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UNDERSTANDING AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS REPRESENT A CRITICAL INVESTMENT IN THE FUTURE OF THE ARTS, RECOGNIZING THE RICH CULTURAL HERITAGE AND PROFOUND CONTRIBUTIONS OF AFRICAN AMERICANS TO THE PERFORMING ARTS LANDSCAPE. THESE SCHOLARSHIPS ARE MORE THAN JUST FINANCIAL AID; THEY ARE A TESTAMENT TO THE VIBRANT TALENT POOL WITHIN THE BLACK COMMUNITY AND A COMMITMENT TO FOSTERING THE NEXT GENERATION OF ARTISTS, PERFORMERS, AND CULTURAL INNOVATORS. BY PROVIDING FINANCIAL SUPPORT, THESE SCHOLARSHIPS EMPOWER STUDENTS TO FOCUS ON HONING THEIR CRAFT WITHOUT THE OVERWHELMING PRESSURE OF SIGNIFICANT DEBT, ALLOWING THEM TO FULLY IMMERSE THEMSELVES IN THEIR ARTISTIC DEVELOPMENT. THE DEMAND FOR TALENTED PERFORMERS REMAINS HIGH ACROSS VARIOUS INDUSTRIES, AND THESE SCHOLARSHIPS SERVE AS A VITAL BRIDGE, CONNECTING ASPIRING ARTISTS WITH THE EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES THEY NEED TO SUCCEED AND MAKE A LASTING IMPACT.

THE PERFORMING ARTS ENCOMPASS A VAST SPECTRUM OF DISCIPLINES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO ACTING, SINGING,

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC, CHOREOGRAPHY, DIRECTING, PLAYWRITING, SCREENWRITING, AND TECHNICAL THEATER. AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS ARE TAILORED TO SUPPORT STUDENTS EXCELLING IN THESE DIVERSE AREAS. THEY ACKNOWLEDGE THE UNIQUE PERSPECTIVES, EXPERIENCES, AND ARTISTIC EXPRESSIONS THAT BLACK ARTISTS BRING TO THEIR WORK, ENRICHING THE CULTURAL TAPESTRY OF SOCIETY. WHETHER IT'S A POWERFUL DRAMATIC MONOLOGUE, A SOULFUL RENDITION OF A CLASSIC SONG, A CAPTIVATING DANCE PERFORMANCE, OR AN INNOVATIVE DIRECTORIAL VISION, THESE SCHOLARSHIPS AIM TO IDENTIFY AND NURTURE TALENT ACROSS THE BOARD.

THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THESE SCHOLARSHIPS ALSO LIES IN THEIR ABILITY TO PROMOTE DIVERSITY AND INCLUSION WITHIN ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS AND THE BROADER PERFORMING ARTS INDUSTRY. BY ACTIVELY SEEKING OUT AND SUPPORTING AFRICAN AMERICAN TALENT, THESE PROGRAMS CONTRIBUTE TO A MORE REPRESENTATIVE AND EQUITABLE ARTISTIC ECOSYSTEM. THIS NOT ONLY BENEFITS THE STUDENTS RECEIVING THE AID BUT ALSO ENRICHES THE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT FOR ALL STUDENTS AND FOSTERS A GREATER APPRECIATION FOR DIVERSE ARTISTIC VOICES AMONG AUDIENCES.

TYPES OF AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

THE LANDSCAPE OF AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS IS DIVERSE, CATERING TO A WIDE RANGE OF ARTISTIC DISCIPLINES AND STUDENT NEEDS. UNDERSTANDING THE DIFFERENT CATEGORIES CAN HELP ASPIRING PERFORMERS TARGET THEIR SEARCH MORE EFFECTIVELY. THESE SCHOLARSHIPS CAN BE BROADLY CATEGORIZED BY THEIR FOCUS, THE SPONSORING ORGANIZATION, AND THE SPECIFIC AREA OF PERFORMANCE THEY AIM TO SUPPORT.

MERIT-BASED PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

THESE SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AWARDED BASED ON DEMONSTRATED TALENT, SKILL, AND ACHIEVEMENT IN A PARTICULAR PERFORMING ART. APPLICANTS TYPICALLY NEED TO PROVIDE EVIDENCE OF THEIR ABILITIES THROUGH AUDITIONS, PORTFOLIOS, RECORDED PERFORMANCES, OR ACADEMIC RECORDS. MERIT-BASED AWARDS RECOGNIZE EXCEPTIONAL ARTISTIC POTENTIAL AND ARE HIGHLY COMPETITIVE.

NEED-BASED PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

WHILE TALENT IS A COMMON THREAD, SOME SCHOLARSHIPS ALSO CONSIDER FINANCIAL NEED. THESE AWARDS AIM TO MAKE ARTS EDUCATION ACCESSIBLE TO STUDENTS FROM LOWER SOCIOECONOMIC BACKGROUNDS WHO MIGHT OTHERWISE BE UNABLE TO AFFORD TUITION, PERFORMANCE-RELATED EXPENSES, OR LIVING COSTS. A DEMONSTRATION OF FINANCIAL NEED IS USUALLY REQUIRED THROUGH FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID APPLICATIONS (LIKE THE FAFSA) AND SPECIFIC SCHOLARSHIP ESSAYS.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR SPECIFIC DISCIPLINES

MANY SCHOLARSHIPS ARE DEDICATED TO PARTICULAR AREAS WITHIN THE PERFORMING ARTS. THESE CAN INCLUDE:

- **MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS:** FOR VOCALISTS, INSTRUMENTALISTS (PIANISTS, VIOLINISTS, ETC.), COMPOSERS, AND MUSIC EDUCATORS.
- **THEATER SCHOLARSHIPS:** FOR ACTORS, DIRECTORS, PLAYWRIGHTS, STAGE MANAGERS, AND TECHNICAL THEATER PROFESSIONALS.
- **DANCE SCHOLARSHIPS:** FOR DANCERS SPECIALIZING IN VARIOUS STYLES SUCH AS BALLET, MODERN, JAZZ, HIP-HOP, AND AFRICAN DIASPORIC DANCE FORMS.
- **FILM AND MEDIA SCHOLARSHIPS:** FOR ASPIRING FILMMAKERS, CINEMATOGRAPHERS, EDITORS, SCREENWRITERS, AND PRODUCERS.

SCHOLARSHIPS FROM CULTURAL AND COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS

NUMEROUS FOUNDATIONS, NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS, AND COMMUNITY GROUPS DEDICATED TO SUPPORTING AFRICAN AMERICAN CULTURE AND THE ARTS OFFER PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS. THESE OFTEN HAVE A STRONG CONNECTION TO COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT AND CULTURAL PRESERVATION. EXAMPLES INCLUDE SCHOLARSHIPS FROM LOCAL ARTS COUNCILS, NATIONAL AFRICAN AMERICAN HERITAGE ORGANIZATIONS, AND SPECIFIC BLACK SORORITIES AND FRATERNITIES.

UNIVERSITY-SPECIFIC PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

MANY COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES WITH STRONG PERFORMING ARTS PROGRAMS OFFER THEIR OWN SCHOLARSHIPS FOR INCOMING STUDENTS, INCLUDING THOSE SPECIALIZING IN PERFORMANCE. THESE ARE OFTEN AWARDED THROUGH DEPARTMENTAL AUDITIONS AND APPLICATIONS, AND THEY MAY BE SPECIFIC TO THE UNIVERSITY'S PARTICULAR STRENGTHS IN AREAS LIKE JAZZ STUDIES, AFRICAN AMERICAN THEATER, OR CONTEMPORARY DANCE.

SCHOLARSHIPS FROM PROFESSIONAL ARTS ORGANIZATIONS

ESTABLISHED PROFESSIONAL THEATERS, ORCHESTRAS, DANCE COMPANIES, AND FILM INSTITUTIONS SOMETIMES OFFER SCHOLARSHIPS OR GRANTS TO SUPPORT EMERGING TALENT. THESE OPPORTUNITIES OFTEN COME WITH THE ADDED BENEFIT OF MENTORSHIP AND POTENTIAL CONNECTIONS WITHIN THE PROFESSIONAL INDUSTRY.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

WHILE THE SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS CAN VARY SIGNIFICANTLY FROM ONE SCHOLARSHIP TO ANOTHER, SEVERAL COMMON ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA ARE FREQUENTLY ENCOUNTERED WHEN APPLYING FOR AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS. UNDERSTANDING THESE PREREQUISITES IS CRUCIAL FOR A SUCCESSFUL APPLICATION, ENSURING THAT CANDIDATES MEET THE FUNDAMENTAL QUALIFICATIONS BEFORE DEDICATING TIME AND EFFORT TO THE APPLICATION PROCESS.

ACADEMIC STANDING

MOST SCHOLARSHIPS, INCLUDING THOSE FOR PERFORMANCE, WILL HAVE A MINIMUM GPA REQUIREMENT. THIS DEMONSTRATES THAT THE STUDENT IS COMMITTED TO THEIR ACADEMIC SUCCESS ALONGSIDE THEIR ARTISTIC PURSUITS. WHILE SOME PERFORMANCE-FOCUSED SCHOLARSHIPS MAY PLACE A SLIGHTLY HIGHER EMPHASIS ON ARTISTIC MERIT, A SOLID ACADEMIC RECORD REMAINS A FOUNDATIONAL ELEMENT FOR MOST AWARDS.

ENROLLMENT IN A PERFORMING ARTS PROGRAM

A PRIMARY REQUIREMENT IS TYPICALLY ADMISSION INTO OR CURRENT ENROLLMENT IN AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY PROGRAM SPECIFICALLY FOCUSED ON A PERFORMING ART. THIS COULD BE A BACHELOR OF FINE ARTS (BFA), BACHELOR OF MUSIC (BM), BACHELOR OF ARTS (BA) WITH A CONCENTRATION IN PERFORMANCE, OR A MASTER OF FINE ARTS (MFA) PROGRAM. THE PROGRAM OF STUDY MUST ALIGN WITH THE SCHOLARSHIP'S FOCUS.

DEMONSTRATED ARTISTIC TALENT AND POTENTIAL

THIS IS OFTEN THE MOST CRITICAL FACTOR FOR PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS. APPLICANTS ARE USUALLY REQUIRED TO SHOWCASE THEIR TALENT THROUGH:

- **AUDITIONS:** LIVE OR RECORDED AUDITIONS SHOWCASING ACTING, SINGING, INSTRUMENTAL PROFICIENCY, OR DANCE

TECHNIQUE.

- **PORTFOLIOS:** FOR PLAYWRIGHTS, SCREENWRITERS, OR COMPOSERS, A PORTFOLIO OF WRITTEN WORK OR MUSICAL COMPOSITIONS MIGHT BE REQUIRED.
- **DEMO REELS:** FOR FILM AND MEDIA STUDENTS, A COMPILATION OF THEIR BEST WORK IS ESSENTIAL.
- **INTERVIEWS:** TO DISCUSS ARTISTIC GOALS, INSPIRATIONS, AND EXPERIENCES.

THE LEVEL OF SKILL EXPECTED CAN RANGE FROM ADVANCED HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS APPLYING FOR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS TO GRADUATE STUDENTS SEEKING FURTHER SPECIALIZATION.

AFRICAN AMERICAN HERITAGE OR IDENTIFICATION

NATURALLY, A CORE ELIGIBILITY CRITERION FOR THESE SCHOLARSHIPS IS AFRICAN AMERICAN HERITAGE OR IDENTIFICATION. THIS IS OFTEN DEFINED AS SELF-IDENTIFICATION AS BLACK OR OF AFRICAN DESCENT. SOME SCHOLARSHIPS MIGHT ALSO CONSIDER INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE DEMONSTRATED A SIGNIFICANT COMMITMENT TO SUPPORTING OR ENGAGING WITH THE AFRICAN AMERICAN COMMUNITY AND ITS CULTURAL CONTRIBUTIONS, EVEN IF THEY DO NOT DIRECTLY IDENTIFY AS AFRICAN AMERICAN.

FINANCIAL NEED (FOR SOME SCHOLARSHIPS)

AS MENTIONED PREVIOUSLY, SOME AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS ARE NEED-BASED. IN THESE CASES, APPLICANTS WILL NEED TO DEMONSTRATE FINANCIAL NEED, USUALLY BY SUBMITTING A FAFSA (FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID) AND POTENTIALLY ADDITIONAL FINANCIAL DOCUMENTATION OR ESSAYS EXPLAINING THEIR FINANCIAL SITUATION.

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

STRONG LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION FROM INDIVIDUALS WHO CAN SPEAK TO THE APPLICANT'S ARTISTIC ABILITIES, WORK ETHIC, CHARACTER, AND POTENTIAL ARE ALMOST ALWAYS REQUIRED. THESE TYPICALLY COME FROM TEACHERS, MENTORS, COACHES, DIRECTORS, OR OTHER PROFESSIONALS WHO HAVE DIRECTLY OBSERVED THE APPLICANT'S PERFORMANCE AND DEVELOPMENT.

ESSAYS AND PERSONAL STATEMENTS

APPLICANTS ARE OFTEN ASKED TO WRITE ESSAYS OR PERSONAL STATEMENTS THAT DETAIL THEIR ARTISTIC JOURNEY, MOTIVATIONS, CAREER ASPIRATIONS, AND HOW THE SCHOLARSHIP WOULD HELP THEM ACHIEVE THEIR GOALS. THESE ESSAYS ARE A CRUCIAL OPPORTUNITY TO CONVEY PERSONALITY, PASSION, AND A CLEAR VISION.

WHERE TO FIND AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

DISCOVERING THE RIGHT AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIP REQUIRES A PROACTIVE AND MULTIFACETED APPROACH. MANY OPPORTUNITIES EXIST, BUT THEY ARE NOT ALWAYS READILY APPARENT. IT'S IMPORTANT TO EXPLORE VARIOUS SOURCES, FROM ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS TO COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATIONS AND PROFESSIONAL BODIES, TO IDENTIFY AWARDS THAT ALIGN WITH YOUR ARTISTIC DISCIPLINE AND PERSONAL CIRCUMSTANCES.

UNIVERSITY FINANCIAL AID OFFICES AND PERFORMING ARTS DEPARTMENTS

YOUR FIRST AND OFTEN MOST FRUITFUL STOP SHOULD BE THE FINANCIAL AID OFFICE AND THE SPECIFIC PERFORMING ARTS DEPARTMENTS OF THE UNIVERSITIES YOU ARE INTERESTED IN ATTENDING. DEPARTMENTS OFTEN HAVE DEDICATED SCHOLARSHIPS FUNDED BY ALUMNI, DONORS, OR DEPARTMENTAL ENDOWMENTS, SPECIFICALLY FOR STUDENTS PURSUING MUSIC, THEATER, DANCE, OR FILM. THEY CAN ALSO DIRECT YOU TO INSTITUTIONAL-WIDE SCHOLARSHIPS THAT MIGHT BE RELEVANT.

ONLINE SCHOLARSHIP DATABASES

NUMEROUS ONLINE PLATFORMS AGGREGATE SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION. WHILE NOT ALL WILL BE SPECIFIC TO AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE, USING TARGETED KEYWORDS LIKE "AFRICAN AMERICAN MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP," "BLACK THEATER SCHOLARSHIP," OR "DANCE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR MINORITIES" CAN YIELD RELEVANT RESULTS. POPULAR DATABASES INCLUDE:

NATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS SUPPORTING AFRICAN AMERICAN ARTS AND CULTURE

SEVERAL PROMINENT NATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS ARE DEDICATED TO ADVANCING AND SUPPORTING AFRICAN AMERICAN ARTS AND CULTURE. THESE ORGANIZATIONS OFTEN PROVIDE SCHOLARSHIPS TO FOSTER EMERGING TALENT. EXAMPLES INCLUDE:

- THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF COLORED PEOPLE (NAACP)
- THE UNITED NEGRO COLLEGE FUND (UNCF)
- THE CONGRESSIONAL BLACK CAUCUS FOUNDATION (CBCF)
- BLACK GIRLS ROCK!
- VARIOUS PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATIONS WITHIN SPECIFIC ARTS DISCIPLINES THAT HAVE DIVERSITY INITIATIVES.

INVESTIGATE THE WEBSITES OF THESE ORGANIZATIONS FOR SPECIFIC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS AND DEADLINES.

LOCAL COMMUNITY FOUNDATIONS AND ARTS COUNCILS

DON'T OVERLOOK LOCAL OPPORTUNITIES. COMMUNITY FOUNDATIONS AND LOCAL ARTS COUNCILS OFTEN HAVE SCHOLARSHIPS FUNDED BY REGIONAL DONORS OR GOVERNMENT GRANTS. THESE MAY BE MORE ACCESSIBLE AND TAILORED TO THE NEEDS OF STUDENTS WITHIN A SPECIFIC GEOGRAPHIC AREA. CHECKING THE WEBSITES OF YOUR LOCAL CITY OR COUNTY ARTS COUNCIL IS A GOOD STARTING POINT.

PROFESSIONAL PERFORMING ARTS COMPANIES AND FOUNDATIONS

MAJOR PROFESSIONAL PERFORMING ARTS ORGANIZATIONS AND THEIR ASSOCIATED FOUNDATIONS SOMETIMES OFFER SCHOLARSHIPS OR GRANTS. THESE CAN BE PARTICULARLY BENEFICIAL FOR STUDENTS LOOKING TO GAIN A Foothold IN THE PROFESSIONAL WORLD. RESEARCH MAJOR THEATERS, OPERA COMPANIES, SYMPHONY ORCHESTRAS, AND DANCE COMPANIES IN YOUR REGION OR AREAS WHERE YOU ASPIRE TO WORK.

BLACK GREEK LETTER ORGANIZATIONS (BGLOs)

MANY HISTORICALLY BLACK GREEK LETTER ORGANIZATIONS (E.G., ALPHA PHI ALPHA, KAPPA ALPHA PSI, OMEGA PSI PHI, DELTA SIGMA THETA, ZETA PHI BETA, SIGMA GAMMA RHO, ALPHA KAPPA ALPHA) HAVE FOUNDATIONS OR COMMITTEES THAT OFFER SCHOLARSHIPS TO DESERVING STUDENTS, OFTEN INCLUDING THOSE PURSUING THE ARTS.

HIGH SCHOOL GUIDANCE COUNSELORS

YOUR HIGH SCHOOL GUIDANCE COUNSELOR IS AN INVALUABLE RESOURCE. THEY OFTEN HAVE ACCESS TO SCHOLARSHIP LISTINGS COMPILED SPECIFICALLY FOR THEIR STUDENTS AND CAN PROVIDE PERSONALIZED ADVICE ON IDENTIFYING AND APPLYING FOR OPPORTUNITIES.

CRAFTING A WINNING SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

SUBMITTING A STRONG SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION IS PARAMOUNT TO SECURING AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS. IT'S NOT MERELY ABOUT MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS; IT'S ABOUT PRESENTING YOURSELF AS THE MOST DESERVING CANDIDATE. THIS INVOLVES METICULOUS ATTENTION TO DETAIL, A CLEAR ARTICULATION OF YOUR PASSION AND GOALS, AND A POLISHED PRESENTATION OF YOUR ARTISTIC ACHIEVEMENTS.

UNDERSTANDING THE SCHOLARSHIP'S PURPOSE AND CRITERIA

BEFORE WRITING A SINGLE WORD, THOROUGHLY RESEARCH THE SPECIFIC SCHOLARSHIP. WHAT IS ITS MISSION? WHAT QUALITIES DOES IT SEEK IN A RECIPIENT? UNDERSTANDING THE SCHOLARSHIP PROVIDER'S VALUES AND OBJECTIVES WILL ALLOW YOU TO TAILOR YOUR APPLICATION TO THEIR SPECIFIC INTERESTS. FOR INSTANCE, A SCHOLARSHIP FROM A JAZZ FOUNDATION WILL LOOK FOR DIFFERENT QUALITIES THAN ONE FOCUSED ON CONTEMPORARY THEATER.

DEVELOPING A COMPELLING PERSONAL STATEMENT/ESSAY

THE PERSONAL ESSAY IS OFTEN YOUR PRIMARY OPPORTUNITY TO CONNECT WITH THE SELECTION COMMITTEE ON A PERSONAL LEVEL. IT SHOULD:

- **TELL YOUR STORY:** SHARE YOUR ARTISTIC JOURNEY, HIGHLIGHTING KEY EXPERIENCES THAT SHAPED YOUR PASSION AND COMMITMENT.

- **SHOWCASE YOUR PASSION:** CONVEY YOUR GENUINE LOVE FOR YOUR CHOSEN ART FORM AND YOUR DEDICATION TO CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT.
- **ADDRESS THE PROMPT DIRECTLY:** IF THERE'S A SPECIFIC QUESTION ASKED, ENSURE YOUR ESSAY DIRECTLY ANSWERS IT.
- **HIGHLIGHT YOUR UNIQUE CONTRIBUTION:** EXPLAIN WHAT UNIQUE PERSPECTIVES OR EXPERIENCES YOU BRING AS AN

AFRICAN AMERICAN ARTIST.

AVOID Cliches AND GENERIC STATEMENTS. BE AUTHENTIC AND SPECIFIC.

PREPARING A STRONG RESUME OR CV

YOUR RESUME OR CURRICULUM VITAE (CV) SHOULD SHOWCASE YOUR ARTISTIC EXPERIENCE AND ACHIEVEMENTS. INCLUDE:

- **PERFORMANCE EXPERIENCE:** LIST ROLES, PRODUCTIONS, VENUES, AND DATES.
- **AWARDS AND HONORS:** DETAIL ANY PREVIOUS RECOGNITION FOR YOUR ARTISTIC WORK.
- **TRAINING AND EDUCATION:** HIGHLIGHT RELEVANT COURSEWORK, WORKSHOPS, AND MENTORS.
- **SKILLS:** LIST RELEVANT PERFORMANCE SKILLS (E.G., VOCAL RANGE, DANCE STYLES, INSTRUMENTAL PROFICIENCY, LANGUAGES).
- **EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:** INCLUDE LEADERSHIP ROLES OR VOLUNTEER WORK RELATED TO THE ARTS.

KEEP IT CONCISE, WELL-ORGANIZED, AND FREE OF ERRORS.

SELECTING AND PREPARING RECOMMENDATION LETTERS

CHOOSE RECOMMENDERS WHO KNOW YOU WELL AND CAN SPEAK ENTHUSIASTICALLY ABOUT YOUR TALENT, WORK ETHIC, AND CHARACTER. PROVIDE THEM WITH AMPLE TIME AND INFORMATION, INCLUDING:

- A COPY OF YOUR RESUME.
- A DRAFT OF YOUR PERSONAL STATEMENT.
- SPECIFIC DETAILS ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP YOU ARE APPLYING FOR.
- THE DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION AND HOW TO SUBMIT THE LETTER.

WAIVE YOUR RIGHT TO VIEW THE LETTERS TO INCREASE THEIR CREDIBILITY.

MASTERING THE AUDITION OR PORTFOLIO SUBMISSION

FOR PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS, AUDITIONS AND PORTFOLIOS ARE CRITICAL. THIS REQUIRES EXTENSIVE PREPARATION:

- **AUDITION MATERIAL:** SELECT PIECES THAT SHOWCASE YOUR BEST ABILITIES AND FIT THE SCHOLARSHIP'S REQUIREMENTS. REHEARSE THEM UNTIL THEY ARE POLISHED AND CONFIDENT.
- **PERFORMANCE QUALITY:** PAY ATTENTION TO YOUR PRESENTATION – ATTIRE, DEMEANOR, AND STAGE PRESENCE.
- **TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:** ENSURE YOUR VIDEO OR AUDIO RECORDINGS MEET THE SPECIFIED QUALITY STANDARDS.
- **PORTFOLIO PRESENTATION:** IF SUBMITTING A PORTFOLIO (E.G., FOR A PLAYWRIGHT OR FILMMAKER), ENSURE IT IS PROFESSIONALLY ORGANIZED AND HIGHLIGHTS YOUR STRONGEST WORK.

PROOFREADING AND EDITING

ERRORS IN GRAMMAR, SPELLING, OR PUNCTUATION CAN DETRACT FROM EVEN THE STRONGEST APPLICATION. METICULOUSLY PROOFREAD ALL WRITTEN MATERIALS. ASK A TRUSTED FRIEND, MENTOR, OR TEACHER TO REVIEW YOUR ESSAYS AND APPLICATION FOR CLARITY, COHERENCE, AND CORRECTNESS.

NAVIGATING THE APPLICATION PROCESS

THE PROCESS OF APPLYING FOR AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS CAN SEEM DAUNTING, BUT BY BREAKING IT DOWN INTO MANAGEABLE STEPS AND MAINTAINING ORGANIZATION, YOU CAN NAVIGATE IT SUCCESSFULLY. PROACTIVE PLANNING AND CAREFUL EXECUTION ARE KEY TO MAXIMIZING YOUR CHANCES OF SUCCESS.

CREATE A SCHOLARSHIP TRACKER

TO STAY ORGANIZED, CREATE A SPREADSHEET OR DOCUMENT TO TRACK ALL THE SCHOLARSHIPS YOU ARE CONSIDERING. INCLUDE COLUMNS FOR:

- SCHOLARSHIP NAME
- PROVIDER
- DEADLINE
- ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS
- APPLICATION MATERIALS REQUIRED (E.G., ESSAY PROMPT, RECOMMENDATION LETTER NEEDS, AUDITION REQUIREMENTS)
- STATUS (E.G., RESEARCHING, PREPARING, SUBMITTED, ACCEPTED, REJECTED)
- AWARD AMOUNT
- CONTACT INFORMATION

THIS WILL PREVENT MISSED DEADLINES AND ENSURE YOU ARE GATHERING ALL NECESSARY COMPONENTS FOR EACH APPLICATION.

READ APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY

EVERY SCHOLARSHIP PROVIDER HAS SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS. DEVIATING FROM THESE INSTRUCTIONS, EVEN IN SMALL WAYS, CAN LEAD TO AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFICATION. PAY CLOSE ATTENTION TO FORMATTING REQUIREMENTS, SUBMISSION METHODS, AND ANY SPECIFIC QUESTIONS THAT NEED TO BE ADDRESSED IN ESSAYS OR INTERVIEWS.

TAILOR EACH APPLICATION

AVOID USING A GENERIC "ONE-SIZE-FITS-ALL" APPROACH. WHILE SOME ELEMENTS MAY BE REUSABLE, EACH APPLICATION SHOULD BE TAILORED TO THE SPECIFIC SCHOLARSHIP PROVIDER. THIS MEANS ADJUSTING YOUR PERSONAL STATEMENT TO ALIGN WITH THE SCHOLARSHIP'S MISSION AND HIGHLIGHTING EXPERIENCES MOST RELEVANT TO ITS CRITERIA.

REQUEST RECOMMENDATION LETTERS EARLY

GIVE YOUR RECOMMENDERS AT LEAST 3-4 WEEKS' NOTICE BEFORE THE DEADLINE. PROVIDE THEM WITH ALL THE NECESSARY INFORMATION AND MATERIALS TO HELP THEM WRITE A STRONG, PERSONALIZED LETTER ON YOUR BEHALF.

PREPARE FOR AUDITIONS AND INTERVIEWS

FOR PERFORMANCE-FOCUSED SCHOLARSHIPS, AUDITIONS AND INTERVIEWS ARE CRITICAL. PRACTICE YOUR MATERIAL THOROUGHLY, RESEARCH COMMON INTERVIEW QUESTIONS FOR ARTS PROGRAMS, AND BE PREPARED TO DISCUSS YOUR ARTISTIC PHILOSOPHY, INFLUENCES, AND GOALS.

SUBMIT APPLICATIONS WELL BEFORE THE DEADLINE

DON'T WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE. SUBMITTING YOUR APPLICATION A FEW DAYS EARLY ALLOWS TIME TO ADDRESS ANY TECHNICAL GLITCHES WITH ONLINE SUBMISSION PORTALS OR TO MAKE ANY LAST-MINUTE CORRECTIONS. IT ALSO REDUCES STRESS.

FOLLOW UP APPROPRIATELY

IF YOU HAVE NOT HEARD BACK AFTER A REASONABLE AMOUNT OF TIME FOLLOWING THE STATED NOTIFICATION PERIOD, A POLITE FOLLOW-UP EMAIL TO THE SCHOLARSHIP ADMINISTRATOR MAY BE APPROPRIATE. ENSURE YOUR FOLLOW-UP IS PROFESSIONAL AND CONCISE.

THE IMPACT OF AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

THE INFLUENCE OF AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS EXTENDS FAR BEYOND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE, PLAYING A PIVOTAL ROLE IN SHAPING THE CAREERS AND LIVES OF RECIPIENTS AND CONTRIBUTING TO THE BROADER CULTURAL LANDSCAPE. WHAT ARE THE MOST COMMON CRITERIA FOR AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS?

YES, MANY HBCUs OFFER PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS TO SUPPORT STUDENTS IN THEIR THEATER, MUSIC, AND DANCE PROGRAMS. THESE CAN RANGE FROM DEPARTMENTAL AWARDS TO INSTITUTIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS SPECIFICALLY AIMED AT FOSTERING BLACK ARTISTIC TALENT WITHIN THE HBCU SYSTEM. DIRECT INQUIRY WITH THE ADMISSIONS AND ARTS DEPARTMENTS OF HBCUs IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED.

WHAT TYPES OF PERFORMANCE ART ARE TYPICALLY COVERED BY AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS?

THESE SCHOLARSHIPS GENERALLY COVER A BROAD SPECTRUM OF PERFORMANCE ARTS, INCLUDING THEATER (ACTING, DIRECTING, PLAYWRITING), MUSIC (VOCAL PERFORMANCE, INSTRUMENTAL, COMPOSITION), DANCE (VARIOUS STYLES), AND SPOKEN WORD POETRY. SOME MAY ALSO EXTEND TO PERFORMANCE-BASED INTERDISCIPLINARY STUDIES OR DIGITAL PERFORMANCE ART.

WHAT MAKES A SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION STAND OUT FOR AN AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIP?

A COMPELLING APPLICATION OFTEN HIGHLIGHTS A UNIQUE ARTISTIC VOICE, A CLEAR VISION FOR HOW PERFORMANCE CAN CONTRIBUTE TO THE AFRICAN AMERICAN COMMUNITY OR BROADER SOCIETY, A STRONG PORTFOLIO OR AUDITION REEL SHOWCASING SKILL AND POTENTIAL, A WELL-ARTICULATED PERSONAL STATEMENT CONNECTING ARTISTIC GOALS WITH CULTURAL IDENTITY, AND IMPACTFUL LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION FROM MENTORS OR TEACHERS.

ARE THERE SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE FOR GRADUATE-LEVEL AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMANCE STUDIES?

ABSOLUTELY. NUMEROUS SCHOLARSHIPS EXIST FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS PURSUING ADVANCED DEGREES IN PERFORMANCE-RELATED FIELDS, INCLUDING MASTER'S AND DOCTORAL PROGRAMS. THESE OFTEN FOCUS ON RESEARCH, SPECIALIZED ARTISTIC TRAINING, AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF EMERGING SCHOLARS AND PRACTITIONERS WITHIN THE AFRICAN AMERICAN ARTISTIC LANDSCAPE.
