

COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS CORE THESIS EXPLAINED

THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO, AUTHORED BY KARL MARX AND FRIEDRICH ENGELS IN 1848, REMAINS ONE OF THE MOST INFLUENTIAL AND CONTROVERSIAL POLITICAL DOCUMENTS IN HISTORY. ITS ENDURING POWER LIES IN ITS SUCCINCT YET POTENT ARTICULATION OF A VISION FOR SOCIETAL TRANSFORMATION. THEIR ANALYSIS WAS NOT MERELY AN ABSTRACT PHILOSOPHICAL EXERCISE; IT WAS A DIRECT RESPONSE TO THE LIVED REALITIES OF MILLIONS OF PEOPLE SUBJECTED TO HARSH

WORKING CONDITIONS, LOW WAGES, AND SOCIAL DISENFRANCHISEMENT. THE DOCUMENT ITSELF IS A TESTAMENT TO THEIR BELIEF IN THE AGENCY OF THE WORKING CLASS TO SHAPE THEIR OWN DESTINY, MOVING BEYOND MERE OBSERVATION TO ADVOCATING FOR ACTIVE PARTICIPATION IN REVOLUTIONARY CHANGE.

THE CORE THESIS OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO EXPLAINED: CLASS STRUGGLE AS THE ENGINE OF HISTORY

THE FUNDAMENTAL COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS CORE THESIS EXPLAINED IS THAT HISTORY IS NOT DRIVEN BY IDEAS, GREAT INDIVIDUALS, OR DIVINE INTERVENTION, BUT BY THE ONGOING CONFLICT BETWEEN DIFFERENT SOCIAL CLASSES, EACH WITH ITS OWN ECONOMIC INTERESTS. MARX AND ENGELS FAMOUSLY BEGIN THE MANIFESTO BY STATING, "THE HISTORY OF ALL HITHERTO EXISTING SOCIETY IS THE HISTORY OF CLASS STRUGGLES." THIS DECLARATION SETS THE STAGE FOR THEIR ENTIRE ARGUMENT. THEY POSIT THAT THROUGHOUT HISTORY, VARIOUS FORMS OF CLASS ANTAGONISM HAVE EXISTED, FROM THE ANCIENT MASTER AND SLAVE, TO THE MEDIEVAL LORD AND SERF, AND ULTIMATELY, IN THEIR TIME, THE BOURGEOISIE AND THE PROLETARIAT.

BOURGEOISIE AND PROLETARIAT: THE CENTRAL CONFLICT

IN THE CAPITALIST SYSTEM THAT MARX AND ENGELS ANALYZED, THE PRIMARY CLASS DIVISION IS BETWEEN THE BOURGEOISIE AND THE PROLETARIAT. THE BOURGEOISIE, IN THIS CONTEXT, REFERS TO THE OWNERS OF THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION – THE FACTORIES, LAND, MACHINERY, AND CAPITAL. THEY ARE THE EMPLOYERS WHO CONTROL THE ECONOMIC INFRASTRUCTURE OF SOCIETY. THE PROLETARIAT, CONVERSELY, COMPRISES THE WORKING CLASS, WHO POSSESS NO MEANS OF PRODUCTION OF THEIR OWN AND MUST SELL THEIR LABOR POWER TO THE BOURGEOISIE IN ORDER TO SURVIVE. THIS INHERENT POWER IMBALANCE, ROOTED IN THE OWNERSHIP OF CAPITAL, FORMS THE BEDROCK OF THEIR ANALYSIS. THE BOURGEOISIE PROFITS FROM THE LABOR OF THE PROLETARIAT, CREATING A FUNDAMENTAL CONFLICT OF INTEREST THAT, ACCORDING TO THE MANIFESTO, INEVITABLY ESCALATES.

HISTORICAL MATERIALISM: THE FOUNDATION OF MARX AND ENGELS' ANALYSIS

THE CONCEPT OF HISTORICAL MATERIALISM UNDERPINS THE ENTIRE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS CORE THESIS EXPLAINED. THIS PHILOSOPHICAL APPROACH SUGGESTS THAT MATERIAL CONDITIONS, PARTICULARLY ECONOMIC FACTORS AND THE RELATIONS OF PRODUCTION, ARE THE PRIMARY DETERMINANTS OF SOCIAL, POLITICAL, AND INTELLECTUAL LIFE. MARX AND ENGELS ARGUED THAT THE ECONOMIC "BASE" OF SOCIETY – THE WAY IN WHICH GOODS ARE PRODUCED AND DISTRIBUTED – SHAPES THE "SUPERSTRUCTURE," WHICH INCLUDES INSTITUTIONS LIKE THE STATE, LAW, RELIGION, AND CULTURE. CHANGES IN THE MODE OF PRODUCTION, THEY BELIEVED, LEAD TO CHANGES IN THE SUPERSTRUCTURE, AND THESE CHANGES ARE OFTEN DRIVEN BY CLASS CONFLICT. THEY SAW CAPITALISM NOT AS A STATIC SYSTEM, BUT AS A HISTORICAL PHASE THAT, LIKE ALL PREVIOUS MODES OF PRODUCTION, CONTAINED THE SEEDS OF ITS OWN DESTRUCTION.

THE INEVITABLE DOWNFALL OF CAPITALISM

A CRUCIAL ELEMENT OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS CORE THESIS EXPLAINED IS THE ASSERTION THAT CAPITALISM, BY ITS VERY NATURE, IS A SYSTEM PRONE TO CRISES AND DESTINED TO BE SUPERSEDED. MARX AND ENGELS ARGUED THAT THE BOURGEOISIE, IN ITS RELENTLESS PURSUIT OF PROFIT, WOULD CONTINUOUSLY REVOLUTIONIZE THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION, LEADING TO INCREASED PRODUCTIVITY BUT ALSO TO THE CONCENTRATION OF WEALTH AND THE IMMISERATION OF THE PROLETARIAT. THEY PREDICTED THAT CAPITALISM'S INTERNAL CONTRADICTIONS – SUCH AS OVERPRODUCTION, RECURRENT ECONOMIC DEPRESSIONS, AND THE GROWING SIZE AND ORGANIZATION OF THE PROLETARIAT – WOULD ULTIMATELY LEAD TO ITS COLLAPSE. THE PROLETARIAT, INCREASINGLY UNIFIED AND AWARE OF ITS EXPLOITED CONDITION, WOULD THEN RISE UP TO OVERTHROW THE BOURGEOISIE AND ESTABLISH A NEW SOCIAL ORDER.

KEY CONCEPTS SUPPORTING THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS

BEYOND THE CENTRAL THESIS OF CLASS STRUGGLE, SEVERAL INTERCONNECTED CONCEPTS ARE VITAL TO UNDERSTANDING THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS CORE THESIS EXPLAINED. THESE CONCEPTS ILLUMINATE THE MECHANISMS OF CAPITALIST EXPLOITATION AND THE RATIONALE BEHIND THE PROPOSED COMMUNIST REVOLUTION.

ALIENATION UNDER CAPITALISM

MARX AND ENGELS ARGUED THAT CAPITALISM ALIENATES WORKERS FROM THEIR LABOR, THE PRODUCTS OF THEIR LABOR, THEMSELVES, AND THEIR FELLOW HUMAN BEINGS. UNDER FEUDALISM, A SERF MIGHT FEEL A CONNECTION TO THE LAND THEY WORKED. UNDER EARLY CRAFT PRODUCTION, AN ARTISAN MIGHT FEEL PRIDE IN THE FINISHED PRODUCT. HOWEVER, IN THE CAPITALIST FACTORY, THE WORKER BECOMES A MERE COG IN A MACHINE, PERFORMING REPETITIVE TASKS FOR WAGES. THEY HAVE NO OWNERSHIP OVER WHAT THEY PRODUCE, NO CONTROL OVER THE LABOR PROCESS, AND THEIR WORK BECOMES AN EXTERNAL ACTIVITY RATHER THAN AN EXPRESSION OF THEIR CREATIVE POTENTIAL. THIS ALIENATION, THEY ARGUED, IS A FUNDAMENTAL DEHUMANIZING ASPECT OF CAPITALISM.

EXPLOITATION AND SURPLUS VALUE

THE CONCEPT OF EXPLOITATION IS CENTRAL TO THE MANIFESTO'S CRITIQUE OF CAPITALISM. MARX AND ENGELS ARGUED THAT THE PROFIT GENERATED BY CAPITALIST ENTERPRISES IS DERIVED FROM "SURPLUS VALUE." THIS IS THE VALUE THAT THE WORKER CREATES BEYOND THE COST OF THEIR OWN LABOR POWER (REPRESENTED BY THEIR WAGES). THE CAPITALIST PURCHASES THE WORKER'S ABILITY TO WORK FOR A CERTAIN PERIOD, BUT THE VALUE PRODUCED BY THAT LABOR OFTEN EXCEEDS THE WAGES PAID. THIS SURPLUS VALUE IS APPROPRIATED BY THE CAPITALIST AS PROFIT, REPRESENTING THE UNPAID LABOR OF THE PROLETARIAT. THIS FORM OF EXPLOITATION, THEY CONTENDED, IS INHERENT TO THE CAPITALIST MODE OF PRODUCTION AND IS THE SOURCE OF THE BOURGEOISIE'S WEALTH AND THE PROLETARIAT'S POVERTY.

THE ROLE OF THE PROLETARIAT AS THE REVOLUTIONARY CLASS

THE MANIFESTO PLACES IMMENSE FAITH IN THE PROLETARIAT AS THE AGENT OF HISTORICAL CHANGE. UNLIKE PREVIOUS EXPLOITED CLASSES, SUCH AS THE SERFS, THE PROLETARIAT, DUE TO ITS POSITION WITHIN THE INDUSTRIAL SYSTEM, IS SEEN AS INHERENTLY CAPABLE OF ORGANIZING AND UNITING ON A GLOBAL SCALE. THE CONCENTRATION OF WORKERS IN FACTORIES, THEIR SHARED EXPERIENCE OF EXPLOITATION, AND THEIR LACK OF PRIVATE PROPERTY MAKE THEM A CLASS WITH NOTHING TO LOSE BUT THEIR CHAINS. THEIR REVOLUTION, THEREFORE, IS NOT MERELY ABOUT REPLACING ONE RULING CLASS WITH ANOTHER, BUT ABOUT ABOLISHING CLASS DISTINCTIONS ALTOGETHER. THE PROLETARIAT, IN THIS VIEW, IS THE UNIVERSAL CLASS WHOSE EMANCIPATION LEADS TO THE EMANCIPATION OF ALL HUMANITY.

ABOLITION OF PRIVATE PROPERTY

ONE OF THE MOST CONTROVERSIAL ASPECTS OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS CORE THESIS EXPLAINED IS THE CALL FOR THE "ABOLITION OF ALL RIGHT OF PRIVATE PROPERTY" IN THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION. IT IS CRUCIAL TO DISTINGUISH THIS FROM THE ABOLITION OF PERSONAL PROPERTY, SUCH AS ONE'S HOME OR PERSONAL BELONGINGS. MARX AND ENGELS WERE NOT ADVOCATING FOR A SOCIETY OF UNIVERSAL POVERTY OR THE CONFISCATION OF INDIVIDUAL POSSESSIONS. INSTEAD, THEY TARGETED "BOURGEOIS PRIVATE PROPERTY" – THE PRIVATE OWNERSHIP OF THE FACTORIES, LAND, AND CAPITAL THAT ALLOWS FOR THE EXPLOITATION OF LABOR. THEY ARGUED THAT BY ABOLISHING PRIVATE OWNERSHIP OF THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION AND TRANSFERRING IT TO COLLECTIVE OR PUBLIC OWNERSHIP, THE BASIS FOR CLASS EXPLOITATION WOULD BE ELIMINATED.

THE DICTATORSHIP OF THE PROLETARIAT

TO FACILITATE THE TRANSITION FROM CAPITALISM TO COMMUNISM, MARX AND ENGELS PROPOSED A TRANSITIONAL PHASE KNOWN AS THE "DICTATORSHIP OF THE PROLETARIAT." THIS IS NOT TO BE UNDERSTOOD AS A TYRANNICAL RULE BY AN INDIVIDUAL OR A SMALL CLIQUE, BUT RATHER AS THE POLITICAL DOMINANCE OF THE WORKING CLASS OVER THE BOURGEOISIE. DURING THIS PHASE, THE PROLETARIAT WOULD USE THE POWER OF THE STATE TO SUPPRESS ANY RESISTANCE FROM THE FORMER RULING CLASS, EXPROPRIATE THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION, AND BEGIN THE PROCESS OF BUILDING A COMMUNIST SOCIETY. THIS PERIOD WAS ENVISIONED AS TEMPORARY, ULTIMATELY LEADING TO THE "WITHERING AWAY OF THE STATE" AS CLASS DISTINCTIONS DISSOLVED.

THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS IN HISTORICAL CONTEXT

THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS CORE THESIS EXPLAINED DID NOT EMERGE IN A VACUUM. ITS IDEAS WERE DEEPLY INTERTWINED WITH THE SOCIO-ECONOMIC AND POLITICAL REALITIES OF THE 19TH CENTURY.

THE INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION AND ITS SOCIAL IMPACT

THE RAPID INDUSTRIALIZATION THAT BEGAN IN GREAT BRITAIN AND SPREAD ACROSS EUROPE HAD PROFOUND SOCIAL CONSEQUENCES. IT LED TO THE GROWTH OF LARGE URBAN CENTERS, THE CONCENTRATION OF WORKERS IN FACTORIES, AND THE CREATION OF A NEW INDUSTRIAL WORKING CLASS. WHILE INDUSTRIALIZATION GENERATED UNPRECEDENTED WEALTH, IT WAS OFTEN ACCOMPANIED BY APPALLING WORKING AND LIVING CONDITIONS FOR THE PROLETARIAT. LONG HOURS, DANGEROUS MACHINERY, CHILD LABOR, AND WIDESPREAD POVERTY WERE COMMONPLACE. THIS STARK CONTRAST BETWEEN THE WEALTH OF THE INDUSTRIALISTS AND THE POVERTY OF THE WORKERS PROVIDED FERTILE GROUND FOR RADICAL POLITICAL IDEAS, INCLUDING THOSE ARTICULATED IN THE MANIFESTO.

THE RISE OF SOCIALIST AND COMMUNIST MOVEMENTS

THE SOCIETAL UPEHAVALS OF THE INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION ALSO FUELED THE GROWTH OF VARIOUS SOCIALIST AND COMMUNIST MOVEMENTS. THINKERS AND ACTIVISTS DEBATED DIFFERENT APPROACHES TO ADDRESSING SOCIAL INEQUALITY AND WORKER EXPLOITATION. MARX AND ENGELS, WHILE DRAWING ON EARLIER SOCIALIST TRADITIONS, OFFERED A DISTINCT AND MORE SYSTEMATIC ANALYSIS THAT EMPHASIZED THE HISTORICAL INEVITABILITY OF A PROLETARIAN REVOLUTION. THEIR WORK SOUGHT TO UNIFY THE DIVERSE STRANDS OF SOCIALIST THOUGHT INTO A COHERENT AND ACTIONABLE POLITICAL PROGRAM, AIMING TO PROVIDE A THEORETICAL AND PRACTICAL ROADMAP FOR THE WORKING CLASS TO ACHIEVE ITS LIBERATION.

CRITIQUES AND ENDURING RELEVANCE OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS

THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS CORE THESIS EXPLAINED HAS BEEN SUBJECTED TO EXTENSIVE CRITICISM SINCE ITS PUBLICATION, YET IT CONTINUES TO RESONATE AND PROVOKE DISCUSSION.

CRITICISMS OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS

- **ECONOMIC DETERMINISM:** CRITICS ARGUE THAT MARX AND ENGELS OVEREMPHASIZED ECONOMIC FACTORS, NEGLECTING THE INFLUENCE OF CULTURE, IDEAS, AND INDIVIDUAL AGENCY IN SHAPING HISTORY.

- **THE INEVITABILITY OF REVOLUTION:** THE PREDICTION THAT CAPITALISM WOULD INEVITABLY COLLAPSE AND BE REPLACED BY COMMUNISM HAS NOT MATERIALIZED UNIVERSALLY AS ENVISIONED. MANY CAPITALIST SOCIETIES HAVE ADAPTED AND REFORMED TO MITIGATE SOME OF THE HARSH ASPECTS OF EXPLOITATION.
- **THE FAILURE OF COMMUNIST STATES:** THE HISTORICAL EXPERIENCES OF STATES THAT ATTEMPTED TO IMPLEMENT MARXIST-LENINIST PRINCIPLES IN THE 20TH CENTURY WERE OFTEN MARKED BY AUTHORITARIANISM, ECONOMIC INEFFICIENCY, AND HUMAN RIGHTS ABUSES, LEADING TO WIDESPREAD CRITIQUES OF THE PRACTICAL APPLICATION OF THE COMMUNIST IDEAL.
- **OVERSIMPLIFICATION OF CLASS:** CRITICS SUGGEST THAT THE STRICT DICHOTOMY BETWEEN BOURGEOISIE AND PROLETARIAT OVERSIMPLIFIES THE COMPLEX CLASS STRUCTURES THAT EXIST IN MODERN SOCIETIES.

THE ENDURING LEGACY AND RELEVANCE OF THE CORE THESIS

DESPITE THESE CRITICISMS, THE CORE TENETS OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS CORE THESIS EXPLAINED CONTINUE TO OFFER VALUABLE INSIGHTS INTO THE DYNAMICS OF POWER, INEQUALITY, AND ECONOMIC SYSTEMS. THE ANALYSIS OF CLASS STRUGGLE, THE CRITIQUE OF EXPLOITATION, AND THE IDENTIFICATION OF ALIENATION REMAIN RELEVANT FOR UNDERSTANDING CONTEMPORARY SOCIETAL ISSUES. THE MANIFESTO'S CALL FOR COLLECTIVE ACTION AND ITS EXAMINATION OF THE WAYS IN WHICH ECONOMIC SYSTEMS SHAPE SOCIAL RELATIONS PROMPT ONGOING REFLECTION ON HOW TO CREATE MORE JUST AND EQUITABLE SOCIETIES. MANY OF THE SOCIAL REFORMS ACHIEVED IN CAPITALIST COUNTRIES, SUCH AS LABOR PROTECTIONS, WELFARE SYSTEMS, AND PROGRESSIVE TAXATION, CAN BE SEEN, IN PART, AS RESPONSES TO THE PRESSURES AND CRITIQUES HIGHLIGHTED BY MARX AND ENGELS.

CONCLUSION: THE ENDURING POWER OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS

IN CONCLUSION, THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS CORE THESIS EXPLAINED POSITS THAT HISTORY IS FUNDAMENTALLY A NARRATIVE OF CLASS STRUGGLE, CULMINATING IN THE REVOLUTIONARY OVERTHROW OF CAPITALISM BY THE PROLETARIAT. WHILE ITS PREDICTIONS AND PROPOSED SOLUTIONS HAVE BEEN DEBATED AND OFTEN CONTESTED, THE ENDURING RELEVANCE OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS CORE THESIS EXPLAINED LIES IN ITS INCISIVE ANALYSIS OF POWER DYNAMICS, ECONOMIC EXPLOITATION, AND THE PERSISTENT HUMAN DESIRE FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE. IT REMAINS A FOUNDATIONAL TEXT FOR UNDERSTANDING CRITIQUES OF CAPITALISM AND THE ONGOING DISCOURSE SURROUNDING SOCIETAL ORGANIZATION AND EQUALITY.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS THE CORE THESIS OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO?

THE CORE THESIS OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO IS THAT HISTORY IS A STRUGGLE BETWEEN OPPOSING SOCIAL CLASSES, AND THAT IN MODERN CAPITALIST SOCIETY, THIS STRUGGLE IS PRIMARILY BETWEEN THE BOURGEOISIE (THE OWNING CLASS) AND THE PROLETARIAT (THE WORKING CLASS). HOW DOES THE MANIFESTO EXPLAIN THE ROLE OF CLASS STRUGGLE?

THE MANIFESTO VIEWS CLASS STRUGGLE AS THE FUNDAMENTAL ENGINE OF HISTORICAL CHANGE. IT POSITS THAT THROUGHOUT

HISTORY, DIFFERENT CLASSES HAVE BEEN IN CONFLICT OVER THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION. IN CAPITALISM, THE BOURGEOISIE'S DRIVE FOR PROFIT NECESSITATES THE EXPLOITATION OF THE PROLETARIAT, THUS INTENSIFYING THIS INHERENT CONFLICT AND SETTING THE STAGE FOR REVOLUTIONARY CHANGE.

WHAT IS THE BOURGEOISIE ACCORDING TO THE MANIFESTO, AND WHAT IS ITS HISTORICAL ROLE?

THE BOURGEOISIE, IN THE MANIFESTO'S ANALYSIS, IS THE CAPITALIST CLASS THAT OWNS THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION (Factories, Land, etc.). ITS HISTORICAL ROLE IS DESCRIBED AS A REVOLUTIONARY ONE, HAVING DESTROYED FEUDALISM AND USHERED IN AN ERA OF UNPRECEDENTED INDUSTRIAL AND TECHNOLOGICAL ADVANCEMENT. HOWEVER, THE MANIFESTO ARGUES THAT THE BOURGEOISIE'S OWN SUCCESS HAS CREATED THE CONDITIONS FOR ITS DOWNFALL BY CREATING A LARGE, ORGANIZED, AND INCREASINGLY POWERFUL PROLETARIAT.

WHO ARE THE PROLETARIAT, AND WHAT IS THEIR SIGNIFICANCE IN THE MANIFESTO'S THESIS?

THE PROLETARIAT ARE THE WAGE-LABORERS, THE WORKING CLASS, WHO DO NOT OWN THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION AND MUST SELL THEIR LABOR POWER TO SURVIVE. THEIR SIGNIFICANCE LIES IN THEIR SHEER NUMBERS AND THEIR COLLECTIVE EXPLOITATION UNDER CAPITALISM. THE MANIFESTO ARGUES THAT THEY ARE THE ONLY TRULY REVOLUTIONARY CLASS, DESTINED TO OVERTHROW THE BOURGEOISIE AND ESTABLISH A NEW, EGALITARIAN SOCIETY.

WHAT IS THE ULTIMATE GOAL OF THE REVOLUTION ENVISIONED IN THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO?

THE ULTIMATE GOAL OF THE REVOLUTION ENVISIONED IN THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO IS THE ABOLITION OF PRIVATE PROPERTY IN THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION, THE ERADICATION OF CLASS DISTINCTIONS, AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CLASSLESS SOCIETY. HOW DOES THE MANIFESTO ADDRESS THE ACCUSATION OF ADVOCATING FOR THE ABOLITION OF INDIVIDUALITY AND FREEDOM?

THE MANIFESTO COUNTERS THIS ACCUSATION BY ARGUING THAT THE 'INDIVIDUALITY,' 'INDEPENDENCE,' AND 'FREEDOM' CELEBRATED UNDER BOURGEOIS SOCIETY ARE, FOR THE VAST MAJORITY (THE PROLETARIAT), MERELY THE FREEDOM TO WORK AND THE INDEPENDENCE TO BE EXPLOITED. IT CLAIMS THAT TRUE INDIVIDUALITY AND FREEDOM CAN ONLY BE REALIZED IN A COMMUNIST SOCIETY FREE FROM CLASS OPPRESSION AND ECONOMIC INSECURITY.

WHAT IS THE MANIFESTO'S VIEW ON THE ROLE OF COMMUNISM IN RELATION TO NATIONAL IDENTITY AND TRADITIONAL INSTITUTIONS?

THE MANIFESTO ARGUES THAT COMMUNISM SEEKS TO ABOLISH NATIONAL BARRIERS AND TRADITIONAL INSTITUTIONS (LIKE FAMILY, RELIGION, AND PATRIOTISM) THAT IT SEES AS INSTRUMENTS OF BOURGEOIS CONTROL AND PERPETUATION OF CLASS DIVISION. IT PROPOSES THAT THE 'PROLETARIANS HAVE NO COUNTRY' AND THAT AN INTERNATIONAL SOLIDARITY OF WORKERS IS ESSENTIAL TO ACHIEVE THE COMMUNIST REVOLUTION.
