

COMMUNIST MANIFESTO CRITICAL REVIEW

THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO, PENNED BY KARL MARX AND FRIEDRICH ENGELS, STANDS AS ONE OF HISTORY'S MOST INFLUENTIAL POLITICAL PAMPHLETS. ITS RADICAL IDEAS ON CLASS STRUGGLE, CAPITALISM, AND THE EVENTUAL TRIUMPH OF COMMUNISM HAVE SHAPED POLITICAL DISCOURSE AND INSPIRED REVOLUTIONARY MOVEMENTS ACROSS THE GLOBE. THIS ARTICLE OFFERS A COMPREHENSIVE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO CRITICAL REVIEW, DELVING INTO ITS HISTORICAL CONTEXT, CORE TENETS, ENDURING IMPACT, AND THE SIGNIFICANT CRITICISMS IT HAS FACED. WE WILL EXPLORE THE MANIFESTO'S ANALYSIS OF HISTORY AS A SERIES OF CLASS CONFLICTS, ITS SCATHING CRITIQUE OF CAPITALISM'S INHERENT CONTRADICTIONS, AND ITS VISION FOR A CLASSLESS SOCIETY. FURTHERMORE, WE WILL EXAMINE THE PRACTICAL IMPLEMENTATIONS OF ITS IDEOLOGY AND THE DEBATES SURROUNDING ITS LEGACY.

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HISTORICAL CONTEXT AND GENESIS OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO

TO UNDERSTAND THE PROFOUND IMPACT OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO, IT IS CRUCIAL TO SITUATE IT WITHIN ITS HISTORICAL MILIEU. PUBLISHED IN 1848, A YEAR OF WIDESPREAD REVOLUTION ACROSS EUROPE, THE DOCUMENT EMERGED FROM THE FERTILE GROUND OF BURGEONING INDUSTRIAL CAPITALISM AND THE SOCIAL UPHEAVAL IT ENGENDERED. KARL MARX AND FRIEDRICH ENGELS, DRIVEN BY THEIR OBSERVATIONS OF THE HARSH REALITIES FACED BY THE WORKING CLASS IN THE INDUSTRIAL HEARTLANDS, SOUGHT TO ARTICULATE A THEORETICAL FRAMEWORK FOR UNDERSTANDING AND ULTIMATELY OVERTHROWING THE PREVAILING CAPITALIST SYSTEM. THE MANIFESTO ITSELF WAS COMMISSIONED BY THE COMMUNIST LEAGUE, A WORKERS' ORGANIZATION, AND WAS INTENDED TO SERVE AS A DECLARATION OF THEIR PRINCIPLES AND OBJECTIVES. THE SOCIO-ECONOMIC CONDITIONS OF THE TIME, CHARACTERIZED BY STARK WEALTH INEQUALITY, EXPLOITATIVE LABOR PRACTICES, AND THE RISE OF A POWERFUL INDUSTRIAL BOURGEOISIE, PROVIDED THE BACKDROP AGAINST WHICH MARX AND ENGELS FORMULATED THEIR REVOLUTIONARY IDEAS. THIS ERA WITNESSED THE CONCENTRATION OF WEALTH AND POWER IN THE HANDS OF A FEW, WHILE THE VAST MAJORITY OF THE POPULATION, THE PROLETARIAT, TOILED UNDER PRECARIOUS AND OFTEN DEHUMANIZING CONDITIONS. THE INTELLECTUAL CURRENTS OF THE TIME, INCLUDING HEGELIAN PHILOSOPHY AND EARLIER SOCIALIST THINKERS, ALSO PLAYED A SIGNIFICANT ROLE IN SHAPING MARX'S DIALECTICAL MATERIALISM AND HIS CRITIQUE OF EXISTING SOCIETAL STRUCTURES.

CORE TENETS AND ARGUMENTS OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO

THE SPECTER OF COMMUNISM

THE OPENING OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO FAMOUSLY DECLARES, "A SPECTER IS HAUNTING EUROPE – THE SPECTER OF COMMUNISM." THIS POTENT IMAGERY IMMEDIATELY ESTABLISHES THE PERVASIVE FEAR AND ANXIETY THAT THE BURGEONING SOCIALIST AND COMMUNIST MOVEMENTS INSTILLED IN THE RULING CLASSES OF EUROPE. MARX AND ENGELS MASTERFULLY USE THIS "SPECTER" TO SIGNAL THAT COMMUNISM IS NOT MERELY AN ABSTRACT IDEOLOGY BUT A TANGIBLE FORCE SHAPING POLITICAL EVENTS AND ANXIETIES. THEY FRAME COMMUNISM AS THE INEVITABLE OUTCOME OF HISTORICAL PROCESSES AND A DIRECT RESPONSE TO THE OPPRESSIVE CONDITIONS CREATED BY CAPITALISM. THE "SPECTER" IS THUS THE EMBODIMENT OF THE DISCONTENT AND ASPIRATIONS OF THE EXPLOITED MASSES, A FORCE THAT CANNOT BE IGNORED OR SUPPRESSED INDEFINITELY. THIS INITIAL FRAMING SETS THE STAGE FOR THE MANIFESTO'S CENTRAL ARGUMENT: THAT HISTORY IS DRIVEN BY CLASS STRUGGLE.

BOURGEOISIE AND PROLETARIAT: THE ENGINE OF HISTORY

CENTRAL TO THE MANIFESTO'S ANALYSIS IS THE CONCEPT OF CLASS STRUGGLE AS THE PRIMARY DRIVER OF HISTORICAL CHANGE. MARX AND ENGELS CONTEND THAT THROUGHOUT HISTORY, SOCIETIES HAVE BEEN DEFINED BY THE CONFLICT BETWEEN OPPRESSORS AND THE OPPRESSED, SUCH AS MASTER AND SLAVE, LORD AND SERF, AND NOW, BOURGEOISIE AND PROLETARIAT. THE BOURGEOISIE, THE CAPITALIST CLASS, IS CHARACTERIZED BY ITS OWNERSHIP OF THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION – FACTORIES, LAND, AND CAPITAL. THE PROLETARIAT, THE WORKING CLASS, POSSESSES NOTHING BUT THEIR LABOR POWER, WHICH THEY

MUST SELL TO THE BOURGEOISIE TO SURVIVE. THE MANIFESTO ARGUES THAT THE BOURGEOISIE, IN ITS RELENTLESS PURSUIT OF PROFIT AND EXPANSION, HAS CREATED A GLOBAL MARKET AND REVOLUTIONIZED THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION, INADVERTENTLY CREATING THE VERY CONDITIONS FOR ITS OWN EVENTUAL DOWNFALL. THIS HISTORICAL DIALECTIC, WHERE EACH DOMINANT CLASS SOWS THE SEEDS OF ITS OWN DESTRUCTION, IS A CORNERSTONE OF MARXIST THOUGHT.

CRITIQUE OF CAPITALISM AND ITS CONTRADICTIONS

THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO OFFERS A SCATHING CRITIQUE OF CAPITALISM, HIGHLIGHTING ITS INHERENT CONTRADICTIONS AND EXPLOITATIVE NATURE. MARX AND ENGELS ARGUE THAT CAPITALISM, WHILE HAVING A HISTORICALLY PROGRESSIVE ROLE IN DISMANTLING FEUDALISM AND DEVELOPING PRODUCTIVE FORCES, INEVITABLY LEADS TO THE ALIENATION OF LABOR, THE CONCENTRATION OF WEALTH, AND PERIODIC ECONOMIC CRISES. THEY DESCRIBE HOW THE BOURGEOISIE CONTINUOUSLY REVOLUTIONIZES THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION, CREATING A PERPETUAL CYCLE OF INNOVATION AND DISRUPTION. HOWEVER, THIS PROGRESS COMES AT THE COST OF THE PROLETARIAT, WHO ARE INCREASINGLY IMPOVERISHED AND ALIENATED FROM THEIR LABOR AND ITS PRODUCTS. THE SYSTEM'S CYCLICAL CRISES, THEY CONTEND, ARE NOT ABERRATIONS BUT INTRINSIC FEATURES, DEMONSTRATING CAPITALISM'S INABILITY TO MANAGE ITS OWN VAST PRODUCTIVE CAPACITY, LEADING TO OVERPRODUCTION AND UNEMPLOYMENT.

THE ROLE OF THE PROLETARIAT AND REVOLUTION

ACCORDING TO THE MANIFESTO, THE PROLETARIAT IS NOT MERELY A VICTIM OF CAPITALISM BUT ALSO ITS EVENTUAL GRAVEDIGGER. AS CAPITALISM EXPANDS GLOBALLY, IT BRINGS TOGETHER A CONCENTRATED MASS OF WORKERS, FOSTERING A SENSE OF SHARED IDENTITY AND COLLECTIVE INTEREST. THIS GROWING SOLIDARITY, COUPLED WITH THE INCREASING SEVERITY OF CAPITALIST EXPLOITATION, IS EXPECTED TO LEAD TO A PROLETARIAN REVOLUTION. THE MANIFESTO POSITS THAT THE PROLETARIAT, BEING THE MOST EXPLOITED CLASS, HAS THE LEAST TO LOSE AND THE MOST TO GAIN FROM OVERTHROWING THE CAPITALIST SYSTEM. THE REVOLUTION IS NOT ENVISIONED AS A SPONTANEOUS UPRISING BUT AS A CONSCIOUS AND ORGANIZED EFFORT BY THE WORKING CLASS TO SEIZE POLITICAL POWER AND DISMANTLE THE EXISTING BOURGEOIS STATE APPARATUS. THE ULTIMATE GOAL IS TO ESTABLISH A NEW SOCIAL ORDER FREE FROM CLASS EXPLOITATION.

ABOLITION OF PRIVATE PROPERTY

ONE OF THE MOST CONTENTIOUS PROPOSALS IN THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO IS THE ABOLITION OF BOURGEOIS PRIVATE PROPERTY, WHICH MARX AND ENGELS DISTINGUISH FROM PERSONAL PROPERTY. THEY ARGUE THAT CAPITALIST PRIVATE PROPERTY, DERIVED FROM THE EXPLOITATION OF WAGE LABOR, IS THE VERY FOUNDATION OF CLASS OPPRESSION. THE MANIFESTO CALLS FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION BY THE PROLETARIAT, TRANSFORMING THEM INTO COMMON PROPERTY. THIS DOES NOT MEAN THE CONFISCATION OF ALL PERSONAL POSSESSIONS, BUT RATHER THE ELIMINATION OF PROPERTY THAT ALLOWS ONE CLASS TO EXPLOIT ANOTHER. THE ABOLITION OF BOURGEOIS PRIVATE PROPERTY IS SEEN AS A NECESSARY STEP TO END CLASS DISTINCTIONS AND ESTABLISH A SOCIETY WHERE THE FRUITS OF LABOR ARE SHARED EQUITABLY AMONG ALL MEMBERS.

VISION OF A COMMUNIST SOCIETY

THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO OUTLINES A VISION OF A COMMUNIST SOCIETY CHARACTERIZED BY THE ABSENCE OF CLASS DISTINCTIONS, THE ABOLITION OF THE STATE (AS IT IS SEEN AS AN INSTRUMENT OF CLASS OPPRESSION), AND THE PRINCIPLE OF "FROM EACH ACCORDING TO HIS ABILITY, TO EACH ACCORDING TO HIS NEED." IN SUCH A SOCIETY, THE FORCES OF PRODUCTION WOULD BE COLLECTIVELY OWNED AND CONTROLLED, LEADING TO AN ERA OF ABUNDANCE AND HUMAN FLOURISHING. THE MANIFESTO SUGGESTS THAT THE DEVELOPMENT OF PRODUCTIVE FORCES UNDER CAPITALISM HAS CREATED THE MATERIAL BASIS FOR THIS FUTURE SOCIETY, MAKING IT A POSSIBILITY RATHER THAN A UTOPIAN FANTASY. THE ULTIMATE AIM IS A SOCIETY WHERE THE FREE DEVELOPMENT OF EACH IS THE CONDITION FOR THE FREE DEVELOPMENT OF ALL, TRANSCENDING THE LIMITATIONS AND DIVISIONS IMPOSED BY CAPITALIST MODES OF PRODUCTION AND SOCIAL ORGANIZATION.

COMMUNIST MANIFESTO CRITICAL REVIEW: EXAMINING THE CRITICISMS

ECONOMIC CRITICISMS OF COMMUNIST THEORY

A SIGNIFICANT BODY OF CRITICISM LEVELED AGAINST THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO AND ITS SUBSEQUENT INTERPRETATIONS FOCUSES ON THE ECONOMIC VIABILITY OF COMMUNIST SYSTEMS. CRITICS ARGUE THAT THE ABOLITION OF PRIVATE PROPERTY AND THE MARKET MECHANISM REMOVES CRUCIAL INCENTIVES FOR INNOVATION, EFFICIENCY, AND PRODUCTIVITY. WITHOUT THE PROFIT MOTIVE AND COMPETITION, THE ARGUMENT GOES, ECONOMIC STAGNATION BECOMES INEVITABLE. THE ABSENCE OF A PRICE MECHANISM TO SIGNAL SCARCITY AND DEMAND CAN LEAD TO MISALLOCATION OF RESOURCES, SHORTAGES OF DESIRED GOODS, AND SURPLUSES OF UNWANTED ONES. FURTHERMORE, THE CONCEPT OF CENTRAL PLANNING, OFTEN ASSOCIATED WITH COMMUNIST ECONOMIES, HAS BEEN CRITICIZED FOR ITS INABILITY TO EFFECTIVELY COORDINATE COMPLEX ECONOMIES AND ADAPT TO CHANGING CIRCUMSTANCES. THE PRACTICAL OUTCOMES OF CENTRALLY PLANNED ECONOMIES IN VARIOUS HISTORICAL CONTEXTS HAVE OFTEN BEEN MARKED BY INEFFICIENCY AND LOWER STANDARDS OF LIVING COMPARED TO MARKET-BASED ECONOMIES.

HISTORICAL FAILURES AND PRACTICAL IMPLEMENTATIONS

PERHAPS THE MOST POTENT CRITICISM OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO STEMS FROM THE HISTORICAL EXPERIENCES OF NATIONS THAT ATTEMPTED TO IMPLEMENT ITS PRINCIPLES. THE SOVIET UNION, MAOIST CHINA, AND OTHER COMMUNIST STATES, WHILE INITIALLY PROMISING RADICAL SOCIAL CHANGE, OFTEN RESULTED IN AUTHORITARIAN REGIMES, SUPPRESSION OF INDIVIDUAL LIBERTIES, AND ECONOMIC HARDSHIP. CRITICS POINT TO THE IMMENSE HUMAN COST, INCLUDING FAMINES, PURGES, AND WIDESPREAD REPRESSION, AS DIRECT CONSEQUENCES OF ATTEMPTS TO FORCIBLY IMPLEMENT MARXIST IDEOLOGY. THE FAILURE TO ACHIEVE THE PROMISED STATELESS, CLASSLESS UTOPIA AND THE EMERGENCE OF NEW FORMS OF ELITE PRIVILEGE WITHIN THESE SYSTEMS ARE OFTEN CITED AS EVIDENCE THAT THE MANIFESTO'S VISION IS EITHER FUNDAMENTALLY FLAWED OR PRACTICALLY UNACHIEVABLE. THE CONCENTRATION OF POWER IN THE HANDS OF A VANGUARD PARTY, RATHER THAN LEADING TO THE WITHERING AWAY OF THE STATE, OFTEN RESULTED IN ITS CONSOLIDATION AND OPPRESSIVE USE.

PHILOSOPHICAL AND ETHICAL OBJECTIONS

BEYOND ECONOMIC AND HISTORICAL CRITIQUES, THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO ALSO FACES SIGNIFICANT PHILOSOPHICAL AND ETHICAL OBJECTIONS. MANY ARGUE THAT THE MANIFESTO'S EMPHASIS ON CLASS STRUGGLE OVERLOOKS THE COMPLEXITIES OF HUMAN MOTIVATION AND THE IMPORTANCE OF INDIVIDUAL RIGHTS AND FREEDOMS. THE PERCEIVED COLLECTIVIST NATURE OF COMMUNISM, CRITICS CONTEND, CAN LEAD TO THE SUPPRESSION OF INDIVIDUALITY AND PERSONAL AUTONOMY. THE IDEA OF A DICTATORSHIP OF THE PROLETARIAT, EVEN IF INTENDED AS A TRANSITIONAL PHASE, HAS BEEN CRITICIZED FOR ITS INHERENT AUTHORITARIANISM AND THE POTENTIAL FOR ABUSE OF POWER. ETHICAL CONCERNS ARE ALSO RAISED REGARDING THE JUSTIFICATION OF VIOLENCE AND REVOLUTION AS MEANS TO ACHIEVE SOCIAL ENDS, AS WELL AS THE POTENTIAL FOR A COMMUNIST SOCIETY TO STIFLE CREATIVITY, DISSENT, AND THE DIVERSITY OF HUMAN EXPERIENCE.

CRITIQUE OF HISTORICAL DETERMINISM

A KEY PHILOSOPHICAL TENET OF MARX AND ENGELS, AS PRESENTED IN THE MANIFESTO, IS HISTORICAL MATERIALISM AND THE IDEA OF HISTORICAL DETERMINISM – THE BELIEF THAT HISTORY PROGRESSES THROUGH PREDICTABLE STAGES DRIVEN BY ECONOMIC FORCES. CRITICS ARGUE THAT THIS DETERMINISTIC VIEW OF HISTORY IS OVERLY SIMPLISTIC AND FAILS TO ACCOUNT FOR THE ROLE OF CONTINGENCY, INDIVIDUAL AGENCY, AND CULTURAL FACTORS IN SHAPING SOCIETAL DEVELOPMENT. THE IDEA THAT CAPITALISM IS DESTINED TO BE OVERTHROWN BY COMMUNISM CAN BE SEEN AS A FORM OF TELEOLOGY THAT DOES NOT ADEQUATELY CONSIDER THE ADAPTABILITY AND RESILIENCE OF CAPITALIST SYSTEMS OR THE DIVERSE PATHS THAT SOCIETIES CAN TAKE. THE UNFORESEEN DEVELOPMENTS AND THE FAILURE OF MANY PREDICTIONS MADE BY MARX ALSO FUEL THIS CRITICISM.

THE STATE AND THE DICTATORSHIP OF THE PROLETARIAT

THE MANIFESTO'S PROPOSITION OF A "DICTATORSHIP OF THE PROLETARIAT" AS A TRANSITIONAL PHASE BETWEEN CAPITALISM AND COMMUNISM HAS BEEN A MAJOR POINT OF CONTENTION. CRITICS ARGUE THAT THE CONCENTRATION OF POWER IN THE HANDS OF A REVOLUTIONARY PARTY, EVEN IF OSTENSIBLY REPRESENTING THE PROLETARIAT, INEVITABLY LEADS TO TYRANNY AND THE SUPPRESSION OF DISSENT. THE HISTORICAL RECORD OF STATES THAT CLAIMED TO REPRESENT THE PROLETARIAT OFTEN SHOWS THE CONSOLIDATION OF STATE POWER AND THE CREATION OF NEW ELITES, RATHER THAN ITS EVENTUAL DISSOLUTION. THE INHERENT TENSION BETWEEN THE CONCEPT OF A POWERFUL STATE APPARATUS AND THE ULTIMATE GOAL OF A STATELESS SOCIETY IS A RECURRING THEME IN THE CRITIQUES OF THIS ASPECT OF COMMUNIST THEORY.

INDIVIDUAL LIBERTY AND THE ROLE OF THE INDIVIDUAL

A FUNDAMENTAL CRITICISM OF THE MANIFESTO'S VISION OF A COMMUNIST SOCIETY REVOLVES AROUND THE FATE OF INDIVIDUAL LIBERTY AND THE ROLE OF THE INDIVIDUAL. CRITICS ARGUE THAT THE STRONG EMPHASIS ON COLLECTIVE ACTION AND THE ABOLITION OF PRIVATE PROPERTY CAN LEAD TO THE SUBJUGATION OF INDIVIDUAL RIGHTS AND FREEDOMS TO THE WILL OF THE COLLECTIVE OR THE STATE. CONCERNS ARE RAISED ABOUT WHETHER A SOCIETY THAT PRIORITIZES COLLECTIVE NEEDS OVER INDIVIDUAL DESIRES CAN TRULY FOSTER HUMAN FLOURISHING AND PROTECT THE RIGHTS OF MINORITIES OR THOSE WHO DEVIATE FROM THE NORM. THE POTENTIAL FOR CONFORMITY AND THE SUPPRESSION OF DIVERSE VIEWPOINTS WITHIN A STRICTLY COLLECTIVIST FRAMEWORK IS A RECURRING CONCERN IN THE CRITICAL REVIEW OF COMMUNIST IDEALS.

ENDURING INFLUENCE AND LEGACY OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO

IMPACT ON POLITICAL THOUGHT AND MOVEMENTS

THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO HAS UNDENIABLY LEFT AN INDELIBLE MARK ON POLITICAL THOUGHT AND HAS BEEN A CATALYST FOR COUNTLESS POLITICAL MOVEMENTS WORLDWIDE. ITS ANALYSIS OF CAPITALISM, CLASS STRUGGLE, AND REVOLUTION PROVIDED A THEORETICAL FRAMEWORK FOR SOCIALIST, COMMUNIST, AND LABOR MOVEMENTS THROUGHOUT THE 19TH AND 20TH CENTURIES. IT INSPIRED REVOLUTIONARY UPRISINGS, SHAPED THE POLITICAL LANDSCAPE OF NUMEROUS NATIONS, AND CONTINUES TO BE A REFERENCE POINT IN DEBATES ABOUT ECONOMIC INEQUALITY, SOCIAL JUSTICE, AND THE FUTURE OF CAPITALISM. EVEN THOSE WHO REJECT ITS CONCLUSIONS OFTEN ENGAGE WITH ITS CRITIQUES, DEMONSTRATING ITS ENDURING INFLUENCE ON INTELLECTUAL DISCOURSE. THE MANIFESTO'S IDEAS PROVIDED A POWERFUL LANGUAGE FOR ARTICULATING GRIEVANCES AND ASPIRATIONS FOR FUNDAMENTAL SOCIETAL CHANGE.

THE MANIFESTO IN THE 21ST CENTURY

IN THE 21ST CENTURY, THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO CONTINUES TO RESONATE, ALBEIT IN DIFFERENT FORMS, AS CONCERNS ABOUT ECONOMIC INEQUALITY, GLOBALIZATION, AND THE POWER OF CORPORATIONS PERSIST. WHILE THE SPECIFIC PREDICTIONS MADE BY MARX AND ENGELS MAY NOT HAVE MATERIALIZED EXACTLY AS FORESEEN, THEIR CRITIQUE OF CAPITALISM'S INHERENT TENDENCIES TOWARDS CONCENTRATION OF WEALTH, EXPLOITATION, AND CRISIS REMAINS RELEVANT TO MANY. DISCUSSIONS ABOUT WEALTH DISPARITY, PRECARIOUS LABOR, AND THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT OF INDUSTRIAL CAPITALISM OFTEN DRAW UPON THE ANALYTICAL TOOLS PROVIDED BY THE MANIFESTO. MODERN SCHOLARS AND ACTIVISTS CONTINUE TO INTERPRET AND RE-CONTEXTUALIZE ITS IDEAS IN LIGHT OF CONTEMPORARY CHALLENGES, MAKING IT A DOCUMENT OF ONGOING, IF OFTEN CONTROVERSIAL, RELEVANCE.

DEBATES ON THE RELEVANCE OF MARX'S IDEAS

THE RELEVANCE OF MARX'S IDEAS, AS ARTICULATED IN THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO, REMAINS A SUBJECT OF VIGOROUS DEBATE. SUPPORTERS ARGUE THAT THE CORE CRITIQUES OF CAPITALISM – ITS TENDENCY TOWARDS EXPLOITATION, ALIENATION, AND CYCLICAL CRISES – ARE MORE PERTINENT THAN EVER IN A GLOBALIZED WORLD GRAPPLING WITH WIDENING INCOME GAPS AND PRECARIOUS EMPLOYMENT.
