

COMPARING APA AND MLA CITATION METHODS

INTRODUCTION

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UNDERSTANDING THE BASICS: WHAT ARE APA AND MLA?

APA (AMERICAN PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATION) AND MLA (MODERN LANGUAGE ASSOCIATION) ARE TWO OF THE MOST WIDELY RECOGNIZED AND UTILIZED CITATION STYLES IN ACADEMIC WRITING. THEIR PRIMARY PURPOSE IS TO PROVIDE A STANDARDIZED METHOD FOR ACKNOWLEDGING SOURCES, THEREBY AVOIDING PLAGIARISM AND ALLOWING READERS TO LOCATE THE ORIGINAL MATERIAL. WHILE BOTH STYLES AIM FOR CLARITY AND ACADEMIC HONESTY, THEY DIFFER IN THEIR FORMATTING GUIDELINES, THE INFORMATION THEY PRIORITIZE, AND THE ACADEMIC DISCIPLINES THEY TYPICALLY SERVE. UNDERSTANDING THESE FUNDAMENTAL DIFFERENCES IS THE FIRST STEP IN EFFECTIVELY COMPARING APA AND MLA CITATION METHODS.

APA STYLE IS GENERALLY FAVORED IN THE SOCIAL SCIENCES, INCLUDING PSYCHOLOGY, SOCIOLOGY, EDUCATION, AND BUSINESS. IT EMPHASIZES THE DATE OF PUBLICATION, REFLECTING THE EMPHASIS ON RECENT RESEARCH IN THESE FIELDS. MLA

STYLE, ON THE OTHER HAND, IS PREDOMINANTLY USED IN THE HUMANITIES, SUCH AS LITERATURE, LANGUAGE ARTS, CULTURAL STUDIES, AND PHILOSOPHY. ITS FOCUS TENDS TO BE ON THE AUTHOR AND THE SPECIFIC PAGE NUMBER, WHICH IS CRUCIAL FOR LITERARY ANALYSIS AND CLOSE READING OF TEXTS.

HISTORICAL CONTEXT AND DISCIPLINARY FOCUS

THE DEVELOPMENT OF CITATION STYLES IS INTRINSICALLY LINKED TO THE EVOLVING NEEDS OF ACADEMIC DISCIPLINES. APA STYLE ORIGINATED FROM THE NEED FOR A STANDARDIZED SYSTEM WITHIN THE FIELD OF PSYCHOLOGY TO FACILITATE THE CLEAR AND CONSISTENT REPORTING OF RESEARCH FINDINGS. ITS EMPHASIS ON EMPIRICAL DATA AND RECENCY OF INFORMATION REFLECTS THE DYNAMIC NATURE OF SCIENTIFIC INQUIRY. THE AMERICAN PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATION FIRST PUBLISHED ITS STYLE GUIDE IN 1929, AND IT HAS UNDERGONE NUMEROUS REVISIONS TO ADAPT TO NEW TECHNOLOGIES AND RESEARCH METHODOLOGIES.

MLA STYLE EMERGED FROM THE MODERN LANGUAGE ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA, AN ORGANIZATION DEDICATED TO THE STUDY OF LANGUAGES AND LITERATURES. ITS HISTORICAL ROOTS ARE IN THE HUMANITIES, WHERE THE AUTHOR'S VOICE AND THE PRECISE LOCATION OF EVIDENCE WITHIN A TEXT ARE PARAMOUNT. THE MLA HANDBOOK, FIRST PUBLISHED IN 1951, PROVIDES GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARS AND STUDENTS TO PRESENT THEIR RESEARCH EFFECTIVELY, PARTICULARLY WHEN ENGAGING WITH LITERARY WORKS AND TEXTUAL ANALYSIS. THE PRIMARY GOAL OF COMPARING APA AND MLA CITATION METHODS IS TO UNDERSTAND WHICH STYLISTIC CONVENTIONS BEST SERVE THE RESEARCH AND WRITING PRACTICES OF DIFFERENT ACADEMIC FIELDS.

IN-TEXT CITATIONS: A CORE DISTINCTION

ONE OF THE MOST SIGNIFICANT AREAS WHERE COMPARING APA AND MLA CITATION METHODS REVEALS CLEAR DIFFERENCES IS IN THEIR APPROACH TO IN-TEXT CITATIONS. THESE BRIEF PARENTHETICAL NOTES WITHIN THE BODY OF YOUR PAPER ATTRIBUTE IDEAS, FACTS, AND DIRECT QUOTES TO THEIR ORIGINAL SOURCES.

APA IN-TEXT CITATION FORMAT

APA STYLE TYPICALLY USES THE AUTHOR-DATE FORMAT FOR IN-TEXT CITATIONS. WHEN YOU INCORPORATE INFORMATION FROM A SOURCE, YOU INCLUDE THE AUTHOR'S LAST NAME AND THE YEAR OF PUBLICATION IN PARENTHESES. FOR DIRECT QUOTES, YOU MUST ALSO INCLUDE THE PAGE NUMBER.

EXAMPLES:

- ACCORDING TO SMITH (2020), THE STUDY FOUND SIGNIFICANT RESULTS.
- THE FINDINGS WERE CONSISTENT ACROSS ALL PARTICIPANTS (JONES, 2021, p. 45).
- AS STATED IN THE RESEARCH, "DATA ANALYSIS REVEALED A CLEAR TREND" (BROWN & GREEN, 2019, p. 112).

MLA IN-TEXT CITATION FORMAT

MLA STYLE, CONVERSELY, PRIORITIZES THE AUTHOR'S LAST NAME AND THE PAGE NUMBER FOR IN-TEXT CITATIONS. THE PUBLICATION DATE IS NOT INCLUDED IN THE PARENTHETICAL CITATION BUT RATHER IN THE WORKS CITED LIST.

EXAMPLES:

- SMITH ARGUES THAT THE STUDY YIELDED SIGNIFICANT RESULTS (20).

- THE RESULTS WERE CONSISTENT ACROSS ALL PARTICIPANTS (JONES 45).
- THE RESEARCH STATES, "DATA ANALYSIS REVEALED A CLEAR TREND" (BROWN AND GREEN 112).

THE FUNDAMENTAL DIFFERENCE IN COMPARING APA AND MLA CITATION METHODS HERE LIES IN THE PROMINENCE GIVEN TO THE PUBLICATION DATE IN APA VERSUS THE EMPHASIS ON AUTHOR AND PAGE NUMBER IN MLA, WHICH AIDS IN QUICKLY LOCATING THE INFORMATION WITHIN A TEXT.

THE REFERENCE LIST VS. WORKS CITED: FORMATTING DIFFERENCES

BOTH APA AND MLA STYLES REQUIRE A COMPREHENSIVE LIST OF ALL SOURCES CONSULTED AT THE END OF THE DOCUMENT. HOWEVER, THE TITLES OF THESE LISTS AND THE SPECIFIC FORMATTING OF THE ENTRIES VARY SIGNIFICANTLY, MAKING THIS A KEY AREA FOR COMPARING APA AND MLA CITATION METHODS.

APA REFERENCE LIST

IN APA STYLE, THIS LIST IS CALLED THE "REFERENCE LIST." THE ORDER OF ELEMENTS WITHIN EACH CITATION IS CRUCIAL, WITH THE AUTHOR'S LAST NAME, INITIAL(S), YEAR OF PUBLICATION, TITLE OF THE WORK, AND PUBLICATION INFORMATION FORMING THE CORE STRUCTURE.

MLA WORKS CITED PAGE

MLA STYLE REFERS TO THIS CONCLUDING LIST AS THE "WORKS CITED" PAGE. THE ARRANGEMENT OF INFORMATION TYPICALLY BEGINS WITH THE AUTHOR'S LAST NAME, FIRST NAME, FOLLOWED BY THE TITLE OF THE SOURCE, AND THEN PUBLICATION DETAILS. THE EMPHASIS ON THE AUTHOR AND TITLE IS A NOTABLE POINT WHEN COMPARING APA AND MLA CITATION METHODS.

THE PRIMARY DISTINCTION WHEN COMPARING APA AND MLA CITATION METHODS REGARDING THESE LISTS IS THE INCLUSION OF THE PUBLICATION YEAR IN APA CITATIONS AS A PROMINENT ELEMENT, WHEREAS MLA PLACES IT LATER IN THE CITATION STRUCTURE, AFTER THE TITLE. THIS REFLECTS THE DISCIPLINARY EMPHASIS ON THE CURRENCY OF INFORMATION IN APA VERSUS THE FOCUS ON THE AUTHOR AND THE TEXT ITSELF IN MLA.

KEY ELEMENTS IN APA CITATIONS

AUTHOR(S)

APA LISTS AUTHORS BY LAST NAME, FOLLOWED BY THEIR FIRST INITIAL AND MIDDLE INITIAL (IF AVAILABLE). FOR MULTIPLE AUTHORS, A SERIAL COMMA IS USED BEFORE THE FINAL "ET" SIGN.

YEAR OF PUBLICATION

THE YEAR OF PUBLICATION IS A CRITICAL ELEMENT IN APA, APPEARING IN PARENTHESES IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE AUTHOR'S NAME.

TITLE OF THE WORK

THE TITLE OF THE WORK IS ITALICIZED. FOR ARTICLES OR BOOK CHAPTERS, ONLY THE FIRST WORD OF THE TITLE AND SUBTITLE ARE CAPITALIZED, ALONG WITH PROPER NOUNS. FOR BOOKS AND JOURNALS, THE MAIN TITLE IS CAPITALIZED ACCORDING TO SENTENCE CASE, WITH PROPER NOUNS CAPITALIZED.

PUBLICATION INFORMATION

THIS INCLUDES THE JOURNAL TITLE (ITALICIZED), VOLUME AND ISSUE NUMBERS, PAGE NUMBERS, AND THE PUBLISHER'S NAME.

DOI OR URL

DIGITAL OBJECT IDENTIFIERS (DOIs) ARE PREFERRED FOR ONLINE SOURCES, FOLLOWED BY A URL IF NO DOI IS AVAILABLE.

KEY ELEMENTS IN MLA CITATIONS

MLA CITATION STYLE PRIORITIZES AUTHORIAL CREDIT AND THE SPECIFIC LOCATION OF INFORMATION WITHIN A SOURCE, ESPECIALLY FOR LITERARY AND TEXTUAL ANALYSIS. WHEN COMPARING APA AND MLA CITATION METHODS, THESE ELEMENTS STAND OUT.

AUTHOR(S)

MLA LISTS AUTHORS BY LAST NAME, FOLLOWED BY THEIR FIRST NAME. FOR MORE THAN TWO AUTHORS, THE FIRST AUTHOR'S NAME IS LISTED FOLLOWED BY "ET AL." (AND OTHERS).

TITLE OF SOURCE

TITLES OF SHORTER WORKS (ARTICLES, ESSAYS, POEMS) ARE ENCLOSED IN QUOTATION MARKS. TITLES OF LONGER WORKS (BOOKS, JOURNALS, WEBSITES) ARE ITALICIZED.

TITLE OF CONTAINER

THIS REFERS TO THE LARGER WORK IN WHICH THE SOURCE IS FOUND, SUCH AS A JOURNAL, ANTHOLOGY, OR WEBSITE. IT IS ITALICIZED.

OTHER CONTRIBUTORS

NAMES OF EDITORS, TRANSLATORS, OR OTHER CONTRIBUTORS ARE INCLUDED AS APPROPRIATE.

VERSION

IF A SPECIFIC EDITION OR VERSION OF A WORK IS BEING CITED, IT IS NOTED.

NUMBER

THIS APPLIES TO VOLUME AND ISSUE NUMBERS FOR PERIODICALS OR SPECIFIC NUMBERING SYSTEMS.

PUBLISHER

THE NAME OF THE PUBLISHING COMPANY.

PUBLICATION DATE

THE YEAR OR SPECIFIC DATE OF PUBLICATION.

LOCATION

THIS INCLUDES PAGE NUMBERS FOR PRINT SOURCES, OR A URL OR DOI FOR ONLINE SOURCES.

WHEN TO USE APA STYLE

APA STYLE IS THE STANDARD FOR MANY DISCIPLINES, PARTICULARLY THOSE THAT RELY HEAVILY ON EMPIRICAL RESEARCH AND THE REPORTING OF DATA. UNDERSTANDING WHEN TO USE APA IS CRUCIAL FOR ACCURATE ACADEMIC COMMUNICATION.

- **SOCIAL SCIENCES:** PSYCHOLOGY, SOCIOLOGY, EDUCATION, CRIMINOLOGY, AND COMMUNICATION STUDIES ARE PRIMARY FIELDS THAT ADOPT APA. THE EMPHASIS ON THE RECENCY OF RESEARCH AND EXPERIMENTAL FINDINGS MAKES APA AN IDEAL FIT.
- **BUSINESS AND ECONOMICS:** THESE FIELDS OFTEN UTILIZE APA TO CITE BUSINESS REPORTS, MARKET RESEARCH, AND ECONOMIC STUDIES, WHERE THE TIMELINESS OF INFORMATION IS PARAMOUNT.
- **NURSING AND HEALTH SCIENCES:** MANY MEDICAL AND HEALTHCARE DISCIPLINES, ESPECIALLY THOSE FOCUSING ON RESEARCH AND CLINICAL TRIALS, FOLLOW APA GUIDELINES.
- **FORMAL REPORTS AND RESEARCH PAPERS:** WHEN PRESENTING EMPIRICAL DATA, STATISTICAL ANALYSIS, AND RESEARCH METHODOLOGY, APA PROVIDES A CLEAR AND STRUCTURED FORMAT.

THE CORE PRINCIPLE GUIDING THE USE OF APA IS THE NEED TO SHOWCASE THE AUTHOR AND THE PUBLICATION DATE AS KEY INDICATORS OF THE RESEARCH'S RELEVANCE AND CREDIBILITY WITHIN THESE FIELDS.

WHEN TO USE MLA STYLE

MLA STYLE IS DEEPLY ROOTED IN THE HUMANITIES, WHERE TEXTUAL ANALYSIS AND AUTHORIAL INTERPRETATION TAKE PRECEDENCE. KNOWING WHEN TO EMPLOY MLA IS KEY TO ADHERING TO THE CONVENTIONS OF THESE DISCIPLINES.

- **LITERATURE:** ENGLISH LITERATURE, COMPARATIVE LITERATURE, AND CREATIVE WRITING COURSES ALMOST UNIVERSALLY REQUIRE MLA FOR CITING NOVELS, POEMS, PLAYS, AND CRITICAL ESSAYS.

- **LANGUAGE AND LINGUISTICS:** STUDIES IN MODERN LANGUAGES, GRAMMAR, AND THE HISTORY OF LANGUAGE OFTEN USE MLA TO CITE LINGUISTIC THEORIES AND TEXTUAL EXAMPLES.
- **CULTURAL STUDIES AND MEDIA STUDIES:** ANALYSIS OF CULTURAL PHENOMENA, MEDIA TEXTS, AND POPULAR CULTURE FREQUENTLY EMPLOYS MLA GUIDELINES.
- **PHILOSOPHY:** WHILE SOME PHILOSOPHICAL DISCIPLINES MAY ADOPT OTHER STYLES, MLA IS COMMON FOR CITING PHILOSOPHICAL TEXTS AND ARGUMENTS.
- **ARTS AND HUMANITIES RESEARCH:** GENERAL RESEARCH PAPERS IN HISTORY, ART HISTORY, AND RELIGIOUS STUDIES MAY ALSO OPT FOR MLA FORMATTING.

THE EMPHASIS WHEN COMPARING APA AND MLA CITATION METHODS FOR MLA USAGE LIES IN IDENTIFYING THE AUTHOR AND THE SPECIFIC LOCATION (PAGE NUMBER) WITHIN A TEXT TO SUPPORT ARGUMENTS AND INTERPRETATIONS.

COMPARING APA AND MLA: SPECIFIC EXAMPLES

TO TRULY GRASP THE DIFFERENCES WHEN COMPARING APA AND MLA CITATION METHODS, EXAMINING SPECIFIC EXAMPLES OF COMMON SOURCE TYPES IS HIGHLY BENEFICIAL.

NOTICE THE PLACEMENT OF THE YEAR AND THE FORMATTING OF THE JOURNAL TITLE AND VOLUME/ISSUE NUMBERS WHEN COMPARING APA AND MLA CITATION METHODS.

BOOK CITATION EXAMPLE

APA STYLE:

AUTHOR, A. A. (YEAR). TITLE OF BOOK. PUBLISHER.

EXAMPLE:

GLADWELL, M. (2008). OUTLIERS: THE STORY OF SUCCESS. LITTLE, BROWN AND COMPANY.

MLA STYLE:

AUTHOR, A. A. TITLE OF BOOK. PUBLISHER, YEAR.

EXAMPLE:

GLADWELL, MALCOLM. OUTLIERS: THE STORY OF SUCCESS. LITTLE, BROWN AND COMPANY, 2008.

AGAIN, THE YEAR'S POSITION IS A KEY DIFFERENTIATOR WHEN COMPARING APA AND MLA CITATION METHODS.

COMMON PITFALLS WHEN COMPARING APA AND MLA CITATION METHODS

DESPITE THE CLEAR GUIDELINES, STUDENTS AND RESEARCHERS OFTEN ENCOUNTER DIFFICULTIES WHEN COMPARING APA AND MLA CITATION METHODS. AWARENESS OF THESE COMMON PITFALLS CAN HELP AVOID ERRORS AND ENSURE PROPER ACADEMIC PRACTICE.

- **INCORRECTLY MIXING STYLES:** THE MOST FREQUENT ERROR IS BLENDING ELEMENTS FROM BOTH APA AND MLA WITHIN THE SAME DOCUMENT OR EVEN WITHIN A SINGLE CITATION. THIS CREATES AN INCONSISTENT AND UNPROFESSIONAL PRESENTATION.
- **FORGETTING ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS:** OVERLOOKING CRUCIAL INFORMATION LIKE DOIs, PAGE NUMBERS FOR DIRECT QUOTES, OR THE CORRECT CAPITALIZATION OF TITLES CAN LEAD TO INCOMPLETE CITATIONS.
- **IMPROPER PUNCTUATION:** BOTH STYLES HAVE SPECIFIC PUNCTUATION RULES FOR COMMAS, PERIODS, AND QUOTATION MARKS. DEVIATIONS FROM THESE CAN IMPACT THE CLARITY AND CORRECTNESS OF THE CITATION.
- **MISINTERPRETING SOURCE TYPES:** DIFFERENT SOURCE TYPES (E.G., BOOKS, JOURNAL ARTICLES, WEBSITES, INTERVIEWS) REQUIRE SLIGHTLY VARIED FORMATTING WITHIN BOTH APA AND MLA. FAILING TO APPLY THE CORRECT FORMAT FOR THE SPECIFIC SOURCE IS A COMMON OVERSIGHT.
- **INCONSISTENT IN-TEXT CITATIONS:** ENSURING THAT EVERY IN-TEXT CITATION HAS A CORRESPONDING ENTRY IN THE REFERENCE LIST OR WORKS CITED PAGE, AND VICE VERSA, IS CRITICAL.
- **INCORRECT ALPHABETIZATION:** BOTH STYLES REQUIRE ENTRIES TO BE ALPHABETIZED BY THE AUTHOR'S LAST NAME, OR BY TITLE IF NO AUTHOR IS LISTED.
- **OVERLOOKING SPECIFIC EDITION REQUIREMENTS:** FOR CERTAIN DISCIPLINES, REFERENCING SPECIFIC EDITIONS OF STYLE MANUALS (E.G., THE LATEST EDITION OF THE APA PUBLICATION MANUAL OR THE MLA HANDBOOK) IS IMPORTANT.

CAREFUL ATTENTION TO DETAIL AND A THOROUGH UNDERSTANDING OF THE CORE PRINCIPLES WHEN COMPARING APA AND MLA CITATION METHODS ARE ESSENTIAL FOR AVOIDING THESE COMMON MISTAKES.

CONCLUSION: MASTERING CITATION FOR ACADEMIC SUCCESS

IN CONCLUSION, A DEEP UNDERSTANDING OF COMPARING APA AND MLA CITATION METHODS IS NOT MERELY ABOUT FOLLOWING RULES; IT'S ABOUT DEMONSTRATING ACADEMIC INTEGRITY, RESPECTING INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY, AND ENABLING READERS TO ENGAGE WITH YOUR RESEARCH EFFECTIVELY. APA STYLE, WITH ITS EMPHASIS ON THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM AND ITS PREVALENCE IN SCIENTIFIC AND SOCIAL SCIENCE DISCIPLINES, PRIORITIZES THE CURRENCY AND AUTHORSHIP OF INFORMATION. CONVERSELY, MLA STYLE, FAVORED IN THE HUMANITIES, FOCUSES ON AUTHOR AND PAGE NUMBER TO FACILITATE CLOSE TEXTUAL ANALYSIS AND ARGUMENT SUPPORT.

BY METICULOUSLY ATTENDING TO THE DISTINCT FORMATTING OF IN-TEXT CITATIONS, REFERENCE LISTS, AND THE SPECIFIC ELEMENTS REQUIRED FOR EACH SOURCE TYPE, YOU CAN ENSURE YOUR WORK MEETS THE RIGOROUS STANDARDS OF ACADEMIC WRITING. RECOGNIZING THE DISCIPLINARY HOMES OF EACH STYLE AND BEING AWARE OF COMMON PITFALLS WILL FURTHER ENHANCE YOUR CITATION PROFICIENCY. WHAT IS THE PRIMARY DIFFERENCE IN HOW APA AND MLA FORMAT IN-TEXT CITATIONS?

APA USES THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM (E.G., (SMITH, 2020)), WHILE MLA USES THE AUTHOR-PAGE NUMBER SYSTEM (E.G., (SMITH 20)). APA PRIORITIZES THE PUBLICATION DATE, WHICH IS CRUCIAL FOR SCIENTIFIC AND SOCIAL SCIENCES WHERE CURRENCY IS IMPORTANT, WHEREAS MLA EMPHASIZES THE SPECIFIC LOCATION WITHIN A SOURCE, BENEFICIAL FOR HUMANITIES DISCIPLINES.

WHEN WOULD A STUDENT TYPICALLY CHOOSE APA OVER MLA, OR VICE VERSA?

STUDENTS ARE GENERALLY ASSIGNED APA WHEN WRITING FOR DISCIPLINES LIKE PSYCHOLOGY, SOCIOLOGY, EDUCATION, AND BUSINESS, WHERE RECENT RESEARCH AND EMPIRICAL DATA ARE FREQUENTLY CITED. MLA IS TYPICALLY USED IN ENGLISH, LITERATURE, AND OTHER HUMANITIES FIELDS, WHERE TEXTUAL INTERPRETATION AND ANALYSIS ARE KEY.

HOW DOES THE WORKS CITED PAGE (MLA) DIFFER FROM THE REFERENCES PAGE (APA)?

BOTH LIST ALL SOURCES USED IN A PAPER, BUT THE ORGANIZATION AND CONTENT CAN VARY. APA'S REFERENCES PAGE IS STRICTLY ALPHABETICAL AND INCLUDES DETAILS LIKE DOIs FOR ARTICLES. MLA'S WORKS CITED PAGE IS ALSO ALPHABETICAL BUT MAY INCLUDE A "WORKS CONSULTED" SECTION FOR SOURCES NOT DIRECTLY QUOTED. MLA OFTEN EMPHASIZES PUBLISHER LOCATION, WHILE APA OMITTS IT FOR BOOKS.

ARE THERE ANY NOTABLE DIFFERENCES IN FORMATTING BOOK CITATIONS BETWEEN APA AND MLA?

YES. FOR BOOKS, APA TYPICALLY INCLUDES THE PUBLISHER'S NAME FOLLOWED BY THE CITY (THOUGH THE CITY IS BECOMING LESS EMPHASIZED). MLA, HOWEVER, REQUIRES THE PUBLISHER'S NAME FOLLOWED BY THE CITY OF PUBLICATION AND OFTEN INCLUDES EDITION INFORMATION IF APPLICABLE. APA ALSO OFTEN PRIORITIZES THE DOI FOR E-BOOKS.

WHICH CITATION STYLE IS GENERALLY CONSIDERED MORE STRICT OR DETAILED IN ITS FORMATTING RULES?

WHILE BOTH APA AND MLA HAVE DETAILED STYLE GUIDES, APA IS OFTEN PERCEIVED AS BEING MORE PRESCRIPTIVE AND STRICT WITH ITS FORMATTING, PARTICULARLY REGARDING THE PRECISE STRUCTURE AND PUNCTUATION OF REFERENCE ENTRIES, ESPECIALLY FOR JOURNAL ARTICLES AND ELECTRONIC SOURCES. MLA, WHILE ALSO DETAILED, CAN OFFER SLIGHTLY MORE FLEXIBILITY IN CERTAIN AREAS.
