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UNDERSTANDING THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE (CMOS)

THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE (CMOS) IS A WIDELY ADOPTED STYLE GUIDE USED IN ACADEMIC AND PROFESSIONAL WRITING, PARTICULARLY IN THE HUMANITIES, SOCIAL SCIENCES, AND SOME SCIENCE FIELDS. DEVELOPED AND MAINTAINED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO PRESS, CMOS PROVIDES COMPREHENSIVE GUIDELINES ON GRAMMAR, PUNCTUATION, USAGE, AND, CRITICALLY, CITATION. ITS PRIMARY GOAL IS TO PROMOTE CLARITY, CONSISTENCY, AND PRECISION IN WRITTEN COMMUNICATION, ENABLING READERS TO EASILY FOLLOW THE AUTHOR'S ARGUMENTS AND TRACE THE SOURCES OF INFORMATION. FOR COLLEGE PROJECTS, ADHERING TO CMOS DEMONSTRATES A COMMITMENT TO ACADEMIC INTEGRITY AND SCHOLARLY PRACTICE, SIGNIFICANTLY ENHANCING THE PERCEIVED CREDIBILITY AND PROFESSIONALISM OF THE WORK.

CMOS IS KNOWN FOR ITS THOROUGHNESS, COVERING A VAST ARRAY OF STYLISTIC CONVENTIONS AND SOURCE TYPES. WHILE IT CAN APPEAR DAUNTING AT FIRST, UNDERSTANDING ITS CORE PRINCIPLES MAKES NAVIGATING ITS EXTENSIVE RULES MUCH MORE MANAGEABLE. THE MANUAL IS UPDATED PERIODICALLY TO REFLECT EVOLVING WRITING AND PUBLISHING STANDARDS, ENSURING ITS CONTINUED RELEVANCE IN ACADEMIC SETTINGS. STUDENTS TASKED WITH CHICAGO STYLE COLLEGE PROJECTS OFTEN FIND THAT A SOLID UNDERSTANDING OF ITS STRUCTURE AND PREFERRED METHODS CAN STREAMLINE THEIR WRITING AND RESEARCH PROCESS, PREVENTING COMMON ERRORS THAT CAN DETRACT FROM THEIR OVERALL GRADE.

THE TWO CITATION SYSTEMS IN CMOS

A FUNDAMENTAL ASPECT OF THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE IS ITS PROVISION OF TWO DISTINCT, YET EQUALLY VALID, CITATION SYSTEMS: THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM AND THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM. UNDERSTANDING THE STRENGTHS AND TYPICAL USE CASES OF EACH SYSTEM IS CRUCIAL FOR SELECTING THE APPROPRIATE ONE FOR YOUR COLLEGE PROJECTS.

THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM IS MORE TRADITIONAL AND IS COMMONLY FOUND IN HISTORY, LITERATURE, AND THE ARTS. IT RELIES ON FOOTNOTES OR ENDNOTES FOR CITATIONS WITHIN THE TEXT AND A COMPREHENSIVE BIBLIOGRAPHY AT THE END OF THE WORK. CONVERSELY, THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM, OFTEN FAVORED IN THE SCIENCES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES, USES

PARENTHETICAL IN-TEXT CITATIONS THAT INCLUDE THE AUTHOR'S LAST NAME AND THE PUBLICATION YEAR, WITH A CORRESPONDING REFERENCE LIST AT THE END. BOTH SYSTEMS REQUIRE METICULOUS ATTENTION TO DETAIL TO ENSURE ACCURACY AND AVOID PLAGIARISM.

NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM FOR COLLEGE PROJECTS

THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM IS CHARACTERIZED BY ITS USE OF NUMBERED FOOTNOTES OR ENDNOTES TO CITE SOURCES DIRECTLY WITHIN THE TEXT. WHEN A PIECE OF INFORMATION IS QUOTED, PARAPHRASED, OR SUMMARIZED FROM A SOURCE, A SUPERScript NUMBER IS PLACED AFTER THE RELEVANT SENTENCE OR CLAUSE. THIS NUMBER CORRESPONDS TO AN ENTRY IN THE FOOTNOTE (AT THE BOTTOM OF THE PAGE) OR ENDNOTE (AT THE END OF THE DOCUMENT) SECTION. THIS METHOD ALLOWS FOR DETAILED ANNOTATIONS AND COMMENTARY ALONGSIDE THE CITATIONS, WHICH CAN BE PARTICULARLY USEFUL FOR IN-DEPTH SCHOLARLY ANALYSIS IN DISCIPLINES LIKE HISTORY OR LITERATURE.

FOOTNOTES VS. ENDNOTES

FOOTNOTES APPEAR AT THE BOTTOM OF THE PAGE WHERE THE CITATION IS MADE, OFFERING IMMEDIATE CONTEXT FOR THE READER WITHOUT THEM HAVING TO TURN TO THE END OF THE DOCUMENT. THIS CAN ENHANCE THE READING FLOW, ESPECIALLY IN LONGER WORKS. ENDNOTES, ON THE OTHER HAND, ARE COLLECTED AT THE END OF THE MAIN TEXT, BEFORE THE BIBLIOGRAPHY. WHILE THEY ACHIEVE THE SAME CITATION PURPOSE, THEY REQUIRE THE READER TO NAVIGATE TO A SEPARATE SECTION. FOR MOST COLLEGE PROJECTS, THE CHOICE BETWEEN FOOTNOTES AND ENDNOTES IS OFTEN DICTATED BY INSTRUCTOR PREFERENCE OR ASSIGNMENT GUIDELINES, BUT BOTH ARE FULLY COMPLIANT WITH THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM.

BIBLIOGRAPHY REQUIREMENTS

A CRUCIAL COMPONENT OF THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM IS THE BIBLIOGRAPHY, WHICH LISTS ALL THE SOURCES THAT WERE CONSULTED AND CITED IN THE PAPER. THE BIBLIOGRAPHY IS TYPICALLY ORGANIZED ALPHABETICALLY BY AUTHOR'S LAST NAME. EACH ENTRY IN THE BIBLIOGRAPHY PROVIDES COMPLETE PUBLICATION INFORMATION, ALLOWING READERS TO LOCATE THE ORIGINAL SOURCE EASILY. THE FORMATTING OF EACH BIBLIOGRAPHIC ENTRY IS PRECISE, INCLUDING ELEMENTS SUCH AS AUTHOR NAMES, TITLES, PUBLICATION DATES, AND LOCATIONS. CONSISTENCY IN THIS FORMATTING IS PARAMOUNT FOR PRESENTING A PROFESSIONAL AND CREDIBLE ACADEMIC WORK.

AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM FOR COLLEGE PROJECTS

THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM OFFERS A MORE CONCISE APPROACH TO IN-TEXT CITATION, PLACING PARENTHETICAL REFERENCES DIRECTLY WITHIN THE TEXT, TYPICALLY AT THE END OF A SENTENCE OR CLAUSE. THESE CITATIONS USUALLY INCLUDE THE AUTHOR'S LAST NAME, THE YEAR OF PUBLICATION, AND SOMETIMES A PAGE NUMBER IF A DIRECT QUOTE IS USED. FOR EXAMPLE, A CITATION MIGHT APPEAR AS (SMITH 2020, 45). THIS SYSTEM IS FAVORED IN FIELDS WHERE THE CHRONOLOGY OF RESEARCH AND THE AUTHOR'S CONTRIBUTION ARE PARTICULARLY IMPORTANT, SUCH AS IN MANY SOCIAL AND NATURAL SCIENCES, AS IT IMMEDIATELY HIGHLIGHTS THE TEMPORAL CONTEXT OF THE CITED INFORMATION.

IN-TEXT CITATIONS IN AUTHOR-DATE

WHEN USING THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM FOR YOUR COLLEGE PROJECTS, THE IN-TEXT CITATIONS SERVE AS BRIEF POINTERS TO THE FULL SOURCE INFORMATION FOUND IN THE REFERENCE LIST. THE FORMAT IS GENERALLY STRAIGHTFORWARD: (AUTHORLASTNAME YEAR). IF YOU ARE DIRECTLY QUOTING A SOURCE, YOU MUST INCLUDE THE PAGE NUMBER(S) AFTER A COMMA: (AUTHORLASTNAME YEAR, Pagenumber). IT IS ALSO PERMISSIBLE TO INTEGRATE THE AUTHOR'S NAME INTO THE TEXT

OF YOUR SENTENCE, IN WHICH CASE ONLY THE YEAR AND PAGE NUMBER (IF APPLICABLE) NEED TO BE ENCLOSED IN PARENTHESES, SUCH AS: "AS SMITH ARGUES, ..." (2020, 45).

REFERENCE LIST FOR AUTHOR-DATE

SIMILAR TO THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM'S BIBLIOGRAPHY, THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM REQUIRES A COMPREHENSIVE LIST OF ALL SOURCES CITED IN THE PAPER, USUALLY TITLED "REFERENCES." THIS LIST IS ALSO ALPHABETIZED BY AUTHOR'S LAST NAME. EACH ENTRY IN THE REFERENCE LIST PROVIDES FULL BIBLIOGRAPHIC DETAILS. THE KEY DISTINCTION IS THAT THE YEAR OF PUBLICATION OFTEN APPEARS IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE AUTHOR'S NAME IN THE REFERENCE LIST ENTRY, FURTHER EMPHASIZING THE TEMPORAL ASPECT OF THE RESEARCH. ENSURING THAT EVERY IN-TEXT CITATION HAS A CORRESPONDING ENTRY IN THE REFERENCE LIST, AND VICE VERSA, IS CRITICAL FOR ACCURACY.

FORMATTING YOUR COLLEGE PROJECTS IN CHICAGO STYLE

BEYOND CITATION MECHANICS, THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE PROVIDES DETAILED GUIDELINES FOR THE OVERALL PHYSICAL PRESENTATION OF YOUR COLLEGE PROJECTS. THESE FORMATTING RULES CONTRIBUTE TO THE PROFESSIONAL APPEARANCE AND READABILITY OF YOUR WORK, HELPING YOUR INSTRUCTOR ASSESS YOUR CONTENT WITHOUT DISTRACTION. PROPER FORMATTING SIGNALS ATTENTION TO DETAIL AND ADHERENCE TO ACADEMIC CONVENTIONS, WHICH CAN INDIRECTLY INFLUENCE THE PERCEPTION OF YOUR RESEARCH QUALITY.

MANUSCRIPT PREPARATION

TITLE PAGE AND RUNNING HEADS

WHILE CHICAGO STYLE DOES NOT MANDATE A TITLE PAGE UNLESS SPECIFIED BY AN INSTRUCTOR, IT IS COMMON PRACTICE FOR COLLEGE PROJECTS. IF A TITLE PAGE IS REQUIRED, IT SHOULD INCLUDE THE PROJECT TITLE, YOUR NAME, THE COURSE NAME, THE INSTRUCTOR'S NAME, AND THE DATE. FOR LONGER WORKS OR THESES, CHICAGO STYLE ALSO OUTLINES REQUIREMENTS FOR RUNNING HEADS (OR HEADERS), WHICH ARE BRIEF TITLES THAT APPEAR AT THE TOP OF EACH PAGE. THESE ELEMENTS, WHILE SEEMINGLY MINOR, ARE PART OF THE COMPREHENSIVE STYLISTIC FRAMEWORK THAT DEFINES CHICAGO STYLE COLLEGE PROJECTS.

CITING VARIOUS SOURCES IN CHICAGO STYLE

ONE OF THE MOST CHALLENGING ASPECTS OF CHICAGO STYLE COLLEGE PROJECTS IS ACCURATELY CITING THE DIVERSE RANGE OF SOURCES STUDENTS ENCOUNTER, FROM BOOKS AND JOURNAL ARTICLES TO WEBSITES AND INTERVIEWS. EACH SOURCE TYPE HAS SPECIFIC FORMATTING REQUIREMENTS FOR BOTH IN-TEXT CITATIONS AND THE CORRESPONDING BIBLIOGRAPHY OR REFERENCE LIST ENTRIES. PRECISION IN CAPTURING ALL NECESSARY PUBLICATION DETAILS IS KEY TO PROVIDING COMPLETE AND VERIFIABLE SOURCE INFORMATION FOR YOUR READERS.

Books

CITING A BOOK IN CHICAGO STYLE REQUIRES INCLUDING THE AUTHOR'S NAME, THE FULL TITLE OF THE BOOK (ITALICIZED), THE PLACE OF PUBLICATION, THE PUBLISHER, AND THE YEAR OF PUBLICATION. FOR EXAMPLE, A BOOK IN A BIBLIOGRAPHY MIGHT LOOK LIKE: ROWLING, J.K. *HARRY POTTER AND THE SORCERER'S STONE*. NEW YORK: SCHOLASTIC PRESS, 1997. IN A FOOTNOTE OR ENDNOTE, THE ENTRY WOULD BE MORE DETAILED AND INCLUDE PAGE NUMBERS IF APPLICABLE.

JOURNAL ARTICLES

CITING JOURNAL ARTICLES INVOLVES PROVIDING THE AUTHOR'S NAME, THE ARTICLE TITLE (IN QUOTATION MARKS), THE JOURNAL TITLE (ITALICIZED), THE VOLUME AND ISSUE NUMBERS, THE YEAR OF PUBLICATION, AND THE PAGE RANGE OF THE ARTICLE. FOR EXAMPLE: SMITH, JOHN. "THE IMPACT OF TECHNOLOGY ON EDUCATION." *JOURNAL OF ACADEMIC RESEARCH* 15, NO. 2 (2021): 112-130. THE SPECIFIC DETAILS REQUIRED CAN VARY SLIGHTLY DEPENDING ON WHETHER IT'S A PRINT OR ONLINE JOURNAL, ESPECIALLY REGARDING DOIs OR URLS.

WEBSITES AND ONLINE SOURCES

CITING ONLINE SOURCES, SUCH AS WEBSITES OR ONLINE ARTICLES, REQUIRES CAREFUL ATTENTION TO DETAIL TO ENSURE THAT READERS CAN ACCESS THE SAME INFORMATION. ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS INCLUDE THE AUTHOR (IF AVAILABLE), THE TITLE OF THE SPECIFIC PAGE OR ARTICLE, THE NAME OF THE WEBSITE, THE PUBLICATION OR LAST UPDATED DATE, AND A URL. IT IS ALSO CRUCIAL TO INCLUDE AN ACCESS DATE, AS ONLINE CONTENT CAN CHANGE OR DISAPPEAR. FOR EXAMPLE: DOE, JANE. "UNDERSTANDING CHICAGO STYLE." *ACADEMIC WRITING HUB*, LAST UPDATED JANUARY 15, 2023. ACCESSED MARCH 10, 2024. [HTTPS://WWW.ACADEMICWRITINGHUB.COM/CHICAGO-STYLE](https://www.academicwritinghub.com/chicago-style).

COMMON PITFALLS IN CHICAGO STYLE FOR COLLEGE PROJECTS

DESPITE CLEAR GUIDELINES, STUDENTS OFTEN ENCOUNTER COMMON PITFALLS WHEN APPLYING THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE TO THEIR COLLEGE PROJECTS. THESE MISTAKES CAN RANGE FROM MINOR FORMATTING INCONSISTENCIES TO MORE SIGNIFICANT ERRORS IN CITATION APPLICATION, WHICH CAN DETRACT FROM THE OVERALL QUALITY AND CREDIBILITY OF THEIR ACADEMIC WORK. BEING AWARE OF THESE FREQUENT ERRORS CAN HELP STUDENTS PROACTIVELY AVOID THEM.

INCONSISTENT CITATION FORMATTING

ONE OF THE MOST PREVALENT ISSUES IS INCONSISTENCY IN CITATION FORMATTING. THIS CAN MANIFEST AS VARIATIONS IN PUNCTUATION, CAPITALIZATION, OR THE INCLUSION OF SPECIFIC PUBLICATION DETAILS ACROSS DIFFERENT ENTRIES IN THE BIBLIOGRAPHY OR REFERENCE LIST. FOR INSTANCE, ONE ENTRY MIGHT INCLUDE THE CITY OF PUBLICATION, WHILE ANOTHER OMITTS IT, OR THE FORMATTING OF ARTICLE TITLES MIGHT DIFFER. STRICT ADHERENCE TO THE SPECIFIC FORMAT FOR EACH SOURCE TYPE IS ESSENTIAL.

INCORRECT USE OF NOTES VS. TEXT CITATIONS

ANOTHER COMMON PITFALL IS THE INCORRECT APPLICATION OF THE CHOSEN CITATION SYSTEM. FOR THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM, STUDENTS MIGHT FORGET TO ADD A SUPERScript NUMBER TO THEIR TEXT OR MISPLACE IT. CONVERSELY, IN THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM, THEY MIGHT FORGET TO INCLUDE PAGE NUMBERS FOR DIRECT QUOTES OR INCORRECTLY FORMAT THE PARENTHETICAL CITATION. ENSURING THAT EVERY PIECE OF BORROWED INFORMATION IS CORRECTLY ATTRIBUTED ACCORDING TO

THE CHOSEN SYSTEM IS PARAMOUNT.

MISSING OR INCOMPLETE SOURCE INFORMATION

STUDENTS SOMETIMES OVERLOOK ESSENTIAL COMPONENTS OF A CITATION, LEADING TO INCOMPLETE ENTRIES. THIS CAN INCLUDE FORGETTING THE PUBLICATION YEAR, THE PUBLISHER, OR THE URL FOR ONLINE SOURCES. FOR BOOK CITATIONS, OMITTING THE SUBTITLE OR ITALICIZING THE TITLE INCORRECTLY IS ALSO COMMON. ENSURING ALL REQUIRED ELEMENTS ARE PRESENT AND CORRECTLY FORMATTED IS CRUCIAL FOR THE INTEGRITY OF THE BIBLIOGRAPHY OR REFERENCE LIST.

RESOURCES FOR CHICAGO STYLE ASSISTANCE

WHILE IT REQUIRES A SUBSCRIPTION, MANY UNIVERSITIES PROVIDE ACCESS THROUGH THEIR LIBRARY PORTALS. THIS IS THE DEFINITIVE RESOURCE FOR ANY QUESTION REGARDING CHICAGO STYLE.

UNIVERSITY WRITING CENTERS AND LIBRARIANS

MOST UNIVERSITIES OFFER WRITING CENTERS STAFFED WITH TRAINED TUTORS WHO CAN PROVIDE PERSONALIZED ASSISTANCE WITH CITATION STYLES, INCLUDING CHICAGO. ONLINE CITATION GENERATORS (WITH CAUTION)

WHILE ONLINE CITATION GENERATORS CAN BE HELPFUL FOR QUICKLY GENERATING BASIC CITATIONS, IT'S CRUCIAL TO USE THEM WITH EXTREME CAUTION. THESE TOOLS ARE NOT ALWAYS PERFECTLY UP-TO-DATE WITH THE LATEST CMOS EDITIONS AND MAY CONTAIN ERRORS OR OMISSIONS. ALWAYS CROSS-REFERENCE ANY GENERATED CITATION WITH THE OFFICIAL CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE OR OTHER REPUTABLE GUIDES TO ENSURE ACCURACY. THEY SHOULD BE USED AS A STARTING POINT, NOT A FINAL AUTHORITY, FOR YOUR CHICAGO STYLE GUIDE COLLEGE PROJECTS.

Q: WHAT IS THE PRIMARY DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM AND

THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM IN CHICAGO STYLE FOR COLLEGE PROJECTS?

A: THE PRIMARY DIFFERENCE LIES IN HOW CITATIONS ARE PRESENTED. THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM USES NUMBERED FOOTNOTES OR ENDNOTES WITHIN THE TEXT AND A BIBLIOGRAPHY AT THE END. THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM USES PARENTHETICAL CITATIONS (E.G., (SMITH 2020)) WITHIN THE TEXT, WHICH CORRESPOND TO A REFERENCE LIST AT THE END.

Q: WHEN SHOULD I USE CHICAGO STYLE FOR MY COLLEGE PROJECTS?

A: YOU SHOULD USE CHICAGO STYLE WHEN YOUR INSTRUCTOR OR DEPARTMENT SPECIFICALLY REQUIRES IT, OR WHEN WORKING IN DISCIPLINES THAT TRADITIONALLY FAVOR IT, SUCH AS HISTORY, LITERATURE, AND THE ARTS (OFTEN WITH THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM), OR CERTAIN SOCIAL SCIENCES (OFTEN WITH THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM).

Q: CAN I USE A MIX OF FOOTNOTES AND ENDNOTES IN MY CHICAGO STYLE PAPER?

A: NO, YOU MUST CHOOSE ONE OR THE OTHER FOR YOUR ENTIRE PAPER. THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE SPECIFIES THAT YOU SHOULD BE CONSISTENT WITH EITHER FOOTNOTES OR ENDNOTES THROUGHOUT YOUR CHICAGO STYLE GUIDE COLLEGE PROJECTS.

Q: HOW DO I CITE A WEBSITE IN CHICAGO STYLE?

A: FOR WEBSITES, YOU GENERALLY NEED TO INCLUDE THE AUTHOR (IF AVAILABLE), THE TITLE OF THE PAGE OR ARTICLE, THE NAME OF THE WEBSITE, THE LAST UPDATED OR PUBLICATION DATE, AND THE URL. IT'S ALSO RECOMMENDED TO INCLUDE THE ACCESS DATE.

Q: WHAT IS THE IMPORTANCE OF A BIBLIOGRAPHY OR REFERENCE LIST IN CHICAGO STYLE COLLEGE PROJECTS?

A: THE BIBLIOGRAPHY OR REFERENCE LIST IS CRUCIAL BECAUSE IT PROVIDES COMPLETE INFORMATION ABOUT ALL THE SOURCES YOU HAVE CITED, ALLOWING YOUR READERS TO LOCATE AND VERIFY YOUR SOURCES. IT IS A FUNDAMENTAL COMPONENT OF ACADEMIC INTEGRITY.

Q: DO I NEED TO ITALICIZE BOOK TITLES IN CHICAGO STYLE?

A: YES, BOOK TITLES, AS WELL AS JOURNAL TITLES, MAGAZINE TITLES, AND WEBSITE NAMES, SHOULD BE ITALICIZED IN CHICAGO STYLE. ARTICLE TITLES, ON THE OTHER HAND, ARE ENCLOSED IN QUOTATION MARKS.

Q: WHAT HAPPENS IF I FORGET TO CITE A SOURCE IN MY COLLEGE PROJECT?

A: FORGETTING TO CITE A SOURCE IS CONSIDERED PLAGIARISM, WHICH IS A SERIOUS ACADEMIC OFFENSE. IT MEANS PRESENTING SOMEONE ELSE'S WORK OR IDEAS AS YOUR OWN, INTENTIONALLY OR UNINTENTIONALLY. ALWAYS ERR ON THE SIDE OF CAUTION AND CITE EVERYTHING.

Q: ARE THERE SPECIFIC FONT AND MARGIN REQUIREMENTS FOR CHICAGO STYLE PAPERS?

A: WHILE THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE OFFERS FLEXIBILITY, STANDARD PRACTICE FOR COLLEGE PROJECTS USUALLY INVOLVES ONE-INCH MARGINS ON ALL SIDES AND A 12-POINT LEGIBLE FONT LIKE TIMES NEW ROMAN OR ARIAL. ALWAYS CHECK YOUR INSTRUCTOR'S SPECIFIC GUIDELINES.

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
