UNQUALIFIED AND INEXPERIENCED INDIVIDUALS. THIS, THEY CONTENDED, UNDERMINED THE EFFECTIVENESS OF GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS AND COULD LEAD TO MISMANAGEMENT AND INEFFICIENCY. THE IDEAL OF A PROFESSIONAL CIVIL SERVICE, BASED ON EXPERTISE AND DEMONSTRATED ABILITY, WAS STARKLY CONTRASTED WITH THE REALITY OF POLITICAL FAVORITISM.

## INCREASED POLITICAL CORRUPTION AND MACHINE POLITICS

OPPONENTS POINTED TO THE POTENTIAL FOR INCREASED POLITICAL CORRUPTION AND THE ENTRENCHMENT OF POWERFUL PARTY MACHINES. THE DISTRIBUTION OF JOBS FOR POLITICAL GAIN COULD LEAD TO A SYSTEM WHERE OFFICES WERE TRADED FOR FAVORS, CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS, AND OTHER FORMS OF POLITICAL LEVERAGE. THIS CREATED A CYCLE OF DEPENDENCY WHERE POLITICIANS WERE BEHOLDEN TO PARTY BOSSES AND VOTERS WERE INCENTIVIZED TO SUPPORT THE PARTY THAT OFFERED THE MOST TANGIBLE REWARDS, FOSTERING A LESS PRINCIPLED FORM OF GOVERNANCE.

## INSTABILITY AND LACK OF EXPERTISE

THE CONSTANT TURNOVER OF PERSONNEL IN GOVERNMENT POSITIONS LED TO A LACK OF CONTINUITY AND EXPERTISE. NEW APPOINTEES, OFTEN LACKING PRIOR EXPERIENCE, WOULD TAKE TIME TO LEARN THEIR ROLES, WHILE SEASONED INDIVIDUALS WERE REMOVED. THIS INSTABILITY COULD HINDER LONG-TERM PLANNING AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF SPECIALIZED KNOWLEDGE WITHIN GOVERNMENT AGENCIES, ULTIMATELY IMPACTING THE QUALITY OF PUBLIC SERVICES.

## EROSION OF PUBLIC TRUST

MANY CITIZENS AND PUBLIC FIGURES BELIEVED THAT THE SPOILS SYSTEM ERODED PUBLIC TRUST IN GOVERNMENT. WHEN APPOINTMENTS APPEARED TO BE BASED ON POLITICAL CONNECTIONS RATHER THAN PUBLIC GOOD, IT FOSTERED CYNICISM AND A PERCEPTION THAT THE GOVERNMENT SERVED THE INTERESTS OF THE PARTY RATHER THAN THE NATION. THIS WAS SEEN AS A DANGEROUS DEPARTURE FROM THE IDEALS OF CIVIC VIRTUE AND PUBLIC SERVICE.

## THE LONG-TERM LEGACY OF JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE

THE INFLUENCE OF JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE EXTENDED FAR BEYOND THE JACKSON ADMINISTRATION ITSELF, LEAVING AN INDELIBLE MARK ON AMERICAN POLITICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY. WHILE THE MOST OVERT MANIFESTATIONS OF THE SPOILS SYSTEM EVENTUALLY WANED, ITS UNDERLYING PRINCIPLES AND THE DEBATES IT IGNITED CONTINUED TO SHAPE GOVERNANCE.

## THE CIVIL SERVICE REFORM MOVEMENT

THE WIDESPREAD CRITICISM OF THE SPOILS SYSTEM EVENTUALLY COALESCED INTO THE CIVIL SERVICE REFORM MOVEMENT IN THE LATTER HALF OF THE 19TH CENTURY. SPURRED BY EVENTS LIKE THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JAMES GARFIELD BY A DISGRUNTLED OFFICE SEEKER, REFORMERS ADVOCATED FOR A MERIT-BASED CIVIL SERVICE SYSTEM. THIS MOVEMENT CULMINATED IN THE PENDLETON CIVIL SERVICE REFORM ACT OF 1883, WHICH ESTABLISHED A COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION SYSTEM FOR MANY FEDERAL APPOINTMENTS, GRADUALLY MOVING AWAY FROM THE PURE SPOILS SYSTEM.

# ENDURING DEBATES ABOUT GOVERNMENT APPOINTMENTS

THE DEBATES SURROUNDING JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE LAID THE GROUNDWORK FOR ONGOING DISCUSSIONS ABOUT THE BALANCE BETWEEN POLITICAL APPOINTMENT AND PROFESSIONAL EXPERTISE IN GOVERNMENT. EVEN WITH THE ADVENT OF CIVIL SERVICE REFORMS, POLITICAL APPOINTMENTS TO HIGH-LEVEL POSITIONS, AMBASSADORSHIPS, AND ADVISORY ROLES REMAIN A SIGNIFICANT ASPECT OF AMERICAN GOVERNANCE. THE TENSION BETWEEN ENSURING LOYALTY AND COMPETENCE CONTINUES TO BE A RECURRING THEME IN DISCUSSIONS ABOUT PRESIDENTIAL NOMINATIONS AND THE COMPOSITION OF GOVERNMENT AGENCIES.

FURTHERMORE, THE JACKSONIAN ERA'S FOCUS ON PARTY ORGANIZATION AND ITS USE OF PATRONAGE TO STRENGTHEN PARTY MACHINERY HAD A LASTING IMPACT ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF AMERICAN POLITICAL PARTIES. THE EMPHASIS ON DISCIPLINED PARTY STRUCTURES, ELECTORAL MOBILIZATION, AND THE REWARDS OF POLITICAL SUCCESS BECAME INGRAINED IN THE POLITICAL LANDSCAPE, INFLUENCING CAMPAIGN STRATEGIES AND PARTY PLATFORMS FOR GENERATIONS TO COME. THE LEGACY OF JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE IS THUS A COMPLEX TAPESTRY WOVEN WITH THREADS OF DEMOCRATIC ASPIRATION, POLITICAL PRAGMATISM, AND ENDURING QUESTIONS ABOUT THE IDEAL FUNCTIONING OF A REPRESENTATIVE GOVERNMENT.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT THE CHARACTERISTICS OF PATRONAGE JACKSONIAN

### Q: WHAT WAS THE PRIMARY GOAL OF JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE?

A: THE PRIMARY GOAL OF JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE, OFTEN REFERRED TO AS THE SPOILS SYSTEM, WAS TO REWARD POLITICAL SUPPORTERS WITH GOVERNMENT POSITIONS AND TO REMOVE POLITICAL OPPONENTS FROM OFFICE. THIS WAS BELIEVED TO ENSURE LOYALTY TO THE PRESIDENT'S AGENDA, PROMOTE EFFICIENCY BY BRINGING IN FRESH PERSPECTIVES, AND MAKE GOVERNMENT MORE RESPONSIVE TO THE WILL OF THE PEOPLE AS EXPRESSED THROUGH ELECTIONS.

### Q: HOW DID JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE DIFFER FROM EARLIER SYSTEMS OF GOVERNMENT APPOINTMENTS?

A: BEFORE JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE, GOVERNMENT POSITIONS WERE OFTEN HELD BY A MORE STABLE BUREAUCRACY, WITH APPOINTMENTS INFLUENCED BY PERCEIVED MERIT, CONNECTIONS, AND EXPERIENCE. JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE MARKED A SIGNIFICANT SHIFT TOWARDS MAKING POLITICAL LOYALTY THE PARAMOUNT QUALIFICATION, LEADING TO A MUCH HIGHER TURNOVER RATE IN FEDERAL POSITIONS AND A MORE SYSTEMATIC USE OF APPOINTMENTS FOR POLITICAL GAIN.

### Q: WHAT WERE THE MAIN ARGUMENTS USED TO JUSTIFY THE SPOILS SYSTEM DURING THE JACKSONIAN ERA?

A: THE MAIN JUSTIFICATIONS INCLUDED DEMOCRATIC EGALITARIANISM, THE BELIEF THAT ORDINARY CITIZENS WERE CAPABLE OF PUBLIC SERVICE; THE IDEA THAT GOVERNMENT SHOULD REFLECT THE "WILL OF THE PEOPLE" AS DETERMINED BY ELECTIONS; THE ARGUMENT THAT ROTATION IN OFFICE WOULD PREVENT CORRUPTION AND THE ENTRENCHMENT OF AN ARISTOCRATIC BUREAUCRACY; AND THE PRACTICAL NEED TO STRENGTHEN AND MOBILIZE THE POLITICAL PARTY.

### Q: WHO WERE THE MAIN CRITICS OF JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE, AND WHAT WERE THEIR PRIMARY CONCERNS?

A: CRITICS INCLUDED FIGURES LIKE HENRY CLAY AND LATER REFORMERS. THEIR PRIMARY CONCERNS WERE THE DISREGARD FOR MERIT AND COMPETENCE IN APPOINTMENTS, WHICH THEY BELIEVED LED TO INEFFICIENCY AND POOR GOVERNANCE; THE POTENTIAL FOR INCREASED POLITICAL CORRUPTION AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF POWERFUL PARTY MACHINES; THE INSTABILITY CAUSED BY FREQUENT TURNOVER, HINDERING EXPERTISE; AND THE EROSION OF PUBLIC TRUST IN A GOVERNMENT PERCEIVED AS SERVING

PARTY INTERESTS RATHER THAN THE PUBLIC GOOD.

## **Q: DID JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE LEAD TO THE PERMANENT ESTABLISHMENT OF THE SPOILS SYSTEM IN THE UNITED STATES?**

A: No, JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE DID NOT LEAD TO THE PERMANENT ESTABLISHMENT OF THE PURE SPOILS SYSTEM. WHILE IT WAS A DOMINANT PRACTICE FOR A SIGNIFICANT PERIOD, WIDESPREAD CRITICISM AND PUBLIC OUTCRY EVENTUALLY LED TO THE CIVIL SERVICE REFORM MOVEMENT. THIS MOVEMENT RESULTED IN LEGISLATION LIKE THE PENDLETON ACT OF 1883, WHICH ESTABLISHED A MERIT-BASED SYSTEM FOR MANY FEDERAL APPOINTMENTS, GRADUALLY MOVING AWAY FROM THE SPOILS SYSTEM.

## **Q: WHAT IS THE LASTING IMPACT OF JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE ON MODERN AMERICAN POLITICS?**

A: THE LEGACY OF JACKSONIAN PATRONAGE IS EVIDENT IN ONGOING DEBATES ABOUT THE BALANCE BETWEEN POLITICAL APPOINTMENTS AND PROFESSIONAL EXPERTISE IN GOVERNMENT. WHILE OVERT SPOILS ARE NOW LARGELY CURTAILED IN THE FEDERAL CIVIL SERVICE, THE PRINCIPLES OF REWARDING LOYALTY THROUGH APPOINTMENTS AT HIGHER LEVELS, THE STRENGTH OF PARTY ORGANIZATIONS, AND THE STRATEGIC USE OF GOVERNMENT POSITIONS TO ACHIEVE POLITICAL GOALS CAN STILL BE OBSERVED IN CONTEMPORARY POLITICS.
