ADHERENCE TO STYLE GUIDE

Q: WHAT IS THE ROLE OF THE ABSTRACT IN A CHICAGO STYLE RESEARCH PROPOSAL?

A: THE ABSTRACT IS A CONCISE SUMMARY OF THE ENTIRE PROPOSAL, USUALLY BETWEEN 150-250 WORDS. IT SHOULD HIGHLIGHT THE RESEARCH PROBLEM, OBJECTIVES, METHODOLOGY, AND EXPECTED CONTRIBUTIONS. ITS PURPOSE IS TO PROVIDE A QUICK OVERVIEW FOR READERS, ALLOWING THEM TO UNDERSTAND THE CORE OF THE RESEARCH PROJECT WITHOUT READING THE FULL DOCUMENT.
