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THE IMPORTANCE OF CMOS FOR FREELANCE EDITORS

FOR FREELANCE PUBLISHING EDITORS, THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE SERVES AS THE ULTIMATE ARBITER OF GOOD PRACTICE. IT PROVIDES A STANDARDIZED FRAMEWORK THAT ENSURES UNIFORMITY AND PROFESSIONALISM ACROSS DIVERSE PROJECTS AND CLIENTS. ADHERENCE TO CMOS SIGNIFIES A COMMITMENT TO QUALITY AND A DEEP RESPECT FOR THE AUTHOR'S WORK, ALLOWING THE EDITOR TO ENHANCE IT WITHOUT INTRODUCING STYLISTIC INCONSISTENCIES. IN THE FREELANCE REALM, WHERE REPUTATION IS BUILT ON RELIABILITY AND EXPERTISE, A STRONG COMMAND OF CMOS IS A SIGNIFICANT DIFFERENTIATOR, ENABLING EDITORS TO CONFIDENTLY TACKLE A WIDE RANGE OF EDITORIAL TASKS FROM DEVELOPMENTAL EDITING TO COPYEDITING AND PROOFREADING.

CLIENTS, WHETHER THEY ARE INDEPENDENT AUTHORS, SMALL PRESSES, OR LARGER PUBLISHING HOUSES, OFTEN HAVE SPECIFIC STYLE GUIDE PREFERENCES. WHILE SOME MAY OPT FOR AP STYLE OR ANOTHER GUIDE, CMOS REMAINS THE DEFAULT FOR A VAST NUMBER OF ACADEMIC AND TRADE PUBLISHERS. THEREFORE, FREELANCE EDITORS PROFICIENT IN CMOS ARE HIGHLY SOUGHT AFTER. THIS PROFICIENCY NOT ONLY STREAMLINES THE EDITING PROCESS BUT ALSO MINIMIZES THE NEED FOR EXTENSIVE CLIENT REVISIONS RELATED TO STYLISTIC MATTERS, FOSTERING SMOOTHER WORKING RELATIONSHIPS AND ENCOURAGING REPEAT BUSINESS.

KEY AREAS OF CMOS FOR PUBLISHING EDITORS

THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE IS AN EXTENSIVE GUIDE, BUT CERTAIN SECTIONS ARE PARTICULARLY CRUCIAL FOR FREELANCE PUBLISHING EDITORS TO MASTER. THESE CORE AREAS FORM THE BACKBONE OF MOST EDITORIAL WORK, ENSURING CLARITY, READABILITY, AND A CONSISTENT PRESENTATION OF THE TEXT. UNDERSTANDING THESE PRINCIPLES ALLOWS EDITORS TO MAKE INFORMED DECISIONS THAT ENHANCE THE MANUSCRIPT WITHOUT ALTERING THE AUTHOR'S VOICE.

PUNCTUATION AND GRAMMAR

CORRECT PUNCTUATION AND GRAMMAR ARE THE BEDROCK OF CLEAR COMMUNICATION. CMOS OFFERS DETAILED GUIDANCE ON THE CORRECT USAGE OF COMMAS, SEMICOLONS, COLONS, EM DASHES, AND HYPHENS, OFTEN WITH NUANCES THAT DIFFER FROM OTHER STYLE GUIDES. FOR INSTANCE, ITS TREATMENT OF THE SERIAL COMMA (THE OXFORD COMMA) IS A POINT OF FREQUENT DISCUSSION, AND CMOS STRONGLY ADVOCATES FOR ITS CONSISTENT USE TO PREVENT AMBIGUITY. FURTHERMORE, THE MANUAL PROVIDES AUTHORITATIVE ADVICE ON SENTENCE STRUCTURE, VERB TENSE, PRONOUN AGREEMENT, AND MODIFIER PLACEMENT, ENSURING GRAMMATICAL CORRECTNESS AND LOGICAL FLOW WITHIN SENTENCES AND PARAGRAPHS.

EDITORS MUST BE VIGILANT IN IDENTIFYING AND CORRECTING ANY GRAMMATICAL ERRORS THAT COULD OBSCURE MEANING OR DISTRACT THE READER. THIS INCLUDES SUBJECT-VERB AGREEMENT ISSUES, MISPLACED MODIFIERS, PRONOUN REFERENCE PROBLEMS, AND PARALLEL STRUCTURE INCONSISTENCIES. CMOS OFFERS CLEAR EXAMPLES AND RATIONALES FOR ITS RECOMMENDATIONS, EMPOWERING EDITORS TO APPLY THESE RULES WITH CONFIDENCE AND PRECISION.

CAPITALIZATION

CONSISTENT AND APPROPRIATE CAPITALIZATION IS VITAL FOR MAINTAINING A PROFESSIONAL APPEARANCE AND GUIDING THE READER'S EYE. CMOS PROVIDES RULES FOR CAPITALIZING PROPER NOUNS, TITLES OF WORKS, AND SPECIFIC TERMS WITHIN A TEXT. WHILE GENERAL RULES FOR CAPITALIZING NOUNS AND ADJECTIVES DERIVED FROM PROPER NOUNS ARE STRAIGHTFORWARD, EXCEPTIONS AND SPECIFIC CONTEXTS, SUCH AS THE CAPITALIZATION OF JOB TITLES OR TERMS IN HEADINGS, REQUIRE CAREFUL ATTENTION. FREELANCE EDITORS NEED TO APPLY THESE RULES UNIFORMLY THROUGHOUT A MANUSCRIPT.

FOR EXAMPLE, CMOS SPECIFIES WHEN TO CAPITALIZE TERMS LIKE "UNIVERSITY" VERSUS "UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO" OR "INTERNET" VERSUS "INTERNET." UNDERSTANDING THESE DISTINCTIONS PREVENTS STYLISTIC INCONSISTENCIES THAT CAN UNDERMINE THE MANUSCRIPT'S CREDIBILITY. EDITORS SHOULD CONSULT CMOS FOR GUIDANCE ON CAPITALIZATION IN TITLES, HEADINGS, AND SPECIFIC TECHNICAL OR CONCEPTUAL TERMS RELEVANT TO THE SUBJECT MATTER.

NUMBERS AND NUMERALS

CMOS OFFERS COMPREHENSIVE GUIDELINES ON WHEN TO SPELL OUT NUMBERS AND WHEN TO USE NUMERALS. GENERALLY, NUMBERS UNDER TEN ARE SPELLED OUT, WHILE LARGER NUMBERS ARE EXPRESSED IN NUMERALS. HOWEVER, THERE ARE NUMEROUS EXCEPTIONS, PARTICULARLY FOR SPECIFIC CONTEXTS LIKE DATES, AGES, MEASUREMENTS, AND STATISTICS. FOR INSTANCE, PERCENTAGES ARE TYPICALLY PRESENTED WITH NUMERALS AND THE PERCENT SIGN. CONSISTENCY IS KEY, AND EDITORS MUST APPLY THE CHOSEN CONVENTION UNIFORMLY.

A CRITICAL ASPECT FOR FREELANCE EDITORS IS UNDERSTANDING THE "CHICAGO STYLE" FOR NUMBERS, WHICH OFTEN DIFFERS FROM OTHER GUIDES. FOR EXAMPLE, CMOS TYPICALLY SPELLS OUT NUMBERS FROM ZERO TO ONE HUNDRED. EDITORS MUST ALSO BE AWARE OF CONVENTIONS FOR EXPRESSING LARGE NUMBERS, RANGES, AND SERIES OF NUMBERS WITHIN A TEXT TO ENSURE CLARITY AND READABILITY. IF A MANUSCRIPT DEALS HEAVILY WITH DATA, A THOROUGH UNDERSTANDING OF CMOS'S NUMERICAL CONVENTIONS IS ESSENTIAL.

SPELLING AND WORD DIVISION

WHILE MOST EDITORS RELY ON DICTIONARIES FOR SPELLING, CMOS PROVIDES GUIDANCE ON PREFERRED SPELLINGS, ESPECIALLY FOR WORDS WITH VARIANT SPELLINGS (E.G., "JUDGMENT" VS. "JUDGEMENT"). IT ALSO ADDRESSES COMPOUND WORDS AND THE CORRECT FORMATION OF PLURALS AND POSSESSIVES. WORD DIVISION AT THE END OF A LINE IS GENERALLY AVOIDED IN DIGITAL PUBLISHING, BUT CMOS OFFERS PRINCIPLES FOR SYLLABIFICATION SHOULD IT BECOME NECESSARY, EMPHASIZING THE AVOIDANCE OF AWKWARD OR MISLEADING BREAKS.

THE MANUAL ALSO TOUCHES UPON IDIOMATIC USAGE AND PREFERRED WORD CHOICES, HELPING EDITORS ENSURE THAT THE LANGUAGE IS PRECISE AND EFFECTIVE. FOR FREELANCE EDITORS, MAINTAINING A CONSISTENT SPELLING STANDARD, OFTEN DICTATED BY THE CLIENT OR THE INTENDED AUDIENCE, IS PARAMOUNT. THIS INCLUDES BEING AWARE OF AMERICAN VERSUS BRITISH ENGLISH SPELLING CONVENTIONS IF THE PROJECT REQUIRES IT.

QUOTATIONS

HANDLING QUOTATIONS ACCURATELY AND CONSISTENTLY IS A SIGNIFICANT RESPONSIBILITY FOR EDITORS. CMOS PROVIDES DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS ON INCORPORATING DIRECT QUOTATIONS, INCLUDING RULES FOR INTEGRATING THEM INTO THE TEXT, PUNCTUATING THEM CORRECTLY, AND HANDLING ALTERATIONS OR OMISSIONS. THE MANUAL DISTINGUISHES BETWEEN SHORT QUOTATIONS, WHICH ARE TYPICALLY RUN INTO THE TEXT AND ENCLOSED IN QUOTATION MARKS, AND LONGER QUOTATIONS, WHICH ARE SET OFF AS BLOCK QUOTES.

EDITORS MUST ALSO UNDERSTAND THE NUANCES OF USING SINGLE VERSUS DOUBLE QUOTATION MARKS, PARTICULARLY WHEN NESTING QUOTATIONS. CMOS OFFERS CLEAR GUIDELINES ON HOW TO USE ITALICS FOR EMPHASIS WITHIN QUOTATIONS AND HOW TO ATTRIBUTE SOURCES CORRECTLY. FOR SCHOLARLY OR JOURNALISTIC WORKS, MASTERING THE RULES FOR QUOTING AND CITING SOURCES IS INDISPENSABLE.

CITATIONS AND BIBLIOGRAPHIES

THIS IS ONE OF THE MOST INTRICATE AND CRITICAL AREAS FOR ACADEMIC AND SCHOLARLY EDITORS. CMOS OFFERS TWO PRIMARY SYSTEMS FOR CITATIONS: THE NOTES-AND-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM AND THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM. FREELANCE EDITORS MUST UNDERSTAND WHICH SYSTEM THEIR CLIENT REQUIRES AND APPLY IT RIGOROUSLY. EACH SYSTEM HAS SPECIFIC RULES FOR FORMATTING NOTES (FOOTNOTES OR ENDNOTES) AND BIBLIOGRAPHY ENTRIES.

THE NOTES-AND-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM IS COMMON IN HISTORY AND SOME HUMANITIES FIELDS, WHILE THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM IS PREVALENT IN SCIENCES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES. REGARDLESS OF THE SYSTEM, ACCURACY IN TRANSCRIBING INFORMATION SUCH AS AUTHOR NAMES, TITLES, PUBLICATION DATES, PAGE NUMBERS, AND URLS IS CRUCIAL. CMOS PROVIDES EXTENSIVE EXAMPLES FOR A WIDE VARIETY OF SOURCE TYPES, INCLUDING BOOKS, ARTICLES, WEBSITES, AND INTERVIEWS.

INDEXES

WHILE NOT ALL FREELANCE EDITORS ARE INDEXERS, A BASIC UNDERSTANDING OF INDEXING PRINCIPLES IS BENEFICIAL, ESPECIALLY FOR THOSE WORKING ON BOOKS. CMOS OFFERS GUIDANCE ON CREATING EFFECTIVE INDEXES, WHICH INVOLVES IDENTIFYING KEY TERMS, CONCEPTS, AND NAMES, AND ORGANIZING THEM ALPHABETICALLY WITH APPROPRIATE SUBENTRIES AND PAGE REFERENCES. A WELL-CONSTRUCTED INDEX SIGNIFICANTLY ENHANCES A BOOK'S USABILITY.

THE MANUAL DISCUSSES THE IMPORTANCE OF CONSISTENCY IN TERMINOLOGY, THE USE OF LEAD TERMS, AND THE CLARITY OF CROSS-REFERENCES. EDITORS WHO CAN OFFER INDEXING SERVICES OR PROVIDE FEEDBACK ON AN INDEX ARE HIGHLY VALUABLE. UNDERSTANDING THE STRUCTURE AND PURPOSE OF AN INDEX HELPS IN EVALUATING THE OVERALL COMPLETENESS AND ORGANIZATION OF A MANUSCRIPT.

MANUSCRIPT PREPARATION

CMOS PROVIDES DETAILED RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE PHYSICAL PREPARATION OF MANUSCRIPTS, WHICH IS ESPECIALLY RELEVANT FOR EDITORS WORKING WITH AUTHORS BEFORE SUBMISSION TO A PUBLISHER. THIS INCLUDES GUIDELINES ON FORMATTING FOR READABILITY, SUCH AS LINE SPACING, MARGINS, FONT CHOICES, AND THE PRESENTATION OF PRELIMINARY PAGES LIKE THE TITLE PAGE, COPYRIGHT PAGE, AND TABLE OF CONTENTS. PROPER MANUSCRIPT PREPARATION ENSURES THAT THE DOCUMENT IS EASY TO READ AND EDIT, AND THAT IT ADHERES TO INDUSTRY STANDARDS.

THE MANUAL ALSO COVERS THE ORGANIZATION OF ELEMENTS WITHIN A BOOK, SUCH AS CHAPTER BEGINNINGS, HEADINGS, SUBHEADINGS, AND THE PLACEMENT OF FIGURES AND TABLES. FOR FREELANCE EDITORS, UNDERSTANDING THESE FORMATTING CONVENTIONS HELPS THEM PRODUCE POLISHED DRAFTS THAT ARE READY FOR THE NEXT STAGE OF THE PUBLISHING PROCESS, WHETHER IT'S FOR A TRADITIONAL PUBLISHER OR A SELF-PUBLISHING PLATFORM.

APPLYING CMOS IN DIFFERENT PUBLISHING GENRES

THE APPLICATION OF THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE CAN VARY SUBTLY DEPENDING ON THE PUBLISHING GENRE. WHILE THE CORE PRINCIPLES REMAIN CONSISTENT, SPECIFIC CONVENTIONS MIGHT BE MORE EMPHASIZED OR ADAPTED. FOR INSTANCE, IN ACADEMIC PUBLISHING, THE CITATION AND BIBLIOGRAPHY RULES ARE PARAMOUNT, OFTEN REQUIRING ADHERENCE TO THE NOTES-AND-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM. FREELANCE EDITORS WORKING ON DISSERTATIONS, THESES, OR SCHOLARLY ARTICLES MUST BE EXCEPTIONALLY METICULOUS IN THIS REGARD.

IN TRADE PUBLISHING, THE FOCUS MIGHT SHIFT MORE TOWARDS NARRATIVE FLOW, CLARITY OF PROSE, AND ADHERENCE TO SIMPLER CONVENTIONS FOR NUMBERS AND CAPITALIZATION, OFTEN LEANING TOWARDS THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM FOR INTERNAL REFERENCES IF NOT ENTIRELY AVOIDING THEM. FOR FICTION, EDITORS MIGHT PAY CLOSE ATTENTION TO DIALOGUE PUNCTUATION, NARRATIVE VOICE CONSISTENCY, AND ENSURING SMOOTH TRANSITIONS BETWEEN SCENES. FOR NON-FICTION TRADE BOOKS, CLARITY OF EXPLANATIONS, CONSISTENCY IN TERMINOLOGY, AND ENGAGING PROSE ARE KEY, WITH CMOS PROVIDING THE FRAMEWORK TO ACHIEVE THESE GOALS.

STAYING UPDATED WITH CMOS REVISIONS

THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE IS NOT STATIC; IT UNDERGOES REVISIONS TO REFLECT EVOLVING LANGUAGE, TECHNOLOGY, AND PUBLISHING PRACTICES. THE LATEST EDITION, CURRENTLY THE 17TH, WAS PUBLISHED IN 2017, AND ONGOING UPDATES AND Q&As ARE AVAILABLE ONLINE. FOR FREELANCE PUBLISHING EDITORS, IT IS CRUCIAL TO STAY ABREAST OF THESE CHANGES. THIS ENSURES THAT THEIR KNOWLEDGE IS CURRENT AND THAT THEY ARE APPLYING THE MOST UP-TO-DATE STANDARDS.

SUBSCRIBING TO NEWSLETTERS, FOLLOWING REPUTABLE EDITING ORGANIZATIONS, OR REGULARLY VISITING THE UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO PRESS WEBSITE CAN HELP EDITORS STAY INFORMED. UNDERSTANDING THE RATIONALE BEHIND NEW OR REVISED GUIDELINES ALLOWS EDITORS TO IMPLEMENT THEM EFFECTIVELY AND EXPLAIN THEIR REASONING TO CLIENTS. PROACTIVE ENGAGEMENT WITH UPDATES DEMONSTRATES A COMMITMENT TO PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AND EXCELLENCE.

TOOLS AND RESOURCES FOR CMOS COMPLIANCE

WHILE THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE ITSELF IS THE PRIMARY RESOURCE, SEVERAL TOOLS AND SUPPLEMENTARY RESOURCES CAN AID FREELANCE EDITORS IN THEIR QUEST FOR CMOS COMPLIANCE. DICTIONARIES, THESAURUSES, AND GRAMMAR-CHECKING SOFTWARE ARE ESSENTIAL, BUT THEY SHOULD BE USED IN CONJUNCTION WITH, NOT AS REPLACEMENTS FOR, THE MANUAL. SPECIALIZED STYLE GUIDES AND ONLINE RESOURCES DEDICATED TO CMOS CAN OFFER PRACTICAL TIPS AND CLARIFICATIONS.

MANY FREELANCE EDITORS MAINTAIN A PERSONAL COPY OF THE CMOS, OFTEN THE PRINT VERSION FOR EASY REFERENCE,

ALONGSIDE DIGITAL ACCESS FOR QUICK LOOKUPS. ONLINE FORUMS AND COMMUNITIES FOR EDITORS CAN ALSO BE INVALUABLE FOR DISCUSSING COMPLEX CMOS ISSUES AND SHARING BEST PRACTICES. FURTHERMORE, INVESTING IN PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT COURSES OR WORKSHOPS FOCUSED ON THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE CAN SIGNIFICANTLY ENHANCE AN EDITOR'S EXPERTISE AND CONFIDENCE.

DEVELOPING EDITORIAL PROFICIENCY WITH CMOS

ACHIEVING TRUE EDITORIAL PROFICIENCY WITH THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE IS AN ONGOING JOURNEY. IT REQUIRES DILIGENT PRACTICE, CRITICAL THINKING, AND A WILLINGNESS TO CONTINUALLY LEARN AND REFINE ONE'S SKILLS. THE MORE MANUSCRIPTS A FREELANCE EDITOR WORKS ON WITH A FOCUS ON CMOS, THE MORE INTUITIVE ITS APPLICATION BECOMES. DEVELOPING AN EYE FOR DETAIL AND A SYSTEMATIC APPROACH TO APPLYING ITS RULES ARE KEY TO CONSISTENT SUCCESS.

FREELANCE EDITORS WHO MASTER CMOS ARE NOT JUST APPLYING A SET OF RULES; THEY ARE CULTIVATING A DEEP UNDERSTANDING OF LINGUISTIC CLARITY, STYLISTIC CONSISTENCY, AND THE FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES OF EFFECTIVE WRITTEN COMMUNICATION. THIS MASTERY EMPOWERS THEM TO SERVE THEIR CLIENTS AT THE HIGHEST LEVEL, CONTRIBUTING SIGNIFICANTLY TO THE QUALITY AND IMPACT OF PUBLISHED WORKS AND BUILDING A ROBUST AND RESPECTED FREELANCE CAREER.

FAQ: CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE FOR FREELANCE PUBLISHING EDITORS

Q: WHAT IS THE PRIMARY DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE NOTES-AND-BIBLIOGRAPHY AND AUTHOR-DATE CITATION SYSTEMS IN CMOS?

A: THE PRIMARY DIFFERENCE LIES IN HOW SOURCES ARE REFERENCED WITHIN THE TEXT AND COMPILED AT THE END. THE NOTES-AND-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM USES FOOTNOTES OR ENDNOTES FOR CITATIONS AND A BIBLIOGRAPHY OF ALL CITED WORKS. THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM USES IN-TEXT PARENTHETICAL CITATIONS (AUTHOR, YEAR, PAGE) AND A REFERENCE LIST OF ALL CITED WORKS.

Q: SHOULD I ALWAYS USE THE SERIAL COMMA (OXFORD COMMA) WHEN EDITING ACCORDING TO CMOS?

A: YES, THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE STRONGLY RECOMMENDS AND GENERALLY REQUIRES THE USE OF THE SERIAL COMMA IN A SERIES OF THREE OR MORE ITEMS TO AVOID AMBIGUITY.

Q: HOW DOES CMOS HANDLE CAPITALIZATION OF JOB TITLES?

A: CMOS GENERALLY ADVISES CAPITALIZING JOB TITLES WHEN THEY PRECEDE A NAME (E.G., PRESIDENT LINCOLN) BUT NOT WHEN THEY FOLLOW A NAME OR STAND ALONE AS A GENERAL REFERENCE (E.G., ABRAHAM LINCOLN, WHO WAS PRESIDENT). HOWEVER, SPECIFIC CONTEXTS AND CLIENT PREFERENCES CAN INFLUENCE THIS.

Q: WHAT IS THE GENERAL RULE FOR SPELLING OUT NUMBERS IN CMOS?

A: GENERALLY, CMOS RECOMMENDS SPELLING OUT NUMBERS FROM ZERO THROUGH ONE HUNDRED AND USING NUMERALS FOR NUMBERS 101 AND ABOVE. THERE ARE NUMEROUS EXCEPTIONS FOR SPECIFIC CONTEXTS LIKE DATES, AGES, AND STATISTICAL DATA.

Q: WHEN SHOULD A FREELANCE EDITOR USE THE LATEST EDITION OF CMOS?

A: A FREELANCE EDITOR SHOULD ALWAYS STRIVE TO USE THE MOST CURRENT EDITION OF THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE (CURRENTLY THE 17TH EDITION) UNLESS A CLIENT SPECIFICALLY REQUESTS ADHERENCE TO AN OLDER EDITION. STAYING CURRENT ENSURES COMPLIANCE WITH THE LATEST EDITORIAL STANDARDS.

Q: HOW CAN FREELANCE EDITORS ENSURE CONSISTENCY WHEN APPLYING CMOS RULES ACROSS A LONG MANUSCRIPT?

A: TO ENSURE CONSISTENCY, EDITORS SHOULD KEEP DETAILED NOTES ON ANY STYLISTIC DECISIONS MADE, ESPECIALLY FOR EXCEPTIONS OR CLIENT-SPECIFIC PREFERENCES. USING DIGITAL EDITING TOOLS THAT ALLOW FOR CUSTOM RULE CREATION OR STYLE SHEETS CAN ALSO BE HIGHLY BENEFICIAL. REGULAR REVIEW OF PREVIOUSLY EDITED SECTIONS CAN CATCH INCONSISTENCIES.

Q: IS IT ACCEPTABLE TO DEViate FROM CMOS IF A CLIENT REQUESTS IT?

A: YES, IT IS OFTEN ACCEPTABLE AND NECESSARY TO DEViate FROM CMOS IF A CLIENT HAS SPECIFIC STYLE PREFERENCES OR REQUIREMENTS, ESPECIALLY IF THEY HAVE THEIR OWN IN-HOUSE STYLE GUIDE. THE KEY IS TO CLEARLY UNDERSTAND AND DOCUMENT THESE DEVIATIONS AND APPLY THEM CONSISTENTLY.

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
