THE 17TH EDITION, PUBLISHED IN 2017, REFINES AND UPDATES PREVIOUS VERSIONS, OFFERING CLEAR GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARLY COMMUNICATION. AT ITS HEART, CHICAGO STYLE EMPHASIZES ACCURACY AND READER CONVENIENCE, ALLOWING READERS TO EASILY LOCATE THE ORIGINAL SOURCE OF INFORMATION. TWO PRIMARY SYSTEMS EXIST WITHIN CHICAGO: THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM AND THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM. THE CHOICE BETWEEN THESE TYPICALLY DEPENDS ON THE DISCIPLINE AND SPECIFIC JOURNAL OR PUBLISHER REQUIREMENTS.

REGARDLESS OF THE SYSTEM CHOSEN, THE FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLE REMAINS THE SAME: TO PROVIDE SUFFICIENT INFORMATION FOR THE READER TO IDENTIFY AND RETRIEVE THE CITED SOURCE. THIS INVOLVES METICULOUSLY DETAILING ELEMENTS SUCH AS AUTHOR NAMES, TITLES, PUBLICATION DATES, PAGE NUMBERS, AND PUBLISHERS. PRECISION IN THESE DETAILS IS NON-NEGOTIABLE FOR MAINTAINING ACADEMIC INTEGRITY. FURTHERMORE, THE 17TH EDITION OFFERS UPDATED GUIDANCE ON DIGITAL RESOURCES, WHICH ARE INCREASINGLY PREVALENT IN MODERN RESEARCH, ENSURING THAT EVEN THE MOST CONTEMPORARY SOURCES CAN BE CITED EFFECTIVELY.

THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM IN DETAIL

THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM, OFTEN PREFERRED IN FIELDS LIKE HISTORY, LITERATURE, AND THE ARTS, USES FOOTNOTES OR ENDNOTES TO CITE SOURCES WITHIN THE TEXT. THESE NOTES PROVIDE DETAILED INFORMATION ABOUT THE SOURCE AT THE POINT OF CITATION. A CORRESPONDING BIBLIOGRAPHY, APPEARING AT THE END OF THE WORK, LISTS ALL SOURCES CONSULTED

AND CITED.

FOOTNOTES ARE PLACED AT THE BOTTOM OF THE PAGE WHERE THE CITATION OCCURS, WHILE ENDNOTES ARE COLLECTED AT THE END OF THE CHAPTER OR THE ENTIRE DOCUMENT. THE FIRST CITATION OF A SOURCE IN THE NOTES TYPICALLY INCLUDES FULL PUBLICATION DETAILS. SUBSEQUENT CITATIONS OF THE SAME SOURCE ARE GENERALLY SHORTENED, OFTEN INCLUDING THE AUTHOR'S LAST NAME, A SHORTENED TITLE, AND THE PAGE NUMBER. THIS SYSTEM IS PARTICULARLY USEFUL FOR LENGTHY WORKS WHERE READERS MIGHT NEED TO REFER BACK TO SPECIFIC SOURCES FREQUENTLY.

COMMON SOURCE TYPES IN NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY

MASTERING THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE 17TH EDITION CITATION REQUIRES FAMILIARITY WITH THE CORRECT FORMATTING FOR VARIOUS SOURCE TYPES. THE DETAILS CAN VARY, BUT THE UNDERLYING STRUCTURE AIMS TO CONVEY ESSENTIAL BIBLIOGRAPHIC INFORMATION.

- **BOOKS:** FOR A BOOK, THE STANDARD NOTE FORMAT INCLUDES AUTHOR'S FULL NAME, TITLE OF THE BOOK (ITALICIZED), PUBLICATION INFORMATION (PLACE, PUBLISHER, YEAR), AND THE SPECIFIC PAGE NUMBER CITED. FOR EXAMPLE: 1. JANE DOE, *THE ART OF CITATION* (CHICAGO: UNIVERSITY PRESS, 2020), 45.
- **JOURNAL ARTICLES:** CITING A JOURNAL ARTICLE INVOLVES THE AUTHOR'S NAME, ARTICLE TITLE (IN QUOTATION MARKS), JOURNAL TITLE (ITALICIZED), VOLUME AND ISSUE NUMBERS, PUBLICATION YEAR, AND THE PAGE RANGE OF THE ARTICLE, ALONG WITH THE SPECIFIC PAGE NUMBER CITED IN THE NOTE. FOR INSTANCE: 2. JOHN SMITH, "DIGITAL SCHOLARSHIP," *JOURNAL OF ACADEMIC WRITING* 15, no. 2 (2021): 112, ACCESSED OCTOBER 26, 2023, DOI: 10.1000/JAJW.15.2.112.
- **WEBSITES AND ONLINE SOURCES:** FOR ONLINE CONTENT, INCLUDE THE AUTHOR OR ORGANIZATION, TITLE OF THE SPECIFIC PAGE OR ARTICLE (IN QUOTATION MARKS), WEBSITE NAME (ITALICIZED), DATE OF PUBLICATION OR LAST UPDATE, AND THE URL, ALONG WITH THE DATE OF ACCESS. EXAMPLE: 3. ACADEMIC WRITING INSTITUTE, "GUIDE TO CMOS 17," *WRITING RESOURCES*, LAST MODIFIED MARCH 15, 2023, [HTTPS://WWW.WRITINGINSTITUTE.EDU/CMOS17](https://www.writinginstitute.edu/cmos17).
- **NEWSPAPER AND MAGAZINE ARTICLES:** SIMILAR TO JOURNAL ARTICLES, THESE REQUIRE AUTHOR, ARTICLE TITLE, PUBLICATION NAME (ITALICIZED), DATE, AND PAGE NUMBER. FOR ONLINE VERSIONS, INCLUDE THE URL AND ACCESS DATE.

THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM EXPLAINED

THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM, OFTEN FAVORED IN THE SCIENCES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES, USES PARENTHETICAL IN-TEXT CITATIONS THAT INCLUDE THE AUTHOR'S LAST NAME AND THE YEAR OF PUBLICATION. A CORRESPONDING REFERENCE LIST AT THE END OF THE DOCUMENT PROVIDES FULL BIBLIOGRAPHIC DETAILS FOR ALL CITED SOURCES.

THIS SYSTEM IS DESIGNED FOR A QUICK AUTHOR AND DATE REFERENCE WITHIN THE TEXT, ALLOWING READERS TO IMMEDIATELY IDENTIFY THE GENERAL TIME FRAME OF THE RESEARCH. IT IS PARTICULARLY EFFECTIVE FOR FIELDS WHERE THE CHRONOLOGICAL DEVELOPMENT OF IDEAS IS IMPORTANT. THE REFERENCE LIST, MUCH LIKE THE BIBLIOGRAPHY IN THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM, SERVES AS THE COMPREHENSIVE LOCATOR FOR ALL SOURCES USED.

COMMON SOURCE TYPES IN AUTHOR-DATE

FORMATTING FOR THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM FOLLOWS A SIMILAR LOGIC TO THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM, BUT THE PRESENTATION IN THE REFERENCE LIST AND THE IN-TEXT CITATIONS DIFFER.

- **BOOKS:** IN THE REFERENCE LIST, THE FORMAT IS AUTHOR'S LAST NAME, FIRST NAME. *TITLE OF BOOK*. PUBLICATION PLACE: PUBLISHER, YEAR. FOR EXAMPLE: DOE, JANE. *THE ART OF CITATION*. CHICAGO: UNIVERSITY PRESS, 2020.
- **JOURNAL ARTICLES:** THE REFERENCE LIST ENTRY INCLUDES AUTHOR'S LAST NAME, FIRST NAME. "ARTICLE TITLE." *JOURNAL TITLE* VOLUME, no. ISSUE (YEAR): PAGE RANGE. A DOI OR URL IS ALSO INCLUDED IF AVAILABLE. EXAMPLE: SMITH, JOHN. "DIGITAL SCHOLARSHIP." *JOURNAL OF ACADEMIC WRITING* 15, no. 2 (2021): 105–120.

- **WEBSITES AND ONLINE SOURCES:** AUTHOR OR ORGANIZATION. "TITLE OF SPECIFIC PAGE." *WEBSITE NAME*. LAST MODIFIED DATE. URL. EXAMPLE: ACADEMIC WRITING INSTITUTE. "GUIDE TO CMOS 17." *WRITING RESOURCES*. LAST MODIFIED MARCH 15, 2023. [HTTPS://WWW.WRITINGINSTITUTE.EDU/CMOS17](https://www.writinginstitute.edu/cmos17).
- **NEWSPAPER AND MAGAZINE ARTICLES:** SIMILAR TO JOURNAL ARTICLES, WITH AUTHOR, TITLE, PUBLICATION, DATE, AND PAGE/URL.

IN-TEXT CITATIONS IN CHICAGO STYLE

IN THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM, IN-TEXT CITATIONS ARE SIGNALLED BY A SUPERScript NUMBER, CORRESPONDING TO A FOOTNOTE OR ENDNOTE. FOR EXAMPLE, IF YOU MENTION A FACT FROM A BOOK, YOU WOULD PLACE A SUPERScript '1' AFTER THE STATEMENT AND THEN PROVIDE THE FULL OR SHORTENED NOTE INFORMATION AT THE BOTTOM OF THE PAGE OR END OF THE DOCUMENT.

IN THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM, IN-TEXT CITATIONS ARE ENCLOSED IN PARENTHESES. THE BASIC FORMAT IS (AUTHORLASTNAME YEAR). FOR EXAMPLE: (DOE 2020). IF YOU ARE QUOTING DIRECTLY, YOU MUST ALSO INCLUDE THE PAGE NUMBER: (DOE 2020, 45). IF THE AUTHOR'S NAME IS ALREADY PART OF THE SENTENCE, ONLY THE YEAR AND PAGE NUMBER ARE NEEDED IN PARENTHESES: AS DOE EXPLAINS (2020, 45)...

THE BIBLIOGRAPHY AND REFERENCE LIST

BOTH CITATION SYSTEMS CONCLUDE WITH A LIST OF ALL SOURCES. IN THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM, THIS LIST IS CALLED A BIBLIOGRAPHY AND IS TYPICALLY ARRANGED ALPHABETICALLY BY THE AUTHOR'S LAST NAME. IT INCLUDES ALL SOURCES CITED IN THE NOTES AND MAY ALSO INCLUDE SOURCES CONSULTED BUT NOT DIRECTLY CITED, DEPENDING ON THE AUTHOR'S INTENT AND PUBLISHER'S GUIDELINES. THE FORMATTING IN THE BIBLIOGRAPHY MIRRORS THE FULL NOTE ENTRIES BUT OMITTS PAGE NUMBERS FOR THE CITATION ITSELF.

IN THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM, THIS LIST IS CALLED A REFERENCE LIST. IT IS ALSO ALPHABETIZED BY THE AUTHOR'S LAST NAME. EACH ENTRY IN THE REFERENCE LIST PROVIDES COMPLETE BIBLIOGRAPHIC INFORMATION FOR THE SOURCE, SERVING AS THE KEY TO UNDERSTANDING THE PARENTHEetical IN-TEXT CITATIONS. THE PRIMARY DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A BIBLIOGRAPHY AND A REFERENCE LIST IS THAT A REFERENCE LIST TYPICALLY ONLY INCLUDES SOURCES THAT HAVE BEEN CITED IN THE TEXT, WHEREAS A BIBLIOGRAPHY CAN BE MORE COMPREHENSIVE.

SPECIAL CASES AND ADVANCED CHICAGO CITATION

THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE 17TH EDITION CITATION ADDRESSES NUMEROUS SPECIAL CASES, INCLUDING CITING WORKS WITH MULTIPLE AUTHORS, CORPORATE AUTHORS, EDITED VOLUMES, DISSERTATIONS, GOVERNMENT DOCUMENTS, AND EVEN WORKS THAT ARE PART OF A LARGER COLLECTION. FOR INSTANCE, WHEN CITING A WORK WITH TWO AUTHORS, BOTH NAMES ARE TYPICALLY INCLUDED IN THE CITATION. FOR WORKS WITH THREE OR MORE AUTHORS, THE FIRST AUTHOR'S NAME IS GIVEN, FOLLOWED BY "ET AL." IN THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM. IN THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM'S REFERENCE LIST, ALL AUTHORS ARE GENERALLY LISTED. UNDERSTANDING THESE NUANCES ENSURES THAT YOUR CITATIONS ARE NOT ONLY ACCURATE BUT ALSO COMPLETE AND CONSISTENT, REFLECTING A THOROUGH GRASP OF ACADEMIC CONVENTION.

Q: HOW DO I CITE A BOOK WITH TWO AUTHORS USING THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE 17TH EDITION CITATION?

A: IN THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM, THE FIRST NOTE WOULD LIST BOTH AUTHORS: 1. JANE DOE AND JOHN SMITH, *BOOK TITLE* (CITY: PUBLISHER, YEAR), 50. SUBSEQUENT NOTES MIGHT SHORTEN THIS. IN THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM REFERENCE LIST, IT WOULD BE DOE, JANE, AND JOHN SMITH. *BOOK TITLE*. CITY: PUBLISHER, YEAR.

Q: WHAT IS THE CORRECT WAY TO CITE A WEBSITE IN THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE 17TH EDITION CITATION?

A: FOR A WEBSITE, YOU TYPICALLY INCLUDE THE AUTHOR OR ORGANIZATION, THE TITLE OF THE SPECIFIC PAGE OR ARTICLE IN QUOTATION MARKS, THE WEBSITE NAME IN ITALICS, THE LAST MODIFIED DATE (IF AVAILABLE), AND THE URL, FOLLOWED BY THE DATE YOU ACCESSED IT. FOR EXAMPLE: JANE DOE, "ABOUT THIS SITE," *EXAMPLE WEBSITE*, LAST MODIFIED JANUARY 1, 2023, [HTTPS://WWW.EXAMPLE.COM/ABOUT](https://www.example.com/about).

Q: HOW DO I HANDLE CITING THE SAME SOURCE MULTIPLE TIMES IN THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM?

A: THE FIRST FULL CITATION PROVIDES COMPLETE INFORMATION. SUBSEQUENT CITATIONS OF THE SAME SOURCE ARE USUALLY SHORTENED TO INCLUDE THE AUTHOR'S LAST NAME, A SHORTENED TITLE OF THE WORK, AND THE SPECIFIC PAGE NUMBER (E.G., DOE, *BOOK TITLE*, 55). IF CITING THE SAME PAGE NUMBER AS THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING NOTE, USE "IBID."

Q: DOES THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE 17TH EDITION CITATION DIFFERENTIATE BETWEEN A BIBLIOGRAPHY AND A REFERENCE LIST?

A: YES, THE TERMS ARE USED DISTINCTLY. A BIBLIOGRAPHY, USED WITH THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM, MAY INCLUDE SOURCES CONSULTED BUT NOT DIRECTLY CITED. A REFERENCE LIST, USED WITH THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM, TYPICALLY INCLUDES ONLY SOURCES THAT HAVE BEEN CITED IN THE TEXT.

Q: HOW DO I CITE AN ARTICLE FROM A JOURNAL WITH A DOI USING CHICAGO STYLE 17TH EDITION CITATION?

A: WHEN CITING A JOURNAL ARTICLE WITH A DOI, YOU INCLUDE IT AT THE END OF THE CITATION. FOR THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM, A NOTE MIGHT LOOK LIKE: JOHN SMITH, "DIGITAL SCHOLARSHIP," *JOURNAL OF ACADEMIC WRITING* 15, no. 2 (2021): 112, doi:10.1000/jajw.15.2.112. THE REFERENCE LIST IN THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM FOLLOWS A SIMILAR PATTERN.

Q: IS THERE A SPECIFIC WAY TO CITE SOCIAL MEDIA POSTS IN THE CHICAGO MANUAL

OF STYLE 17TH EDITION CITATION?

A: YES, THE 17TH EDITION PROVIDES GUIDANCE FOR CITING SOCIAL MEDIA. THIS TYPICALLY INCLUDES THE AUTHOR'S USERNAME, THE CONTENT OF THE POST (QUOTED), THE PLATFORM NAME, AND THE DATE AND URL OF THE POST. FOR EXAMPLE:
ATJANEDOE (JANE DOE), "EXCITED TO SHARE MY NEW RESEARCH!" TWITTER, MARCH 15, 2023,
HTTPS://TWITTER.COM/JANEDOE/STATUS/1234567890.

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
