

# COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS FUNDAMENTAL ARGUMENTS

THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO, PENNED BY KARL MARX AND FRIEDRICH ENGELS, REMAINS ONE OF THE MOST INFLUENTIAL POLITICAL DOCUMENTS IN HISTORY. ITS ENDURING POWER LIES IN ITS INCISIVE ANALYSIS OF SOCIETAL STRUCTURES AND ITS BOLD PRONOUNCEMENTS ON THE TRAJECTORY OF HUMAN HISTORY. 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## THE HISTORICAL CONTEXT OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO

TO FULLY GRASP THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS AND ITS FUNDAMENTAL ARGUMENTS, IT IS ESSENTIAL TO UNDERSTAND THE HISTORICAL MILIEU IN WHICH IT WAS CONCEIVED. PUBLISHED IN 1848, THE MANIFESTO EMERGED DURING A PERIOD OF SIGNIFICANT SOCIAL, ECONOMIC, AND POLITICAL UPHEAVAL ACROSS EUROPE. THE INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION WAS IN FULL SWING, TRANSFORMING TRADITIONAL AGRARIAN SOCIETIES INTO INDUSTRIAL POWERHOUSES. THIS TRANSFORMATION, WHILE BRINGING ABOUT UNPRECEDENTED WEALTH AND TECHNOLOGICAL ADVANCEMENT, ALSO CREATED STARK SOCIAL INEQUALITIES. THE WORKING CLASS, THE PROLETARIAT, OFTEN FACED HARSH WORKING CONDITIONS, LOW WAGES, AND ABJECT POVERTY, WHILE THE CAPITALIST CLASS, THE BOURGEOISIE, ACCUMULATED VAST FORTUNES. THIS STARK CONTRAST FUELED WIDESPREAD DISCONTENT AND INSPIRED VARIOUS REVOLUTIONARY MOVEMENTS SEEKING TO CHALLENGE THE EXISTING SOCIAL ORDER. MARX AND ENGELS, DEEPLY IMMERSSED IN THE INTELLECTUAL CURRENTS OF THEIR TIME, INCLUDING HEGELIAN PHILOSOPHY AND EARLY SOCIALIST THOUGHT, SOUGHT TO PROVIDE A RIGOROUS THEORETICAL FRAMEWORK TO EXPLAIN THESE SOCIETAL DYNAMICS AND TO GUIDE THE BURGEONING WORKERS' MOVEMENT.

## UNPACKING THE CORE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS

AT ITS HEART, THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS POSITS THAT HISTORY IS NOT A RANDOM UNFOLDING OF EVENTS BUT A PREDICTABLE PROCESS DRIVEN BY UNDERLYING ECONOMIC FORCES AND CLASS ANTAGONISMS. THE CENTRAL ARGUMENT IS THAT THE INHERENT CONTRADICTIONS WITHIN EACH MODE OF PRODUCTION EVENTUALLY LEAD TO ITS DOWNFALL AND THE RISE OF A NEW ONE. IN THE CONTEXT OF 19TH-CENTURY EUROPE, MARX AND ENGELS IDENTIFIED CAPITALISM AS THE DOMINANT MODE OF PRODUCTION AND THE BOURGEOISIE AND PROLETARIAT AS THE PRIMARY OPPOSING CLASSES. THEIR THESIS SUGGESTS THAT CAPITALISM, DESPITE ITS DYNAMISM, CONTAINS THE SEEDS OF ITS OWN DESTRUCTION. THE MANIFESTO ARGUES THAT THE BOURGEOISIE, BY CREATING A GLOBALIZED MARKET AND AN INCREASINGLY POWERFUL PROLETARIAT, INADVERTENTLY SETS THE STAGE FOR ITS OWN EVENTUAL OVERTHROW AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A COMMUNIST SOCIETY, FREE FROM CLASS EXPLOITATION.

## FUNDAMENTAL ARGUMENT 1: THE HISTORY OF ALL HITHERTO EXISTING SOCIETY IS THE HISTORY OF CLASS STRUGGLES

THIS FOUNDATIONAL STATEMENT, PERHAPS THE MOST ENDURING AND WIDELY RECOGNIZED OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO'S FUNDAMENTAL ARGUMENTS, SETS THE STAGE FOR MARX AND ENGELS' ENTIRE ANALYSIS. IT ASSERTS THAT THROUGHOUT HISTORY, FROM ANCIENT SLAVE SOCIETIES TO FEUDALISM, AND INTO THE CAPITALIST ERA, THE DRIVING FORCE OF SOCIAL CHANGE HAS BEEN THE CONFLICT BETWEEN DIFFERENT SOCIAL CLASSES. THESE CLASSES ARE DEFINED BY THEIR RELATIONSHIP TO THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION – THE TOOLS, FACTORIES, LAND, AND RAW MATERIALS USED TO PRODUCE GOODS AND SERVICES.

# UNDERSTANDING SOCIETAL ANTAGONISM

MARX AND ENGELS ARGUED THAT IN EVERY HISTORICAL EPOCH, THERE HAVE BEEN AT LEAST TWO MAJOR CLASSES: THE EXPLOITERS AND THE EXPLOITED. IN ANCIENT SOCIETIES, THIS WAS THE MASTER AND THE SLAVE. IN FEUDALISM, IT WAS THE LORD AND THE SERF. UNDER CAPITALISM, THE PRIMARY STRUGGLE IS BETWEEN THE BOURGEOISIE (THE OWNERS OF THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION) AND THE PROLETARIAT (THE WAGE LABORERS WHO SELL THEIR LABOR POWER). THIS ANTAGONISM IS NOT MERELY A MATTER OF DIFFERING OPINIONS OR INTERESTS; IT IS ROOTED IN THE FUNDAMENTAL ECONOMIC STRUCTURE OF SOCIETY, WHERE ONE CLASS BENEFITS AT THE EXPENSE OF THE OTHER. THE MANIFESTO CONTENDS THAT THESE CLASS STRUGGLES ARE THE ENGINE OF HISTORICAL PROGRESS, PUSHING SOCIETIES THROUGH VARIOUS STAGES OF DEVELOPMENT.

## THE EVOLUTION OF OPPRESSOR AND OPPRESSED CLASSES

THE MANIFESTO TRACES THIS EVOLUTION, HIGHLIGHTING HOW EACH DOMINANT CLASS, WHILE REVOLUTIONARY IN ITS OWN TIME, EVENTUALLY GIVES WAY TO A NEW CLASS THAT IT HAS CREATED. THE BOURGEOISIE, FOR EXAMPLE, OVERTHREW THE FEUDAL ARISTOCRACY. HOWEVER, IN DOING SO, THEY BROUGHT INTO EXISTENCE THE PROLETARIAT, A CLASS WHOSE CONDITIONS OF EXISTENCE ARE IN DIRECT OPPOSITION TO THOSE OF THE BOURGEOISIE. THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THESE CLASSES IS INHERENTLY EXPLOITATIVE, AS THE BOURGEOISIE EXTRACTS SURPLUS VALUE FROM THE LABOR OF THE PROLETARIAT, PAYING THEM ONLY ENOUGH TO SUBSIST AND REPRODUCE THEIR LABOR POWER. THIS INHERENT EXPLOITATION, THE MANIFESTO ARGUES, IS UNSUSTAINABLE IN THE LONG RUN.

## FUNDAMENTAL ARGUMENT 2: THE RISE OF THE BOURGEOISIE AND ITS REVOLUTIONARY ROLE

THE MANIFESTO DEDICATES CONSIDERABLE ATTENTION TO THE BOURGEOISIE, ACKNOWLEDGING ITS UNDENIABLY REVOLUTIONARY IMPACT ON THE WORLD. MARX AND ENGELS RECOGNIZED THAT THE BOURGEOISIE, THROUGH ITS RELENTLESS PURSUIT OF PROFIT, HAD ACCOMPLISHED FEATS THAT DWARFED ALL PREVIOUS HISTORICAL ACHIEVEMENTS. IT SHATTERED FEUDAL BONDS, BROKE DOWN TRADITIONAL SOCIAL STRUCTURES, AND UNLEASHED PRODUCTIVE FORCES THAT HAD PREVIOUSLY BEEN UNIMAGINABLE.

## THE BOURGEOISIE'S IMPACT ON PRODUCTION

THE FUNDAMENTAL ARGUMENT HERE IS THAT THE BOURGEOISIE REVOLUTIONIZED THE INSTRUMENTS OF PRODUCTION. THEY DEVELOPED NEW TECHNOLOGIES, MECHANIZED INDUSTRIES, AND REORGANIZED LABOR ON A MASSIVE SCALE. THIS LED TO AN EXPLOSION IN THE QUANTITY AND VARIETY OF GOODS PRODUCED, FUNDAMENTALLY ALTERING THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN HUMANITY AND NATURE. THE SHEER PRODUCTIVE POWER UNLEASHED BY CAPITALISM WAS, IN THE EYES OF MARX AND ENGELS, A NECESSARY PRECURSOR TO A MORE ADVANCED SOCIETY CAPABLE OF PROVIDING FOR THE NEEDS OF ALL.

## THE BOURGEOISIE'S GLOBALIZING TENDENCIES

ANOTHER KEY ARGUMENT CONCERNING THE BOURGEOISIE IS ITS INHERENT DRIVE TO EXPAND AND GLOBALIZE. TO MAINTAIN ITS PROFITABILITY, THE BOURGEOISIE MUST CONSTANTLY SEEK NEW MARKETS FOR ITS PRODUCTS AND NEW SOURCES OF RAW MATERIALS. THIS LED TO THE BREAKDOWN OF NATIONAL BARRIERS, THE INTERCONNECTEDNESS OF NATIONS, AND THE SPREAD OF CAPITALIST MODES OF PRODUCTION ACROSS THE GLOBE. THE MANIFESTO FAMOUSLY STATES THAT THE BOURGEOISIE HAS "CONCOCTED SO MUCH GREATER PRODUCTION THAN ALL THE EARLIER GENERATIONS PUT TOGETHER." THIS GLOBAL REACH, WHILE OFTEN ACCOMPANIED BY EXPLOITATION AND COLONIALISM, ALSO CREATED A GLOBAL WORKING CLASS WITH SHARED INTERESTS.

## THE BOURGEOISIE'S SELF-DESTRUCTIVE POTENTIAL

DESPITE ITS ACHIEVEMENTS, THE MANIFESTO ARGUES THAT THE BOURGEOISIE'S OWN SUCCESS CONTAINS THE SEEDS OF ITS DEMISE. THE CYCLICAL CRISES OF OVERPRODUCTION, WHERE THE MARKET BECOMES SATURATED WITH GOODS THAT CANNOT BE SOLD, DEMONSTRATE THE INHERENT INSTABILITY OF THE CAPITALIST SYSTEM. FURTHERMORE, AS THE BOURGEOISIE DEVELOPS

AND EXPANDS THE PROLETARIAT, IT CREATES A CLASS OF INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE INCREASINGLY ORGANIZED, CLASS-CONSCIOUS, AND ULTIMATELY, POSITIONED TO CHALLENGE BOURGEOIS RULE. THE VERY FORCES THAT THE BOURGEOISIE UNLEASHES – INDUSTRIALIZATION, URBANIZATION, AND MASS COMMUNICATION – ALSO SERVE TO UNITE THE PROLETARIAT.

## FUNDAMENTAL ARGUMENT 3: THE PROLETARIAT AS THE REVOLUTIONARY CLASS

FOLLOWING THEIR ANALYSIS OF THE BOURGEOISIE, THE MANIFESTO PIVOTS TO THE PROLETARIAT, IDENTIFYING IT AS THE CLASS DESTINED TO OVERTHROW CAPITALISM AND USHER IN A NEW ERA. THE ARGUMENTS PRESENTED HERE FOCUS ON THE PROLETARIAT'S UNIQUE POSITION WITHIN THE CAPITALIST SYSTEM AND ITS POTENTIAL TO BECOME A CONSCIOUS AGENT OF HISTORICAL CHANGE.

### THE PROLETARIAT'S UNIQUE POSITION

THE PROLETARIAT, MARX AND ENGELS ARGUE, IS FUNDAMENTALLY DIFFERENT FROM PREVIOUS OPPRESSED CLASSES. UNLIKE THE SERF WHO MIGHT HAVE HAD A STAKE IN THE LAND, OR THE ARTISAN WHO OWNED THEIR TOOLS, THE MODERN WORKER OWNS NOTHING BUT THEIR OWN LABOR POWER, WHICH THEY MUST SELL TO THE CAPITALIST TO SURVIVE. THIS COMPLETE DISPOSSESSION MAKES THE PROLETARIAT THE TRULY REVOLUTIONARY CLASS BECAUSE IT HAS NOTHING TO LOSE BUT ITS CHAINS. ITS INTERESTS ARE DIRECTLY OPPOSED TO THOSE OF THE BOURGEOISIE, AND ITS LIBERATION REQUIRES THE ABOLITION OF THE ENTIRE SYSTEM OF PRIVATE PROPERTY AND CLASS DOMINATION.

### THE PROLETARIAT'S PATH TO POWER

THE MANIFESTO OUTLINES A PATH FOR THE PROLETARIAT TO GAIN POWER. IT EMPHASIZES THE NEED FOR THE PROLETARIAT TO ORGANIZE ITSELF INTO A POLITICAL PARTY AND TO DEVELOP CLASS CONSCIOUSNESS – AN AWARENESS OF ITS SHARED INTERESTS AND ITS HISTORICAL MISSION. THIS ORGANIZED PROLETARIAT, THROUGH REVOLUTION, WOULD THEN SEIZE THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION FROM THE BOURGEOISIE AND ESTABLISH A DICTATORSHIP OF THE PROLETARIAT, A TRANSITIONAL PHASE DESIGNED TO CONSOLIDATE THE REVOLUTION AND SUPPRESS COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY FORCES. THIS PHASE WOULD BE CHARACTERIZED BY THE EXPROPRIATION OF THE BOURGEOISIE AND THE CENTRALIZATION OF THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION IN THE HANDS OF THE STATE, REPRESENTING THE PROLETARIAT.

### THE ABOLITION OF PRIVATE PROPERTY

A CENTRAL AND OFTEN CONTROVERSIAL ARGUMENT IS THE CALL FOR THE ABOLITION OF PRIVATE PROPERTY. THE MANIFESTO CLARIFIES THAT IT IS NOT THE PERSONAL PROPERTY ACQUIRED THROUGH ONE'S OWN LABOR (LIKE TOOLS OR A FAMILY HOME) THAT IS TARGETED, BUT RATHER THE PRIVATE OWNERSHIP OF THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION BY THE BOURGEOISIE, WHICH ENABLES THEM TO EXPLOIT THE LABOR OF OTHERS. THE ABOLITION OF THIS FORM OF PRIVATE PROPERTY IS SEEN AS THE KEY TO DISMANTLING CLASS SOCIETY AND ESTABLISHING A SYSTEM WHERE THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION ARE OWNED AND CONTROLLED BY SOCIETY AS A WHOLE, OR BY THE WORKING CLASS IN TRANSITION.

## FUNDAMENTAL ARGUMENT 4: THE COMMUNIST PROJECT AND THE VISION OF A CLASSLESS SOCIETY

THE FINAL MAJOR COMPONENT OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS CONCERNS THE ULTIMATE GOAL OF THE COMMUNIST MOVEMENT: THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CLASSLESS SOCIETY. THIS SECTION OUTLINES THE ENVISIONED FUTURE AND THE PRINCIPLES THAT WOULD GOVERN IT.

# THE ROLE OF COMMUNISM

COMMUNISM, AS PRESENTED IN THE MANIFESTO, IS NOT MERELY A POLITICAL SYSTEM BUT A HISTORICAL MOVEMENT AIMING TO ABOLISH EXISTING CONDITIONS. ITS IMMEDIATE AIM IS THE POLITICAL SUPREMACY OF THE PROLETARIAT, THE GRADUAL WRESTING OF ALL CAPITAL FROM THE BOURGEOISIE, AND THE CENTRALIZATION OF THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION IN THE HANDS OF THE STATE, CONTROLLED BY THE ORGANIZED PROLETARIAT. THIS TRANSITIONAL PHASE WOULD THEN PAVE THE WAY FOR A SOCIETY WHERE CLASS DISTINCTIONS, AND THE STATE AS AN INSTRUMENT OF CLASS OPPRESSION, WOULD WITHER AWAY.

## ADDRESSING COMMON MISCONCEPTIONS

THE MANIFESTO PREEMPTIVELY ADDRESSES CRITICISMS AND MISCONCEPTIONS ABOUT COMMUNISM. IT REFUTES THE ACCUSATION THAT COMMUNISM SEEKS TO ABOLISH THE RIGHT TO WORK OR THE PRODUCT OF ONE'S OWN LABOR. INSTEAD, IT AIMS TO ABOLISH THE VERY CONDITIONS THAT MAKE SUCH EXPLOITATION POSSIBLE. IT ALSO CHALLENGES THE NOTION THAT COMMUNISM ABOLISHES PERSONAL FREEDOM, ARGUING THAT TRUE FREEDOM CAN ONLY BE ACHIEVED WHEN INDIVIDUALS ARE LIBERATED FROM ECONOMIC COERCION AND EXPLOITATION.

## THE END GOAL: A FREE ASSOCIATION

THE ULTIMATE VISION PRESENTED IS A SOCIETY WHERE THE "FREE DEVELOPMENT OF EACH IS THE CONDITION FOR THE FREE DEVELOPMENT OF ALL." IN THIS COMMUNIST SOCIETY, THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION WOULD BE COLLECTIVELY OWNED AND OPERATED FOR THE BENEFIT OF ALL. THE DIVISION OF LABOR THAT ALIENATES INDIVIDUALS FROM THEIR WORK AND FROM EACH OTHER WOULD BE OVERCOME. THE STATE, AS AN INSTRUMENT OF CLASS RULE, WOULD BECOME UNNECESSARY AND WOULD EVENTUALLY "DIE OUT." THIS WOULD BE A SOCIETY OF ABUNDANCE, WHERE HUMAN POTENTIAL COULD FLOURISH UNFETTERED BY ECONOMIC SCARCITY OR SOCIAL HIERARCHY.

## CRITIQUES AND ENDURING RELEVANCE OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO'S FUNDAMENTAL ARGUMENTS

WHILE THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS AND ITS FUNDAMENTAL ARGUMENTS HAVE PROFOUNDLY INFLUENCED HISTORY, THEY HAVE ALSO FACED SIGNIFICANT CRITICISM. EXAMINING THESE CRITIQUES IS ESSENTIAL FOR A BALANCED UNDERSTANDING OF THE MANIFESTO'S IMPACT.

### CRITICISMS OF HISTORICAL MATERIALISM

ONE OF THE MOST FREQUENT CRITICISMS LEVELED AGAINST THE MANIFESTO IS ITS RELIANCE ON HISTORICAL MATERIALISM. CRITICS ARGUE THAT IT OVERSIMPLIFIES HISTORY BY REDUCING ALL SOCIAL AND POLITICAL PHENOMENA TO ECONOMIC FACTORS. THEY CONTEND THAT OTHER FORCES, SUCH AS CULTURE, RELIGION, NATIONALISM, AND INDIVIDUAL AGENCY, PLAY CRUCIAL ROLES IN SHAPING HISTORICAL DEVELOPMENT AND THAT THE DETERMINISTIC NATURE OF HISTORICAL MATERIALISM IS FLAWED. THE PREDICTIVE POWER OF THE THEORY HAS ALSO BEEN QUESTIONED, AS HISTORICAL EVENTS HAVE NOT ALWAYS UNFOLDED AS MARX AND ENGELS PREDICTED.

### CRITIQUES OF THE PREDICTED REVOLUTION

THE MANIFESTO'S PREDICTION OF A PROLETARIAN REVOLUTION IN ADVANCED CAPITALIST COUNTRIES HAS NOT MATERIALIZED IN THE WAY IT ENVISIONED. WHILE REVOLUTIONS OCCURRED IN COUNTRIES THAT WERE LARGELY AGRARIAN OR IN THE EARLY STAGES OF INDUSTRIALIZATION (E.G., RUSSIA, CHINA), THE ADVANCED INDUSTRIAL NATIONS OF WESTERN EUROPE AND NORTH AMERICA DID NOT EXPERIENCE THE WIDESPREAD, VIOLENT OVERTHROW OF CAPITALISM THAT THE MANIFESTO SEEMED TO ANTICIPATE. CRITICS SUGGEST THAT CAPITALISM HAS PROVEN MORE ADAPTABLE AND RESILIENT THAN MARX AND ENGELS BELIEVED, INCORPORATING REFORMS AND SOCIAL WELFARE PROGRAMS THAT HAVE MITIGATED SOME OF THE HARSHTEST CONDITIONS FACED BY THE WORKING CLASS.

## THE MANIFESTO'S LASTING INFLUENCE

DESPITE THESE CRITICISMS, THE FUNDAMENTAL ARGUMENTS OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO CONTINUE TO HOLD RELEVANCE AND HAVE HAD A LASTING INFLUENCE ON POLITICAL THOUGHT AND SOCIAL MOVEMENTS. ITS ANALYSIS OF CLASS INEQUALITY, THE EXPLOITATIVE NATURE OF CAPITALISM, AND THE INHERENT CONTRADICTIONS WITHIN THE SYSTEM REMAINS A POWERFUL CRITIQUE FOR MANY. THE MANIFESTO'S EMPHASIS ON THE IMPORTANCE OF COLLECTIVE ACTION, THE CRITIQUE OF ALIENATION IN LABOR, AND THE VISION OF A MORE EQUITABLE SOCIETY HAVE INSPIRED COUNTLESS MOVEMENTS FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE AND REFORM. EVEN THOSE WHO REJECT COMMUNISM AS AN IDEOLOGY OFTEN ENGAGE WITH THE MANIFESTO'S DIAGNOSTIC INSIGHTS INTO THE PROBLEMS OF MODERN INDUSTRIAL SOCIETY.

## CONCLUSION: THE ENDURING LEGACY OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS

THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO THESIS, WITH ITS CORE ARGUMENTS CENTERED ON CLASS STRUGGLE, HISTORICAL MATERIALISM, THE ROLES OF THE BOURGEOISIE AND PROLETARIAT, AND THE VISION OF A CLASSLESS SOCIETY, STANDS AS A MONUMENTAL DOCUMENT IN THE HISTORY OF IDEAS. IT PROVIDED A POWERFUL ANALYTICAL FRAMEWORK FOR UNDERSTANDING THE DYNAMICS OF CAPITALISM AND A COMPELLING CALL TO ACTION FOR THE OPPRESSED. WHILE ITS PREDICTIONS AND PRESCRIPTIONS HAVE BEEN DEBATED AND CRITIQUED EXTENSIVELY, THE FUNDAMENTAL ARGUMENTS PRESENTED IN THE MANIFESTO CONTINUE TO RESONATE, SPARKING DISCOURSE ON ECONOMIC INEQUALITY, SOCIAL JUSTICE, AND THE ORGANIZATION OF SOCIETY. ITS ENDURING LEGACY LIES NOT ONLY IN ITS HISTORICAL IMPACT BUT ALSO IN ITS CAPACITY TO PROVOKE CRITICAL THINKING ABOUT THE STRUCTURES OF POWER AND THE POSSIBILITIES FOR A MORE EQUITABLE FUTURE.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### WHAT IS THE CORE THESIS OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO REGARDING CLASS STRUGGLE?

### WHAT ARE THE FUNDAMENTAL CRITICISMS LEVELED AGAINST CAPITALISM IN THE MANIFESTO?

THE MANIFESTO CRITICIZES CAPITALISM FOR ITS INHERENT INSTABILITY (CRISES OF OVERPRODUCTION), ITS TENDENCY TO

CONCENTRATE WEALTH AND POWER, ITS COMMODIFICATION OF ALL ASPECTS OF LIFE, AND ITS EXPLOITATION OF THE WORKING CLASS.

## **WHAT DOES THE MANIFESTO PROPOSE AS THE ULTIMATE GOAL OF COMMUNIST REVOLUTION?**

THE ULTIMATE GOAL IS THE ABOLITION OF PRIVATE PROPERTY IN THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION, THE ELIMINATION OF CLASS DISTINCTIONS, AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A COMMUNIST SOCIETY WHERE THE FREE DEVELOPMENT OF EACH IS THE CONDITION FOR THE FREE DEVELOPMENT OF ALL.

## **HOW DOES THE MANIFESTO VIEW THE ROLE OF THE STATE?**

THE MANIFESTO VIEWS THE STATE UNDER CAPITALISM AS AN INSTRUMENT OF THE BOURGEOISIE, SERVING TO MAINTAIN THEIR POWER AND PROTECT PRIVATE PROPERTY. IN A COMMUNIST SOCIETY, IT IS ENVISIONED THAT THE STATE WILL EVENTUALLY 'WITHER AWAY' AS CLASS ANTAGONISMS DISAPPEAR.
